I came in second in my department, showing DXing is still good for something, hi!. In case you are vondering about my study, I used 12 clear channels, KNBR WSB WITR WBEM WFAA WCCO MHAS KOA WCBS KDKA WHO \& $\operatorname{TSSL}$, recirded their signal steengths from day to day, \& related this to phystcal changes as sunspots, temperature, pressure, WX \& moon phese. My results were rather amazing. Sunspots showed up as the \#l cause of static \& interior radio reception (as nore of us know). Next came teaperature. 'I founa, in general, when an extreme low tamperature prevailed, ay -150 , the station was not heard. Despite many claims, pressure had very little to do with the radio wavds in my six-month project. No consistancy existed; high, low, or similar pressure didn't cormelate with similar signal strengths. The same results were found with $W X \&$ moon phase. If any of you ars interested in my studies, please write me, \& I'll fill you in! Local KGB is now leaning heavily toward rr, \& expect them to have a survey soon. As of March 201963 no reply had been received from Maurice Nittler nor from any of the other 4 signers of the Proposal as to the Denver Area DXers taking over the publication of DX News. Thus as of March 20 1963 I cut into a stencil the following and sent a copy to each of the following; Marv Robbins-Maurice Nittler-Larry Godwin-Murray Mann and Glen Kippel - with copies to Musings Editor, Ernest R. Cooper and our Foreign DX Digest Editor, Peter V. Taylor; Gentlemen;

This date I received your Second News-Letter and as usual its filled with many distorted facts or you did not bother to do any checking before making your statements.

However I am sending this to all of you asking WHY I have not as yet received an answer to my letter addressed to Maurice Nittler under the date of February 251963 giving the results of the votes on the proposal you gentiemen made in regard to taking over the publishing etc of the. NVRC as of Sept I 1963.

For the information to you other Four Denver Members the result of the $\stackrel{\text { For }}{ }$ vote was an Unanimous "NO"

Thus I asked Maurice that you fellows decide as to when this proposal and the results should be published and I would abide by the decision. Thus as of March 201963 I am still awaiting the reply.

I did this believing that if it had been published now as it should be, I would extend the courtesy of asking your suggested time and decision because I felt that in case it would have been published before your convention and the attendance might not cone up to expectations, you would have laid the blame in my lap. However with all your talk about this and that not being done correctly, I believe that you have not practiced what you preach by not being courteous enough to reply to my letter of Feb 15th. (Feb 15 th in original letter and it should have been Fob 25th) Ray.
