PHILIP EDERS A - 15570 Cleveland - Spring Lake, Michigan - 49456 ----- A couple of comments/obervations from the last couple DX NFT Ses. First, in the 12/4 issue's list of surset times for the states, an error was nade in Michigan. ALL Nichigan stations do not have a 5pm sunset time in December, only those in the Eastern 2/3 of the state do. Stations is Western ! ichigan, suca as in cities like Grani Farids, kiskegoa, Holland, Grand Haven, Manistee, etc. have a 5:15pm sunset time. Also Ermie: Code IDs are unquestionably ILLEGAL for broadcast stations. FCC rules promibit the broadcasting of any type of telegraphy over radiotelephone stations, in fact, there were a couple of stations cited by the FCC for using CIDs a couple of years ago. IECA had a big controversy over this for a while - and the resulting conclusion was that their CPC will no longer request CIDs. Finally, in answer to WILLIAM HALE's Muse in the 12/4 issue: Some stations licensed for unlimited operation do indeed have and use PSAs, even if their authorized nighttine power is more than 500 watts. The reason is their nighttime pattern is so restrictive that they actually give better coverage when they can power down to 500 watts at 6 a.m. and switch to their laytime (usually less restrictive or mondirectional) pattern. An example is WTRU-1600 which is 5,000/5,000 DA-N (U-2 -ERC) w/a PSA of 500w. They can actually cover parts of Muskegon better with 500w ND during PSA mours than they can w/5,000w DA. 73s. (At Conventions, we have discussed this with FCC men & they say CIDs CAN be used on TRSTs, so long as VIDs are given along with them - wen like Fobert W. Lee, I mean -ERC)

GOOD PEVERAGE SITES IN MASSACHUSETTS VARMONTELLY - 52 Ansden Street - Arlington, Lassackusetts - 02174 With the amplementation of the new TA & TP assignments and the increasing availability of top-grade portable DX gear, the desire for DX-peditions has increased. I shall present a DXpedition gaide to Massachusetts with the hope that others will come forward with similar guides to tasir areas. We should first characterise what makes a good location; warsh or salt water in the direction of interest & a minimum of power lines, buildings, and strong legal stations. Poor ground/aill blockage towards undesired reception areas is helpful. Non-PC stations may present problems through overlead, spurs, etc. - the LOTAN station en Mantucket & WCC in Chatnam may appet reception in twose areas. Specific TA-proven sites: Orleans/Easther Atlantic shore, especially Tonset Point; Marsafield/Scituate at mouth of the North River; Gleacester/Bockport, many good sites such as the Halibut Point Reservation. Cape Coi's saidy-scil pitc.-pine wooded coastal plain is ideal for Eeverages terminated at water's edge. It should be noted that North of Eastman, up to Provincetewn, QR. from the Nest, new over water, is strenger than it is in Orleans. LA-proven sites: Fest Dennis teach & march areas near Lewer County Food (between Eass River and Swan River) is LA CTE #1 in my opinion. Any of the Sentimard-facing beaches on Cape Cod, in general, will provide sood LA DX. Inland sites worth mentioning for general-purpose DXing include the Sulbury Piver at the Route 27 crossing (Wayland/Sudoury) and the Charles River marsh at Foute 109 ('edfield).
