It s wonderful to be young - but let's not overdo it in our reporting methods! Let there be NO NORE of this type of report from an NRC uember! This club has a very high standard, and a fine itage to uphold, and we do not wish to see our good name besmirched by postcard, no-return-postage reports. So - MIX MAY."

Please use the following rules as a "CUDE" when compiling information. This should be referred to by those members whe wish to participate either as a new contributor or those who are now active and mail in their aditions from time to time.

1. TOTAL VIRIES. This category to include ALI veries in your file that you personally count as veries. Each member has his own "honor code".
2. FORETGY VEREES. Inder this heading count all veries except those veries in the T.S.A. and Canada. TNCLUDE HAWAII AMD ALASKA. (New Zealand DXers can not count Tew Zealand veries in this group).
3. TOTAL COUNTRIES VERIFIED, Count ALL countries in your total. TTCLIDE U. S.A. AND CAMADA IT THIS GRNUP). Tse MRC Country List by Continent as a guide. Watch for revisions or additions as they appear in John Callarman's section.
4. NARTH AMERICAN VERIES. Count ALL VERIES from countries shown on past, present and future NRC Country Lists indicating the continent of Morth America. COUNT ALASKAN VERIES in this group. DO NOT COTNT U.S. AND CANADIAN VERIES IN THIS GROUF
5. SOUTH AMERICAN VERTES. Count all veries from the countries shown on the NRC Country list by Continent of the past, present and future.
6. EUROPEAM VERTFS, COUTT ALL VERIES FROM THE MRC COUYTRY ITISTS that have appeared so far. WATCH FCR CHANGES. U.S.S.R., Isle of Man, etc.
7. OCEAIIA TERIES. FOLLOW THE MRC COUMRY IISTS. IMCITDE GAWAII as a country in this group.
8. AFRTGAN VERIES. USE TRC COUTTRY LISTS by COTPTENT of the past, present and future. There have been many changes in this continent in the past few years.
9. ASLAM VBTES. FOLLCW THE NRC COUNTRY LISTS by COTTHENT. There have been many changes in the past few years--especially in the U.S.S.R.
10. BEST VERIE I: EACH COTTIENT. JUST WEAT IT TNPLIES. YOUR BEST VERIE FROM EACH COMTMNT. EXCEPTMN: U.S. and Canadian veries are not elgible for "N. A. BEST".
11. Send in your new totals once a month or not less than once each two months. This is important if standings are to be current.
12. When submitting information as a new contributor please follow each step so that your file card at this den is complete. When established contributors send in any additions please remember to proup your new veries by continent and if any new countries are added please be sure to give the names. Ton many letters come to me in regards to STPRTACY RATXGS where the information is incomplete. May I have your fullest cooperation on this matter in the future.
13. There are a few good reasons to be a SUPREACY RATMG contributor: (1) Records of your progress as a R.C.B. Drter is kept for you as the years roll by (2) As a contributor you invite good clean healthy competition among your brother $D \mathrm{D}$ ters (3) Award Certificates for "Veries" and "Countries Verified" are mailed to you automaticcaly as you reach each multiple.
