THE GREAT NRCTAKEOVER．：
The coming switch of publishing and management facilities to the New Jersey Publishing Committee is moving along smoothly．Present plans call for the NJPC to come up to Boston on the weekend of the 23 rd to pick up the necessary equipment and materials．This necessitates the following minor change in scheduling for the remainder of Volume 40.

SCHEDULINGFOR THE END OF VOLUME 31
Due to matters of timing and logistics（not to mention the shortage of material on hand）Russ and the BPC have decided to terminate this Volume with the next issue，Number 31．The NJPC will take over with issue Number 1 of Volume 41；details will be found inside this issue．This switchover will be difficult for both the old and new Publishing groups so please bear with us． The next issue of DX NEWS（the last published in Boston）will have a deadline of September 15 th for copy arriving in Boston；Editors will be contacted by the NJPC regarding the schedule and deadlines for the upcoming first NJ issue．We plan to keep Box 99 open but the major club address will be cha nged to New Jersey；both new $H Q$ address and phone numbers will be given in the next issue．

MCINTIRE REVISITED。』。
Recent press reports indicate that McIntire＇s＂Radio Free America＂offshore bootleg operation is still alive；keep your ears open for him！

Now that it's official that the NRC HQ is moving to North Jersey, we would like to emphasize that we anticipate no immediate major changes in operations, and have every reason to expect the transfer of duties to be a smooth one. We will commence publishing with Volume 41, \#1 in October, and hope that we can get the bugs which will inevitably appear in our operations at first out shortly thereafter. By way of changes and announcements, we offer the following:

1. The new club address will be published in the next issue, as will the new HQ phane numbers. THESE WILL NOT BE EITHER PACE'S OR FI ADDRESSES OR NUMBERS! We will have a NEW address and a NEW number, neither of which exist currently.
2. Effective with the next issue, IDXD will be edited by Alan Merriman, P.O. Box 6, Fairfax, Va. 22030. Likewise, DDXD will be published by Wes Boyd, 960 West Liberty, Girard, Ohio. We will leave it to them to publish their phone numbers.
3. THE DX CALFNDAR will be compiled here at HQ. CPC items should be sent to the new $H Q$ address effective with the next issue, and not to ERC.
4. The new line limit for ERC's Musings section will be TWENTY (20) LINES per muse during the winter $D X$ season (Oct. - March). Other times no change.
5. The HQ crew, in consultation $\mathbf{w} / \mathrm{GPN}$ will implement a policy which was proposed by Eoston some time agn, which was not implemented at that time; it not being deemed needful. Namely, that is the practise of making certain articles submitted for publication in DX NEWS into monographs rather than printing them. This will occur ONLY under very rare circumstances, such as when $H Q \& G P N$ ( \& perhaps others) determine that so few members will be able to comprehend it that it would be better in manograph. If such is the case, the author will be notified and subsequent to his approval, will be offered as a monograph with suitable and Eubsequent to his app
announcement in DX NEWS.
6. MAILING of DX NEWS will occur by meane of a professional mafling service, who will pick up the finished bulletins from the printer down the street and address \& stamp them \& deliver them to the P.O. within 24 hours of their completion by the printer.
7. Effective with Volume 41, DX NEWS will appear THIRTY (30) times per year, according to the following PROJECTED schedule: Weekly commencing the second week in October, through the and of March, with skips at Thanksgiving, Christmas, and the third weak in February (due to 2 legal holidays at that time); Bi-weekly in September and April; and monthly in May, June, July, \& August. We will be prepered to publish an extre issue in mid-summer if demand warrants and if finances permit. The projected schodule calls for ten 40-pagers and twenty 20pagers for a total of 800 text-pages per year. This is a reduction of about $20 \%$ over volume 39, and about equal to the actual page count for Volume 40. We hope that the changes outlined in items four and five above will accomplish this in addition to the reduction in the number of issues. THIS WILL FAY FOR THE MAILING SERVICE, which is necessary in order for us to publish at oll. It will also pay for the very moderate price increase due to the fact that....
8. DX NEWS WILL BE FRINTED ON METAL PLATES \& USING NEGATIVES !! This represents a major qualitr advance in DX NEWS, and will allow us to have greater leeway in contrast not only between pages, but also within pages. Our printer is dealing with lots of volume business, and strictly contract business, and was very anxious (1!!) to land the NRC contract, thus the gocd deal.
