New stations, changes, skeds, etc. . . . .

GREAT BRITAIN - BBC cuts for economic reasons will affect both TV and Radio. Radios 1 and 2 on 1214 khz and 200 khz will sign on weekdays at 0600 and Sundays at 0655 as now and will sign off at 0040. Local BBC stations will also be affected by these schedule changes. Radios 1 and 2 will merge 1400-1700 and 1900-s/off. Radios 3 and 4 will merge for 6 hours per week with what would have been Radio 3 programs and this will include 3 hours on Saturday afternoons. Radio 3 will s/off a little earlier. This plan is due to begin early in 1975. (Brownless) Ken also sent in a list of IBA stations. Since it is identical to the one from Terry Creenhill that was run several issues ago (except for power's, generally lower in Ken's list) I won't run it again. Our thanks to Ken for taking the time to send the list. (ED)

INDONESIA - The Indonesian Government is coordinating the progressive movement of all private stations from SW to MW. During 1975-79, high powered MW facilities are to be built at Jakarta, 250 kw; Ujung Padang, Ydeyakarta and Medan 100 kw; Palembang, 50 kw; Surabaya and Semarang 20 kw. No frequencies given. (NZDXRA)

MALTA - Radio Canada International apparently used the Deutsche Welle relay at Cyclops, 1570 khz, during November, but a revised sked as of 12/1 shows no MW use of Malta by Canada. The Nov-Mar DW sked, however, shows:

SOUTH AFRICA - This country will not disappear as a MW DX possibility. Some SABC transmitters, when domestic programming is completely switched to FM and SW, will remain on the air, relaying without local ID, L-M Radio from Mozambique. (Hauser)

SRI IANKA - According to a brochure from TWR, permission is expected to be granted shortly for TWR to build a 400 kw MW station to beam programs to India, Pakistan and South Asia. (Winkleman) Frequency not given. (ED)

TUNISIA - RTV Tunisienne has purchased a 350 kw MW transmitter from Telefunken. This transmitter will be located at Gafsa, in south-west Tunisia, and will beam programs in Arabic to North Africa. (NZRDXL) Frequency not given. (ED)

URUGUAY - Three stations are to increase power. CX6 on 650 khz will go to 200 kw. CX26 on 1050 khz and CX38 on 1290 khz are to go to 50 kw. (NZDXRA)

U S VIRGIN ISIANDS - WRRA Frederiksted, St. Croix, granted a modification of CP to change frequency from 1090 to 1290 khz. (Broadcasting)

PUERTO RICO - Penuelas Broadcasters, Penuelas has applied for a CP for a new station on 1330 khz, 500 D1. (Broadcasting)





#### VARIABLE SPEECH CONTROL -- by Paul Daplyn

VSC (variable speech control) is a major breakthrough unveiled recently by the Cambridge Research and Development Group of Westport, Connecticut. VSC is a cassette tape player that can halve or triple the playback rate of recorded speech without distortion. This means you can increase a person's speaking rate to 500 words per minute without affecting the pitch of his voice! However, when you do speed up the tape, you can tell "electronic editing" is taking place, but it isn't very noticeable.

Fortunately, there is a lot of redundant information in basic speech sounds. Then you speed up a tape on a VSC machine, its electronic circuitry removes redundant portions of the speech waveform and stretches the remaining pieces to fill the gaps. The trick is to delete portions short enough (20 to 10 milliseconds) to avoid a significant loss of continuity. Then the tape is slowed down, the electronic circuitry samples the speech waveform, compacts it, and fills the gaps produced by this compression with redundant waveform. It will be interesting to see what affect this "electronic editing" will have on music.

The VSC machine has a speed control that gradually changes the speed of the capstan motor and the compression/expansion ratio of the circuitry. VSC should be available shortly for approximately \$200.00 in the US. Hopefully, VSC circuitry will be available as "add on" equipment for those who already have tape recorders. PUBLISHERS' CORNER:.....

CPC Procedures & Comments

This season has proven to be one of the better ones of late in at least one respect, namely, the success of the Courtesy Programs Committee in providing the membership with notifications of more tests than in several previous seasons. We still see a proliferation of no-shows and "dedicated hour of program in regular schedule" items from one club in particular, which deserves comment. Stations which tell a CPC'er they will "ID more frequently" or "tell the DJ to verify all reports" do not really belong in the Test Schedule, as they are not tests. The primary purpose of the CPC is to report in tests which stations are planning to make which are of a sporadic nature, and which will feature predictable test formats, so that DX'ers may benefit from the advanced knowledge of them.

CPC'ers should endeavour to make use of opportunities when stations will be most likely to be running tests, namely, during and immediately after periods of equipment or facilities changes. The alert CPC'er should contact new stations as soon as they are noted ET'ing or on RS in DDXD. A new station is frequently going to be testing a lot to "shake out the bugs", and all DX'ers out of their area will need to log them. Simply writing to obtain dates and times of anticipated tests is a most useful project. The same principle applies to new power changes, pattern changes and so on. DDXD and the Log Updaters, as well as the "Flash Tips" columns are the best allies. If a CPC'er subscribes to Broadcasting, he is a good two or more weeks ahead of the game, for he can see the "Program Authorizations" column, which generally precedes RS for a new station by a few weeks.

Another valuable project would be trying to line up Proof of Performance test dates, as all stations are required to conduct such a test annually. If a station must make a test, the CPC'er can frequently gain notification in advance, and perhaps guide the CE in scheduling, because such a test should take into account the factor of how little interference it will cause, because this will be a consideration for the station. Naturally the less interference it will cause consideration will be related to how many other stations are on at the time, which will obviously be related in the opposite way to how much interference will be available to plague the DX'er. Suddenly, the two considerations dovetail, and the smart CPC'er will emphasize the consideration most important to the station.

Above all, CPC'ers should be mindful of the FCC rules as relate to tests, so that they do not request anything illegal of a station. Stations may NOT key their transmitters to achieve code, but they may key an oscillator onto a tape and then run it. They may not simulcast FM (although some do). They may NOT announce that it is anything but an equipment test, a proof, or a frequency check. Any other terminology is suspect. References to DX'ing, or to a radio club made on the air, while they are not specifically prohibited, are suspicious. A test which makes frequent reference of these facts is legal, but an over-zealous inspector might well infer that the test was primarily DX-oriented. Again, new operations have more latitude, for it is only normal for them to try to ascertain just how far and in what directions, their signal goes.

The standard CPC request should be oriented to the station. Rather than ask for a "special test", ask for pre-notification of an ET, PoP, f/c instead. This makes it easier for the station personnel, and you will get fewer flat refusals. If the tester will be playing music, it is perfectly reasonable for you to specify something "distinctive". (Over the years, march music has been about the most "distinctive" and likewise successfully used). Code ID's are required by some frequency monitors for f/c's to ID stations, and if done properly, are also legitimate. Keeping these points in mind will make for an even more successful OPC.

There is a phenomena which occurs on the daytime BCB which few DXers have reported or experienced to my knowledge. GPN discussed it in his article on midday DX - partual reflections from the daytime D-layer caused by vertical or laminer type electron density gradients. It amounts to this: DX via this day "skip" or skywave can net stations out to the 1200-1300 mile region. The time to look for it is llam to lpm local time ("high noon") & start on the clears if youv'e not experienced it before. My long experience with this phenomena says to expect stations at or N of your latitude & that if you live in low latitudes you may not experience this mechanism at all! Nebraska is an excellent location as I well discovered 1968-1974! In fact Dabelstein (Lincoln) and Nittler (McCook) are observing this year this type of DX quite regularly. It would be quite valuable to both your own DX log as well as provide the DX fraternity with valuable data provided it is reported (DX NEWS is excellent forum for that!) An example of this phenonema: KOA-850 disappeared at noon in deep Winter and CKRD-850 appeared with pice steady signal, then, when it went, it went out fast. The mechanism will supress stations on channel between RX & disant XR at 1000-1300 miles - i.e., stations under the reflection points (about 47 miles high) are too greatly absorbed to propagate to RX location. Try it and please report data to DX NEWS. It's there, but few day DX - we need more ears! Who will be the first to log an E-layer DAY hop? (on the BCB)

NOTES DEFT. : To RES, FRM, EDF: Last season, in late Spring, we ran numerous conments and edits about what constituted a valid logging distance-wise. The discussions at our May and Movember GTGs here in MJ seemed to gravitate to that as well. All of us, of course, realise that DX ing is an individual hobby, and that we can all set our own criteria to a great degree. Where one varies significantly from the norm, however, one may be likely to develop a magnetism for FLAK. Inamuch as distances of over 100 miles make no substantial ox changes in the plains states, and 50+ makes none in certain directions here or in Chic(after discussing this with HWB, we noted that depending on the direction we want, it would be anywhere from 10 to 75 miles before any substantial ox changes were noticed. ) yet as HKS (and others prior) have noted, sometimes changes across a room or upstairs will be significant. Here, one must use his judgement. THUSLY, all of us at HJFC, as well as Wes & Jerry are in unanimous agreement on one thing: if a DI'er deliberstaly goes sway from his QTH to take advantage of mulls or peaks for DA purposes. he is guilty of an unethical practice. If you are driving home and hear comething which stays in for a period of time, and does not only occur in one place, that may be different as you choose, but the other is a no-no by us. PT frequently kided me about WCNR-930 being sudible less than I mile from me at a stoplight, but I didn't count it 'til I had it here, Wes smiced if he was OK to delete all "DX" which falls into the above "deliberate" category, and we have approved. We view this as an attempt to circumvent the normal procedures of DX. Discussion invited.
