- 750 COLOMBIA.(?) I feel this one is Colombian, although no postive ID. In here very loud, burying WSB 2330-0010, 1/21. They were playing what they called Colombian music, and gave news report at 0000. Following the news, they seemed to give all the affiliated stations, all seemed to be in Colombia, but I could hear no ID for themselves. I would appreciate any help. (Senko, N.J.) Greg, the Colombian here is La Voz de Anticquia, HJDK, Medellin, 50,000-watt affiliate of CARACOL. The Spanish-speaker I hear most often here, though, is YNX, R. Equis, Managua, NICARAGUA. (Ed.)
- 764 IRAC. Baghdad. In Arabic with very good signal at 0205 on MM 1/24. This station has been noted here for the past several MM's, and appears to be an easy way to log Asia. (Kowalski, Pa.) Granted the programming is what you'd expect from Baghdad, but the station is Dakar, SENEGAL, in Arabic. Baghdad has moved to 760+ ko. to avoid ORM to SWITZERLAND. Dakar, with 200 kw., presents an easy way to log Africa. (Ed.)
