
NRC's rep, Dave Schmidt.

No interval signal or time pips noted on hour. My Asian language expert's best guess from tape is Malay. I've been hearing a carrier here for years which never exhinited a null on the loop, characteristic of over-the-pole signals. The possibility of this being a South American can be ruled out since it is in sunlight at this time. The last time I had audio on this one was FEB 1975, but too weak to even guess at language. It is always heard at or after local sunrise in Thailand. 200 used to be hear dhere but was last noted at Christmas 1992 with carols and has apparently moved. WRTH lists 2RF here in Italian with 500 watts which is a possibility since 4QD was putting in a good signal on 1548 kHz. Language was definitely not Ilatian, however. My language expert does not have "Dxer's Ears" so I would appreciate someone familiar with Asian languages listening to the tape. If anyone is interested please let me know and I will ship out a tape right away. My local sunrise is 1210, by the way. [Moore-FL] (Ray's address is 1288 River Bend Drie, La Belle FL 33935 - Jim)

Ray speaks: "This has been the poorest season in years for "down under" stations. The only redeeming feature has been three exotic catches: Majuro, Marshall Islands 1098 kHZ on AUG 13, the Japan opening on DEC 26-29, and the above, whatever it is."
