porter with the station since the '50's, died on at the age of 63. Stienbach died from cancer, but he also had lung and esophagus problems. He began his career in the late '50's after graduating from Duquesene University with Group W's Washington bureau. He returned to Pittsburgh and KDKA in 1960. Steinbach had been known for being on the air during the John F. and Robert Kennedy assassinations, the Challenger explosion in 1986, and more recently the blizzard of 1993. Also during his tenure, he was on the national board for American Federation Of Radio and Television Artists as well as serving four terms as president of the Pittsburgh Press Club.

10 years ago ... from the October 3, 1988 DXN: Dallas Lankford and Fritz Mellburg reviewed the Collins 51J4 receiver.



#### WCHB To Upgrade Signal Station, Will Temporarily Be Off The Air

WCHB (1200 AM), which provides Detroit with urban talk programming, will be off the air for the next two to three months while it upgrades its signal.

The Radio One-owned station, which flipped the on-off switch to the downward position last Wednesday (August 5) evening, will boost its signal to 50,000 watts during the day and 15,000 watts at night. At the time it went off the air, WCHB was operating on a 25,000-watt signal during days, dropping to 700 watts once the sun went down.

Officials at Radio One admitted that the station is currently losing money and will spend the down time recruiting a new operating team for the station.

WCHB-FM, the AM station's urban-contemporary sister, will not be affected by the signal upgrade.

WNHC-CT-1340 returned to the air on 9/15 at 0600 with programming run by Yale students: alternative rock, blues, jazz, football games, and local talk. WCFR-VT-1480 is now business news, ex-NOS. WNSH-MA-1570 is back on the air after six weeks silence due to a lightning strike at the transmitter site. WASB-NY-1590 is still popping on and off the air randomly, no set schedule yet.

#### STATION NEWS

- CARIBBEAN: Hurricane Georges is in the news as this column is being prepared, with devastating winds, destruction and loss of life in St. Kitts, Puerto Rico, Dominican Republic, Haiti and Florida. Glenn Hauser has noted, in his e-mail summary, that Gene Scott's Shortwave operation in Anguilla appeared to be off the air, and it is possible that other islands have been similarly affected, especially if the electrical grid has gone down. {Renfrew-NY]
- KALININGRAD / NETHERLANDS: For nearly a week now Business Radio has been operating from Holland on 1395 kHz. It is NOT operating 24hrs a day whereas its predecessor, Talk Radio, did. Also UCB has stopped using 1386 kHz from Russia which was formerly active to until 2300UTC. That means through the night from about 2200UTC, 1390kHz is once again a very clear DX channel in NW Europe. The only possible interference is from Greece on 1386kHz. 1390 is a regional channel in N American so it is not dominated by any 50kW monsters. Therefore there is a wide range of stations that can be heard in Europe. [Steve Whitt, UK, e-mail]

# **DXpedition to Mt. Megunticook**

Hoping for a Newfie-like experience, I headed out to Camden Hills State Park in Maine for a camping DXpedition on the shore at the base of Mount Megunticook August 20-22, 1998. Unfortunately, the weather would not cooperate as thunderstorms stretching from upstate New York across northern New England made reception difficult due to the high noise floor. It rained all night on the 21st, with nature providing the fireworks for most the night instead of the radio. A stagnant weather front continued to make listening difficult the following night.

Despite the poor weather conditions not being conducive to DXing, the coastal location provided for some good transatlantic and Latin American DX. Overall conditions mirrored that of the "DX Clams" outing in Rowley, Massachusetts a couple of weeks ago, with poor reception from the Middle East and much of Europe, and Spain dominant on many frequencies. No reception of Argentina or Brazil either, just the typical Latin Americans from Colombia and Venezuela for the most part.

While I usually wouldn't bother listing so many stations from Spain, I've indicated most of them here for the record and just to illustrate the magnitude of reception. From my perspective, the most interesting loggings from the two nights in Maine are Libya-1251 with three SW parallels, and two unID Latin American stations at 550 and 1190 which might be worth chasing from home or coastal car DX outings.
