downloading and studying a copy of the "Guidebook", which covers non-DX News contributions for NRC Publications, also; at the least, you could save yourself some typing time.

Gary Atkins, Louisville, KY, asked, "Why do all the good DX'ers seem to leave Kentucky? First Jerry Conrad, then Larry Cowles, and lately, Dan Phillips ... Next thing you know Dick Truax will be packing his bags and moving."

10 years ago ... from the Monday, February 13, 1989 DXN: Cesar Objio reported that both his frequency counter and his DX-400 were inoperable ... George Santulli, Leesburg, VA reported hearing a "K" call in KCTA-1030 signing off above WBZ on January 12 . Gene Martin, Denver, reported that intense solar activity January 11 through 16 prompted him to explore the high band on the 11th, and he bagged the two

Australians on 1629, and again on the 14th and 15th.
