After gaining authorization from the FCC for a power hike to 5,000 watts, Mr. O'Noil goved WJW to Cleveland mere it has occupied the 850 spot since Novenber $\mathrm{H}_{4}$ th, 1943. When coning to Cleveland WJW became affiliated with the ABC Network. Joining Storer Broadcasting roup on November 17the 1954. On December 31, 1957, WJW dropped its ABC ties and went inde an increase of powor to 10,000 watts. Its affiliation with NBC was scrapped on July 29, 1966 gain finding its indopendence.
