- 890 CUBA Radio Progreso, NOV 18 0258 SS, very good with ballads, fanfare, ID on hour as ... "Radio Progresso. Havana Cuba". [Ross-ON]
- 910 VENEZUELA YVRQ Caracas, NOV 13 0307-0345 with strong signal, play-by-play beisbol game, between the Caribes and the Tiburones. [Renfrew-NY] NOV 18 0327-0353 fair in long fades. SS male playing adult SS vocals. No ID heard, and at 0352 as the song ended there was a brief jingle and abruptly, they aired the YV National Anthem, sung by a chorus. Gone at 0353. [Funkenhauser-ON]
- 910 COLOMBIA HJMY RCN, Isla San Andres, OCT 28 0450 poor at best. SS talk, mentions of RCN, then // programs heard on 770 and 1000 at 0454. Heard a couple of times this summer while at my cottage, though I didn't record it in my log book then. New. [Funkenhauser-ON] (I tried for this many times this month without a hint of RCN! Jim)
- 920 MEXICO XEMJ, Piedras Negras, COAH, NOV 16 0300 Legal ID with call, freq, power (1000 w.). Very poor in QRM, but a newie 150th XE!! [Wilkins-CO1]
- 920.2 COLOMBIA HJJN Ondas del Mayo Pasto, NOV 18 0224-0235 poor and fadey. IDed only by frequency (slightly low of 920.2) with lots of SS talk. [Funkenhauser-ON] (Werner, Emisora Fuentes has been heard on 920.17 by Terry Krueger and myself, not HJJN Jim)
- 940 UNID unID Latin, NOV 8 0530-0601 poor-fair at most w/co-channel Reloj & XEQ. SS male playing torchy tango vocals with brief talks to an 0558 fanfare or musical ad. 5 pips at 0559, more talk (a possible ID) in a fade. Might have been YVNN but sure didn't sound like the usual raunchy R. Punto Fijo Saturday night stuff. [Funkenhauser-ON]
- 1000 COLOMBIA RCN Cartagena, NOV 9 0456 Apparent ads including one in Miami, time pips at 0458 then song by Chuck Mangione. [Sgrulletta-NY] NOV 18 0304 SS, very good with man speaking SS, many ments of "Colombia", lots of "Banco Popular" ads. "En Colombia...El Mundo" woman with spot for "Noticias". Local time check. [Ross-ON]
- 1000 MEXICO XEFV Ciudad Juarez, Chihuahua, NOV 17 0357 Ranchera music with station ID at top of hour. Fading under KOMO. [Robello-UT]
- 1000 DOMINICAN REPUBLIC HION R. Cadena de Noticias, Sto. Domingo, NOV 10 0543-0551 fair-good. SS, many ads, many 'Cadena de Noticias' jingles and spots, but few 'noticias'. [Funkenhauser-ON]
- 1030.1 UNID unID Latin, NOV 19 0215-0300+ very weak under/with 1030 HJER RCN Cali in a WBZ null. SS in long fades, male/female and male/male discussions, seemingly gospel with a couple of SS songs. Very difficult to hear as HJER aired 'futbol' (which was // on HJAQ-1000), by the usual impassioned announcers The Icom only gives .1 kHz frequency resolution, but the PLAM detector clearly locked and stayed locked on this signal, which was just below 1030.1. Seemed off after 0300. [Funkenhauser-ON]
- 1110 COLOMBIA RCN Villavicencio, NOV 20 0319 weak but parallel to RCN 1000 with sports coverage, including post-game interview with Oscar Cortéz, ad for Publicar, SA; new! A Venezuelan station could also be heard underneath this one with AST timechecks, some sports news about Venezuelan teams probably R. Carúpano. [Renfrew-NY]
- 1130 COLOMBIAHJAC Barranquilla, NOV 200358 Sure did sound like "Radio K, Cadena Nacional" (which would be the Bogotá station), but they also mentioned "HJAC" call letters before the Colombian anthem, so this one is Emisora Riomar. I believe they signed off at this time, which is one hour earlier than shown in the WRTH. [Renfrew-NY]
- 1130 VENEZUELA R. Ideal, Maiquetía, NOV 20 0700 romantic music program, nice, clear ID and AST time check at the top of the hour as "Radio Ideal, trés en punto", new! [Renfrew-NY]
- 1170 COLOMBIA HJNW, CARACOL Cartagena, NOV 18 0250 fair, // 5078. SS, "Hora Colombia" news program with "CARACOL" spots. [Funkenhauser-ON]
- 1410 MEXICO XECF, Los Mochis, SIN, NOV 10 0550 XE banda music, "La Mexicana" slogans, call ID at 0601. Also heard "La Perla del Pacifico" mentioned, but might have been a song title, rather than a slogan. Chased this for 3 nights before finally ID'ing it, XE #148, SIN #13. [Wilkins-CO]
- 1570 MEXICO XERF, Cd. Acuna (tentative): OCT 23 0502 very poor with another SS station and other co-channel QRM. Caught the ending of and instrumental version of the XE National Anthem but lost to the clutter. [Funkenhauser-ON]

John speaks: "I've reached the 2 goals I set out to attain this season - 1400 total stations and 150 XE stations. Guess I can "retire" now."

Werner speaks: There were excellent auroral enhancement on NOV 8, 9, 10, 11. Conditions continued to be good, though much less, even until today. Also, the period several days before and several days after OCT 22 was quite productive. How sweet it is! After returning from all that DX in Newfoundland, it's been especially nice, because I was looking forward to a dry DX well in Ontario. In the month or so after my return, I've logged a bunch — Caribbean splits, Colombians, Cubans, Mexicans and Venezuelans aplenty. Most were re-logs, though many not heard in a while, and I even managed a few new ones. "


