Finally, the stations themselves do not care about their calls. At YNDS I was told by the manager, "Yes, our call is YNDS, but we don't always use it, and sometimes we dhorten it to YND." And at "La voz de Medellin" no one at the station knew the call." In June, Dave will leave for Venezuela, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Bolivia, Chile, Paraguay, Uruguay, Argentina, Brazil, Surinam, and possibly the Dominican Republic. He will be visiting stations, and has volunteered to try and obtain veries based on worthy reports. He will not accept reports in English, and reserves the right to reject poor reports.
