Personal names in Latin America are used in a rather

Names in the U.S. are used in the following way: Whan a child is born he receives a given name such as John or Peter, a middle nane, and his father's last receives a given name such as John or Peter, a milde name, nas his father sume his complete name will then bo somothing like "John Theodore Snith", which is often abbreviated to "John T. Sint th".

In Latin America when a child is born he receives two names, for example, Jose Manuel". If he is a legitimate male (that is, born from a lepal marrage), he will be entitied to his father's last name of family name, and cinally his ther's fanily name; if his father's family name was "PArez." and hie mother's amily name was "Garafa", for example, his complete name would be "Jotid Mnnuel Erez Garcta".

Sometimes this full name is abbroviated like this: "Jos8 M1. ['Kroz G.", or "Jose M. Perez", or just "Jose PGrez". When this parson does not that hin ancond name, i.e., Manuel", there is a possibility of error if he writan him name lika this. "Jose Pbrez Garcfa".
