From the January 31, 1959 DXN; "Pat" Reilly, Jamestown, NY reported that he woke up to a rooster crowing on PJC7-1-1010 at 0430 and a clock chiming 0500, 1/2 hour ahead of EST, logged for a very nice report to a new country.

25 years ago ... from the January 30, 1984 DXN: Matt Stutterheim, Montauk, NY tentatively claimed hearing Ecuadorians on 735 and 805 kHz, both on 1/8.

10 years ago ... from the February 1, 1999 DXN: WREN-1250, Topeka, was purchased by Entercom and was to be moved to Kansas City.


