DX Catches in the U.S. and Canada, with 24-br. ELT

DDXD-West MEDIUM WAVE RAMBLINGS

- Some Canadian news from Broadcast Engineering: "CHSJ-700 Saint John will be moving fror AM to FM. The new transmitter will operate on 94.1 MHZ, with 50.4 KW. New Brunswick Broadcasting Co. Limited currently operates CHSJ-AM in Saint John, which will go dark three months after the FM is up and running. Both CIBX-FM and CIHI-AM/CKHJ-FM in Fredericton opposed the flip, prompting the Commission to impose the condition that CHSJ not solicit advertising from the Fredericton market. CHSJ-FM will also have to produce 110 hours of local programming every week."
- □ And some U.S. news ... "Two Washington-area firms bid a total of \$173 million at a government auction for the rights to provide a new breed of radio service that can be heard coast-to-coast and offers CD-quality reception. American Mobile Radio Corp., a unit of American Mobile Satellite Corp. of Reston, Va., placed a winning bid of \$89.9 million at a Federal Communications Commission sale for one of two licenses to offer digital audio radio. Washington-based CD Radio Inc. put down a top bid of \$83.3 million for the second license in a long-delayed -- and controversial -- auction limited to four companies. Digital radio, expected to be up and running by the latter half of 1999, will be beamed via satellite nationwide and will allow listeners to tune in anywhere in the country. It will be subscription-based and will offer listeners anywhere from 25 to 50 stations of music, news and other specialized programs. The small satellite antenna needed to tune in the broadcasts could be installed in cars, trucks and homes. People who drive a lot -- or who live in remote areas with few existing radio channels are considered prime candidates for the new service. CD radio expects to begin its service in the second half of 1999, offering 50 channels of programming. Most channels will be commercial-free and offer music." *Reuters/Variety*





Ben extemporizes: "Since most of Europe turned time ahead to Summer Time on MAR 30, one week ahead of us, there are 4 days left to listen to French, Italian and other stations sign on an hour earlier than regularly since their 0600 and 0500 sign on time is actually 0500 and 0400. Of course, things will even up when we too turn our clocks ahead. With that in mind I found good high end openings on APR 1 and 2 beginning around 0400 each night. The biggest signal was Vatican-1611 which has been coming on about 0420 and taking over 1610 and 1611 like a local. Last night several Italians were good at 0400 sign on, including 1035, 1116, 1332 and 1575. Both nights have brought in strong signals from French stations prior to their 0500 sign on, the best being 1557 and 1206. And on Sunday night [MAR 31] Nice-1557 and Paris-864 were on early at 0345 with religious music. Also in with super signals this week were Switzerland-1566, Vatican-1530 and Spain [mixed] on 1602. On the other hand, the low end of the band has been so-so, and the LW poor with a constant buzz."

Bruce speaks: "TA MW DX has really slacked off over the past couple of weeks. In addition to the detailed logs, just the usual stuff is being heard from home-base; Algeria-549, 891, Spain-684, 855, 1044, England-693, 909, 1053, 1089, 1215, Slovakia-1098, Croatia-1134, etc. In another couple of weeks it should be dry and warm enough for a Maine camping DXpedition. NEWFOUNDLAND DXPEDITION UNIDENTIFIED SIGNALS

- ARGENTINA: R. Buenos Aires 1350 "I have just seen the report from Felipe L.G. Flosi (Brasil), when he says that the unID station heard by Neil Kazaross in the Newfoundland DXpedition V, DX News #16, at 0140, is probably R. Buenos Aires from Argentina. And he adds that the station is airing at night a program of the Brazilian religious group "Igreja Universal de Reino Deus". I can confirm that the station R. Buenos Aires 1350 airs a program in the Portuguese language before midnight, I don't know if it is a religious one, but I certainly know that after midnight, local time, in Buenos Aires, they change to a program of tangos for seven hours (the station operates 24 hours, and I know that because I have received a recorded tape from a friend in Buenos Aires who recorded for me a 90 minute tape with tangos right at the start of the month of February 1997 (midnight January 31 February 1). During the conversdation the speaker mentioned the Brazilian program before midnight and the duration of the tango program, but he did not say that it was a religious one." [Objio-DR]
- ARGENTINA: unID 790 "I don't think this station can be Radio Mitre as mentioned by John Fisher, as this one is at Buenos Aires; most probably it is R. Nacional at San Salvador de Jujuy. This province, Jujuy, is the Argentinian northwesternmost province ... the mention he heard of "Colin de los Andes" may be a place located near or around the mountains. The pips on the exact hour is a signal usually heard on R. Nacional, this is another lead for IDing it as R. Nacional." [Objfo-DR]
- DOMINICAN REPUBLIC: unID 860 "Most probably this station is as stated by John Fisher, he has a feeling that it is Radio Clarín, but the program he heard is "Radio Mil Informando", a newsreel presented by Radio Mil 1180 and relayed by R. Clarín. See 1180 in the same report. [Objio-DR]

César habla: "One thing that helps a lot to ID a station from down in South America is the accent of the speaker. If you don't know how to ID that it is difficult, but if you can ID the accent you can almost always ID a country, and with it the station. I have had that experience as I can do that, but US citizens can't do that as I can't ID a Texas speaker from a Californian or Chicagoan, but you can do it, hi." (César is correct; there are vast differences in accent, pronunciation of letters, and vocabulary depending upon where you are in the Spanish-speaking world. When I traveled from Puerto Rico to the Dominican Republic about 15 years ago, there were quite a few differences evident even to my unsophisticated ears! - Jim)

STATION NEWS

CAYMAN ISLANDS (more): "Enjoyed Tom Bryant's Cayman Islands observations in IDXD 64-24.

It's been quite a few years since I was there, but at the time, I visited R. Cayman and Radio ICCI (college FMer). The 1205 antenna was a simple dipole above the studio building in downtown George Town, at least then. What I still often wonder is why the 1555 transmitter on East End wasn't immediately farmed out for revenue (and--for that matter--what the status of the equipment is). Certainly Gene Scott, the BBC and/or DW could have had a ready-made source many years before infiltrating other transmitter sites. I would like to think that the 99.9 MHz "Z-99" entry might make it here on a summer E-skip, at 5 kW." [Krueger-FL]

- LATVIA: Recent station news indicated Latvia now operating on 954, and this got me thinking. While up in Newfoundland we heard a station on this frequency which we couldn't identify. Jean thought the language sounded like Romanian, a woman talking and musical selections. We supposed at the time this was France on foreign service. Now I'm inclined to think Latvia. Bears watching. [Dangerfield-PA]

DX FILES: ROWLEY MINI-DXPEDITION

Mini-DXpedition: Rowley, MA (UTC: 8-9 APR 1997) Mark Connelly, WAIION

I hadn't done much with wire antennas on outdoor DXpeditions recently, so I decided to go out to the Rowley salt marsh site (Parker River National Wildlife Refuge) after work on Tuesday, 8 APR. Another objective of the trip was to view the Hale-Bopp comet from an area of relatively-low ambient light. The dirt road out to the site was in poor shape with serious ruts and potholes. I did manage to get in and out of there with no car damage by going at a very slow rate. The weather conditions were adequate (though not truly ideal) for DXing and astronomy. There were fast-moving clouds with adequate breaks between them to afford a view of the comet: it was seen best about an hour after sunset. The temperature was a bit cold by April standards (-3 C / +27 F), the wind was strong and gusty, and there was an occasional snowflake in the air. It's probably good that I DX'ed with wires lying on the ground rather than with the car-roof mounted loop / whip arrangement. Loops have been known to tip over or get blown off the roof during a strong coastal gale.

One wire (length approximately 80 m) was run easterly along the dirt path from the gate towards Nelson Island. Luckily the tide was not so high as to submerge the path this time around. The second wire, 40 m long, was run due south over some very wet salt marsh grass. As expected, the two wires at a right angle did produce usefully-different pick-up patterns.

Conditions were typical of those noted over the last few months: that is to say best towards the western Mediterranean, reasonable to the UK and other parts of western Europe, mediocre to the Caribbean, and comparatively poor to South America. Signals from Spain were especially loud. 1 was hoping for much more auroral effect (and resulting Africans / Brazilians), but such was not to be. The Rowley site tends to be biassed more towards Europe anyway. Africans do a bit better in Rockport and at Tom Beaton's house in Manchester-by-the-Sea and considerably better at South Yarmouth on the Cape because of a bit of blockage towards Europe at that site. Despite ordinary conditions, the DX outing was fun. The new Mini-DL-2 delay-line phaser worked great. Even many of the New York stations could be nulled adequately to reveal others underneath - e.g. St. Lucia heard through nulled WFAN-660. When signal levels were low, I inserted the Mini-MWT-3 regenerative preselector to bring post-null DX above the Drake R8A noise floor. European splits next to domestics sounded pretty good just on the east wire by itself, but they were really cleaned up when the two wires were phased. A chronological loggings list follows. Full-detail reports will be integrated with my "effort parallel to Hatteras" (loggings that I'll be doing from Cape Cod on

Saturday the 12th).

Rowley highlights included best-ever reception of Spain-1071 right next to strong CBA, Spain-1080 easily getting through WTIC, strong Spain-936, St. Lucia-660, and a beautiful signal from Bermuda-1160 (with only a weak bit of WOBM under). France on 1377 seems to be all-night schedule: it was often swamping St. Pierre - 1375. On the east wire Spain-855 had WEEI-850 beaten by about 10 dB ! Signals from the Iberian peninsula were THAT huge. Even though I didn't get the desired DX run into deep Africa, the outing was still enjoyable. Setting up a null on a station like WTAM-1100 gave a decent broadband west null cardioid all the way from 1000 to 1200 kHz. That's the beauty of delay-line phasing of wire antennas (rather than tuned sources such as loops). Minor resetting of knobs melted away QRM from WWVA-1170, WHAM-1180, and numerous other pests from the west.



"Veracruz is about six hours by car from Mexico City (or a short 50- minute flight) It is also a scenic 15-hour drive from Brownsville, Texas The organizers are hoping that DXers from the United States and elsewhere will come to Veracruz and make a vacation of their trip as well Good airfares are available to Mexico City or direct to Veracruz from several cities throughout North America
