I think it was because members were satisfied with the jobs the editors $\&$ publisher were performing \& were not concernedjabout superfluous comitteies \& the other trappings of a formal organization. I do not foresee any real difference for the future. Infact, I suspect that the 151 people voting in the recent socalled election is not or is just basely a majority of Club members. Such splinter actions as we are now witnessing are highly detrimental to the hobby of BCB DXing. To start with, there are but a very fow people in the world who are interested in the hobby. Secondyy, in light of the increasing number off AN stations, the hobby is not likely to spread \& will probably fall off in popularity.
