If be loceted in Mainland Chine, Only a few of these stations have been assigned hocations, beceuse no local idrs are given on so many of the programs. 795 kHz is definitely Shanghai, and both 835 kHz and 843 kHz gave Klangus in the ID's. The 843 station might be a rebrotedcast by Thailand, since some Thai stations are reported to be troadesting Peking programs.

The foreign service on 1040 kHz is heard most often on the West cosst, and programming is in Japanese with Poking Hoso IDts. The 1120 (variable station is also foreign service, with several lenguges (including Russien (Govor1t Pekin ID heard).

Most stations are home service outlets. Centrel Psoplefg Broadcast stations; these are characterized by the 5 low; 1 high time pips on the hour (sometimes without a break in progremung). The national lanagrage In China is Manderin, and is the language that we hear on the home service usuali $y$. The 1030 kHz station possibiy is In the home service, or a local in Kwlechow or ? ? ? The time pips are not standard, but 2 low, 1 high . In some cases, the only identificable material heard was the 6-pip interval signel, but these stations are listed below angway.

There were other unidentified orientel stations (e.ge the second station on 955 kHz under Durma, 738 kHz , 810, and 900 ) that might also possibly be from Chine.
