**EMMIS ENDS PURCHASING DRYSPELL.** . . . Emmis Broadcasting is buying up three more stations in St. Louis. It's buying Zimmer Radio Group's CHR simulcast WKBQ, St. Louis and WKBQ-FM, Jerseyville, IL, as well as country WKKX, Granite City, IL for \$42.5 million. Emmis owns rocker KSHE, Crestwood, MO there. An LMA will start December 1. Zimmer plans to use the proceeds to fund expansion in cellular and long distance businesses. Media Services Group brokered the deal.

**CLEAR CHANNEL'S "BAYOU BABY"** . . . Clear Channel Communications adds another FM to its collection in New Orleans with the purchase of KHOM, Houma, LA. KHOM Associates will get an undisclosed amount for the station, which broadcasts a CHR format. The purchase will give Clear Channel the maximum number of FM's it can own there. It has new rock KKND, Pt. Sulphur; and country WNOE-FM, urban AC WYLD-FM, and urban WQUE-FM, all New Orleans... It also owns two AM's there--blues WODT and black gospel WYLD.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

The Commission reviewed a complaint filed by Media Access Project (MAP) on behalf of the Committee to Support the Oregon Health Plan against radio stations KKCW(FM), KXL(AM) & KEX(AM), Portland, OR; KUGN AM & FM, Eugene, OR & KRWQ(FM), Gold Hill, OR. According to the complaint, the stations aired ads opposing an Oregon ballot proposition increasing taxes on cigarettes & other tobacco products. The ads identify "Fairness Matters to Oregonians Committee (FMOC)" as the sponsor.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)**

Media contended all but \$20 raised by FMOC was donated by the Tobacco Institute, that its sole members were registered with the State of Oregon as lobbyists for R.J. Reynolds, that the IRS shows that R.J. Reynolds is the largest single contributor to the Tobacco Institute & addresses & phone numbers for FMOC are the same as for the FMOC directors' lobbying firm. The Commission contacted each station by phone, asking for a response before ruling that future broadcasts should not air without disclosing the Tobacco Institute as the sponsor. No sanctions were issued against the stations.

The Commission found in favor of Concord Area Broadcasting's KRHT(AM), Concord, CA, who was ordered to show cause why the station's license should not be revoked due to its silent status & whether they have the capability & intent to expeditiously resume broadcast operations. Concord suspended operations on Jan. 31, 1993 due to financial difficulties and the loss of the transmitter site lease. KRHT was on the list to migrate to the expanded AM band allowing it to operate non-directionally, requiring far less land & more flexibility in selecting a transmitter site & was awaiting FCC approval. The Commission found the delay in returning to air "reasonable."

Petition for reconsideration of renewal grant conditions by Sunshine Wireless Co., Inc. licensee of WQAM(AM), Miami, FL and WKIS(FM), Boca Raton were denied this week. The stations maintain studios in Hollywood, FL & were directed by the Commission to use Miami for EEO performance evaluations where it had previously used the Ft. Lauderdale market. Sunshine claimed that the majority of its workforce is drawn from the Ft. Lauderdale, Hollywood & Boca Raton areas. The Commission found that some recruitment had in fact occurred in Miami; Miami had the largest minority labor force; the stations broadcast to the Miami area; and WQAM's transmitter is located in Miami.

The Commission granted The Great Duluth Broadcasting Company, Inc.'s KQDS-AM & FM, Duluth, MN, permanent waiver of the Commission's one-to-a-market rule. Shockley Communications Corp. filed a petition to deny the transfer. The application will transfer control of 91% of the stock of Great Duluth to KQDS, Inc. Anthony J. Fant, KQDS's principal is also 100% owner of Fant Broadcasting Co. of MN, Inc., the permittee of new independent UHF TV KNLD. KQDS submitted evidence of the cost savings in operating from a common tower, rents, utilities, taxes, office equipment, salaries and operating expenses and that the proposed combination will not create any undue concentration of ownership in the market.

Cloud Nine Broadcasting, licensee of KDBR(FM), Kalispell, MT petitioned the Commission for reconsideration of the grant for modification of the facilities of Radio 2000 Inc.'s KCWX(FM), Columbia Falls, MT. Cloud Nine claimed Radio 2000 had failed to notify the FAA of the proposed upgrade, that Commission staff failed to afford the 30-day period for filing petitions to deny, and the time for amendments had expired. The Commission said it was a "first come, first serve" application and found no evidence of noncompliance with the Commission's site availability certification requirements and denied KDBR's petition.

In granting the renewal of Western Cities Broadcasting, Inc.'s KQKS(FM) in Longmont, CO, the Commission dismissed competing applications and Supplement to Opposition filed by Eldorado Communications and approved a Joint Request for an Approval of Merger Agreement filed by Western Cities, Amador S. Bustos, Longmont Broadcasting Corporation, and St. Vrain Communications Co. The Commission further approved a Joint Request for Approval of Agreement filed by Eldorado and Western Cities. A Minor change app. for the station was dismissed.

**ELSEWHERE**

Osborn is making its first purchase in the Tuscaloosa market, picking up Tuscaloosa Broadcasting Company's country WTXT, Fayette, AL. Purchase price is \$5.1 million. Osborn's only other Alabama properties are a combo in the Gadsden market.

Further south, in Montgomery, Benchmark Communications is buying WZHT and WMCZ, Montgomery from Capital Communications, which is a partnership between New South Communications and Ron Eubanks, the stations' GM. Price is \$17.75 million. It's the first purchase for Benchmark in the market.

Mike Shott's New Adventure Communications is doubling up in its home market of Bluefield, WV with the purchase of Country Broadcasting Corp.'s talker WKOY, Bluefield, and gold-based AC WKMY, Princeton, WV. Adventure already owns news-talker WHIS and hot AC WHAJ, Bluefield. Shott paid \$675,000 for the combo. The deal was brokered by Ray Rosenblum.

Primedia Broadcast Group spent \$12 million to buy up three Puerto Rico stations from Cadena Esterotempo. The deal nets Primedia WIOA, San Juan; WIOB, Mayaguez; and WIOC, Ponce. Media Venture Partners handled the transaction.

Arbitron has announced it will delete two diaries used in the Charleston, SC Summer '96 book that went to a single household where one of the residents was affiliated with a local radio station. The diaries were placed in Charleston county. The revised report will be mailed November 11.

SportsFan Radio has purchased the remainder of Major Network's Sports line-up. The purchase includes John Madden's Sports Quiz and Sports Calendar, Bob Costas, "Costas Coast-to-Coast", Pat O'Brien's SportsFan Report and SportsFan Flashback. Metro Networks, Inc. announced the acquisition of the traffic reporting operations of Wisconsin Information Systems, Inc., which serves radio and TV stations in Oklahoma City, Albuquerque, Omaha and Milwaukee.

And you thought there was nothing you could do about it. . .Bott Broadcasting announced that it would donate all advertising revenue it's stations received from the Clinton/Gore campaign to pro-life/crisis pregnancy groups. All radio stations are required under federal election laws to run the ads for any qualified candidate. The company strongly questioned the sincerity of the ads which claim that President Clinton is in favor of a complete ban on late-term abortions, except in the case of the life or health of the mother.

The Winter 1997 Station Information Packet is being mailed by Arbitron to radio stations in the 94 markets measured four times a year. The packet contains a Station Information Form, Programming Schedules and a Sports Schedule, if applicable. When completed, the packet should be returned to Arbitron by Dec. 2.

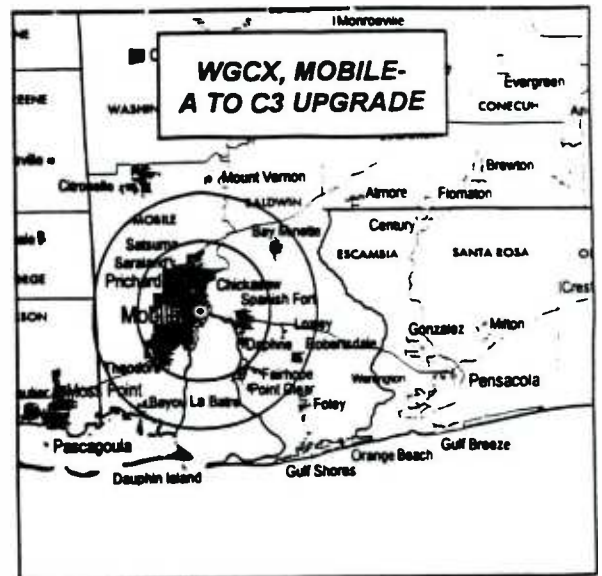
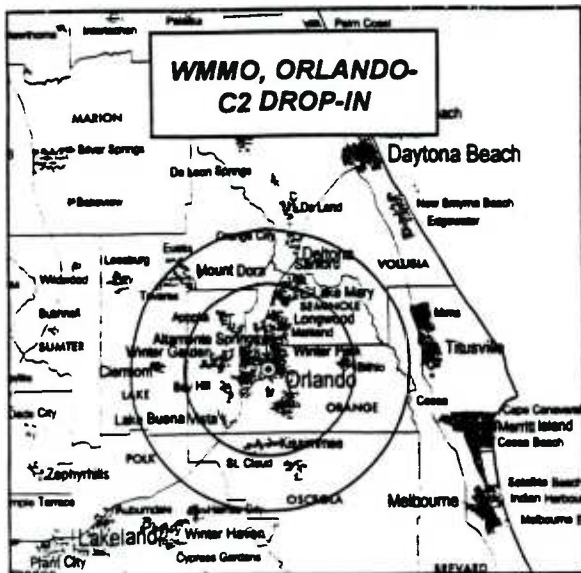

**FIRST HURDLE PASSED FOR WESTINGHOUSE AND INFINITY. . .** The Justice Department approved the merger of Westinghouse and Infinity. Only two radio stations will have to be spun off--alternative WBOS, Brookline, MA (Boston) and classic rocker WMMR, Philadelphia. The DOJ based the decision on the "40% threshold," allowing the combined company to handle about 40% of each market's revenue. The FCC has not yet approved the deal, which would give the combined group 79 radio stations in 17 markets. The decision makes clear the DOJ will continue to consider deals based on competition for radio advertising dollars, not other media like TV and print. Westinghouse and Infinity Boards have scheduled shareholder meetings for December 10 to vote on the deal.

**HEAR TODAY, GONE TOMORROW. . .** 70's oldies outlet WDBS, Bolingbroke, GA (Macon) has been ordered to cease operations after failing to construct the new station before its construction permit expired. Joseph Kendrick filed an application for review of the canceled CP for the station, which was denied. WDBS was originally ordered to cease operations on April 30 after failing to construct during the authorized period. Although Kendrick argued that he had completed construction and begun operations, the Commission found that Kendrick constructed after the permit expired and that most of the construction occurred after cancellation.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

Quality Broadcasting, Inc.'s WNEX(AM), Macon, GA has been designated for hearing by the Commission due to its silent status. The station claimed the studio was destroyed by fire in Aug. 1994, and since then, the station has been vandalized several times. Quality further claimed an intent to assign the license to the licensee's son, but FCC records reveal that no transfer application has been filed to date. WNEX has 20 days to file a written appearance to appear on the date fixed for hearing and present evidence on the issues.

The Commission revoked the license of Lamoille Broadcasting & Comms.' WSJR(AM), Madawaska, ME. Lamoille was ordered to show cause why the license should not be revoked due to its silent status and their capability and intent to expeditiously resume broadcast operations but failed to file the requisite notice of appearance. WSJR has been off the air since Mar. 7, 1994 and without authority since Sept. 1, 1995. Lamoille also owns WLVC, Fort Kent, ME, which has been silent since 1994 as well, but no decision has been issued on that station. Also failing to file was Missouri Valley Productions' KLEH(AM), Anamosa, IA. KLEH was off the air without authority since February 21, 1995. The Commission concluded that Missouri Valley had no intention to resume broadcast operations and deleted the call letters.

License renewal for Desert Broadcasting Corp.'s KZAL(FM), Desert Center, CA has been designated for hearing by the Commission. Desert stated, in its last ownership report, filed on Feb. 15, 1991, that Eugene White and Ralph Savage each held 40% interest. On May 20, 1991, White entered a guilty plea in Florida and North Carolina state courts to charges of racketeering, fraud and sales of unregistered securities and was sentenced to 12 years in prison. In Oct. 1992, Savage also entered guilty pleas to similar charges. However, on Jan. 29, 1993, the date Savage was to appear in NC for sentencing, he committed suicide. Desert did not report any of the foregoing information to the Commission. White's and Savage's convictions were based upon their activities as directors of Sunrise Management Services, Inc. Those activities involved the sales of interests in partnerships that filed construction permit apps for FM broadcast stations. Section 1.65(c) of the Rules requires that broadcast licensees report annually any adverse finding or final action bearing on the licensee's character qualifications that would be reportable in connection with license renewal. KZAL has been off the air for more than three years claiming a loss of its transmitter site, a "financially-strapped" condition and that the station is searching for a buyer.



**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)**

Zephyr Broadcasting, Inc. was denied reconsideration by the Commission for an extension of time to construct station WENL(FM), Gladstone, MI. Zephyr claims financial hardship including cancellation of its credit line and loss of transmitter site as the reasons for the delay in construction. Although the Commission found no intentional deception, Zephyr was admonished for its conduct during the construction period.

The Commission denied CAM Broadcasting, Inc.'s application for review of a CP to a new Class A FM station on 102.1 in Sylvester, GA. CAM was disqualified on a financial issue. The application for the station was granted to Thomas W. Lawhorne.

The license was canceled and call letters deleted for Evergreen Media's KNFL(AM), Tremonton, UT at the licensee's request. The 5,000 watt station on 1470 KHz is silent.

Waterman Broadcasting's KTFM, San Antonio, TX was hit with a \$7,500 fine for airing Prince's "Erotic City" unedited in afternoon drive. Radio & Records reports the Commission raised the price \$2,500 from what it would normally charge because it had judged the lyrics of that particular song to be obscene in a previous case.

The Federal Trade Commission, which is eying recent super-duops along with the Justice Department, has decided to approve several recent transfer filings, clearing any anti-trust issues under consideration. Inside Radio reports the approvals come as the Hart-Scott-Rodino anti-trust act was allowed to expire, clearing the way for several pending deals.

The Commission shut down a pirate radio station in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area operating on 97.7 MHz as "The Beat." U.S. Marshals confiscated the transmitter and other broadcast equipment. The identity of the operator of the pirate station was unavailable at presstime.

The Commission is rethinking its methodology for assessing annual regulatory fees. The current schedule is based on the type of station and its class. One proposal, submitted by the Montana Broadcasters Association, utilizes broad groupings of radio markets determined by Arbitron market size and proposes four classifications: Markets 1-25, 26-50, 51-100 and remaining markets. Comments and replies should be sent to the Office of the Secretary, FCC, Washington, DC 20554 within 30 days.

The Commission is also seeking further comment in its review of the broadcast attribution rules. These rules are intended to identify those interests that give their holders a degree of influence or control affecting programming decisions or other core operating functions of licensees. Comments should address: (1) How ownership rule revisions should affect the Commission's review of the attribution rules, (2) whether a new attribution rule should be added to the current rules which would limit, but not eliminate, the single-majority shareholder and non-voting stock exceptions to the rules and (3) attribution of Local Marketing Agreements and joint sales agreements in specified circumstances.

**ELSEWHERE**

As expected, Westinghouse Electric Corporation has decided to split off the broadcasting division into a completely separate company. The newly-dubbed Westinghouse Broadcasting will be based in New York and will retain the services of Westinghouse Chairman Michael Jordan. Jordan chose to leave the other newly-created division, "WELCO", which will handle its industrial products and consumer goods. Infinity President Mel Karmazin will handle the radio side. WELCO's headquarters will remain in Pittsburgh.

American General Media is beefing up in the Boise market with the purchase of Boise Viking Media's classic rocker KJOT and standards KGEM, both Boise; and new rock KQXR, Payette, ID for \$5.1 million. AGM already owns KCID (FM) in the market, but the station is silent. The deal brings AGM's total to 20 owned stations.

Buckley Broadcasting is making a comparatively small purchase in the southeast Connecticut market. It's buying WSNG, Torrington, CT from the U.S. Small Business Administration for \$425,000. The station is on 610 KHz with 1,000 watts days and 500 watts nights, but is currently silent. Buckley owns WOR, New York; WDRC-AM & FM, Hartford, and others.

J & K Broadcasting is buying country combo WMON and WZKM, Montgomery, WV and country WVAR, Richwood, WV from R & S Broadcasting for \$210,000. J & K owns southern gospel WAFD, Webster Springs, WV. R & S will keep its hot AC outlet, WCWV, Summersville, WV. Ray Rosenblum brokered the deal.

Interep's Allied Radio Partners has acquired Regional Rep Services, Inc., an independent rep firm serving stations in the Pacific Northwest. Regional Reps is the parent company of the Intermountain Radio Network. Terms of the deal were not disclosed. The group's sales offices in Seattle and Portland will move in with Allied in those cities.

Children's Broadcasting Corporation has secured \$15 million in cash for working capital and for acquisitions from Foothill Capital Corporation, a division of Norwest. The deal is expected to close this month.

The Chicago Bears have a new flagship radio station--CBS' WMAQ. The station won the rights from Tribune Broadcasting's WGN, which gave up the rights by choosing to exercise an out clause in the contract. Purchase price for the rights was not disclosed.

**M STREET BAZAAR. . .PEOPLE, PRODUCTS, AND PROGRAMMING**

A new Spanish talk network will hit the airwaves soon. The venture, "Radio Unica," will feature talk and sports programming, plus hourly newscasts, 24 hours a day. Hispanic Media Update reports the web will launch April 1, 1997 and will feature mostly U.S.-produced programming, but will broadcast some Mexican fare, as well. Former Univision and Telemundo CEO Joaquin Blaya will run the network, which will be based in Los Angeles.

SportsFan Radio Network has unveiled "Classic Costas Coast To Coast," a series of the best shows from sportscaster Bob Costas' over the last ten years. WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission granted a temporary 18-month waiver of the Radio-Newspaper cross-ownership rules for Stauffer Communications, Inc. to allow common ownership of WIBW (AM) & FM and the Topeka Capital Journal in Topeka, KS and KGNC (AM) & FM and the Amarillo Daily News-Globe Times in Amarillo, TX. The grant is subject to the condition that within 12 months of the date of consummation of the proposed transfer of the stations from the Stauffer Topeka Radio Trust to Stauffer Communications, Inc., Stauffer has filed an application for Commission consent to assign the stations to a new party.

The Commission reinstated and is expeditiously processing a minor modification application filed by Southwestern Broadcasting Corp., licensee of KLZK(FM), Brownfield, TX. KLZK has been silent for 3 years and was notified its license will terminate automatically if it does not resume operations before Feb. 9, 1997. After receiving the FCC letter, KLZK promptly obtained a new transmitter site, prepared a projection of expenses and obtained a bank letter to cover the costs of construction and initial operation. It is estimated to take about sixty days to construct the proposed facilities so the modification application must be granted by Dec. 6 in order to get on the air by the deadline. Until that time, renewal of the license will be held in abeyance.

ELSEWHERE

EZ Communications will get \$10 million for talker KSD (AM), St. Louis. The Dorsey Group agreed to buy the station--it's first in that market. EZ paid \$15 million for the station and its sister, rocker KSD-FM in 1993. Dorsey has been closely associated with talker WIBV, Belleville, IL and much of their programming is expected to move to KSD.

Mortenson Broadcasting makes two big purchases this week. It's picking up Entercom's 50,000 watt country WDSY, Pittsburgh and gospel KKGW, Gladstone, MO serving the Kansas City market. Terms weren't disclosed. LMA's began this week.

McGraw Communications is expanding its reach into northern West Virginia with the purchase of Cat Radio's country trimulcast of WBUC-AM & FM, Buckhannon and WVUC, Barrackville. Cat will get \$1.3 million for the stations, which will give McGraw a duopoly with oldies WBTQ, Buckhannon and AC WELK-FM, Elkins, WV. Ray Rosenblum brokered the deal.

Eric Straus' Straus Media Group is duopolizing in the Poughkeepsie market. It's buying Dutchess Communications' news-talker WKIP and AC WRNQ, both Poughkeepsie. Straus owns news-talk WELV and country WTHN, Ellenville, NY. The stations serve both Poughkeepsie and the Mid-Hudson Valley. Purchase price is \$3.475 million and includes the right to assign the current LMA with progressive WNSX, Poughkeepsie. Blackburn & Company brokered the deal.

Ken Kendrick is selling his family-owned group of four stations in the Four Corners market. Talker KENN and classic rock KRWN, Farmington, NM and oldies KDGQ and country KWXA, Durango, CO will go to Roberts Radio for an undisclosed amount. Roberts is partially-owned by former MTV Chairman and current President of America On-Line Bob Pittman. Kalil & Co. brokered the transaction.

Beasley Communications is adding another station to its collection in the Augusta, GA market. Frank Copsidas, Jr.'s GMR Broadcasting will sell new rock WCHZ, Harlem, GA for \$1.2 million. Beasley owns oldies WGOR, Martinez; standards WAJY, New Ellenton; and talker WGAC, Augusta.

The terms of the deal have changed, but SFX Broadcasting is getting ready to close on Multi-Market Radio. The expected closing date for the merger will be November 22, immediately following the meetings of both companies' shareholders. Because of the trading terms of the deal, Multi-Market shareholders will receive .2983 shares of SFX Class A Common stock, which is approximately ten percent less than the original exchange ratio.

The Interep Radio store unveiled a new program, PlayRadio, which offers customized, radio-driven Internet promotions to national advertisers. Hot link buttons will be added to existing radio station web sites to enable consumer browsers to connect to an Interep-run PlayRadio site which has been customized to the radio station and the advertiser-sponsored promotion. **WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

Former licensee of KFMS(AM)/KFMS-FM, Las Vegas, NV, Broadcast Associates, Inc., has been ordered to pay a \$15,000 forfeiture for violation of the Commission's EEO Rule. The forfeiture was originally set for \$25,000. The Commission granted short-term license renewals and imposed reporting conditions upon the stations.

Radio Communicators Inc.'s WINL-FM, Linden, AL license renewal was granted and a Notice of Apparent Liability issued for \$8,000 plus reporting conditions by the Commission for EEO violations. The Commission found that there was no evidence of employment discrimination but found the licensee's recruitment efforts deficient.

The California Branch of the NAACP lost its effort to deny the rescission of a notice of apparent liability and the granted renewals for Pinnacle Communications, Inc.'s KTMS/KHTY-FM, Santa Barbara, CA. The Commission concluded that the current liabilities of the station exceed its current assets and the ability to pay may be properly considered in mitigation of a forfeiture. The Commission also found Pinnacle's minority employment exceeded the Rule and policy requirements.

An application for Review filed by New South Communications, Inc. was denied regarding the Commission's decision which granted the application to assign the license of KMYT, Monroe, LA from Opus Media Group, Inc. to Radioactive Images, Inc. New South argued that its petition to deny presented documented allegations demonstrating that Opus and Radioactive violated the EEO Rule and policies. In response, Radioactive stated that the organizations listed in the Program Report are illustrative, and do not represent a commitment to contact any particular organization. In addition, New South has alleged failure to comply by a "minority-owned, minority-programmed, and predominantly minority-staffed radio station." The Commission found that New South did not provide documentation in a timely manner and there was no evidence that Wilkinson's submissions demonstrate misrepresentation.

Under His Direction, Inc.'s KHUD (AM), Port Neches, TX was ordered to show cause whether the station had the capability and intent to expeditiously resume broadcast operations, whether it violated Commission rules and is qualified remain the licensee. Because of financial difficulties, UHD took the station dark on Aug. 18, 1994. The Commission granted special temporary authority to remain silent until July 25, 1995. On Feb. 25, 1995, the assets of the station located at its tower site, including the station's tower and transmitter, were seized by Janet Chance, owner of the site. UHD then entered into negotiations with the Church of the Christian Crusade (CCC), the former licensee of the station, to assign the license back to CCC in consideration of CCC's forgiveness of the debt owed to it by UHD. CCC informed UHD that it had negotiated an agreement with Mrs. Chance to take back the station's assets in consideration of payment of the back rent. UHD notified the Commission that an application for transfer of control would be filed within 30 days and requested an additional extension to expire Feb. 2, 1996. During this time, the Castros expressed interest in buying the station but UHD's legal counsel advised against it. Therefore, UHD contacted the Castros and advised them they would have to make arrangements with the owners of the studio and transmitter sites before they could acquire the station's license. By the end of March, the Castros incorporated Vision and made the necessary arrangements and filed to assignment application on May 24, 1996. The Commission concluded that by way of its proposed license assignment to Vision Latina, Inc, KUHD has both the capability and intent to return to air. UHD violated the Rules but the violation was of relatively brief duration and came at a time when the licensee was engaged in significant efforts to return the station to the air. No forfeiture was warranted.

Ben Walker Broadcasting, Inc. was denied a Petition for Reconsideration proposing the allotment of 94.9 A to Cut and Shoot, TX. The proposal was returned as technically unacceptable premised on a short-spacing to KYKR, 95.1 C1 in Beaumont, TX. Walker can refile its Petition for Rule Making once the facilities authorized in KYKR's construction permit are constructed and licensed.

The Commission denied Petitions for Reconsideration filed by Arso Radio Corp. for WPRM-FM, San Juan and WKJB AM-FM, Inc., Mayaguez, PR. The stations were directed to show cause why their licenses should not be modified in accordance with a proposal to substitute 98.3 A for 98.9 B at Vieques and modify WSAN's license to specify operation on 98.3 A at Las Piedras. The Order also modified the license of WQQZ to move to 99.5 A, WKJB-FM to move to 98.7 B, and WPRM-FM to move to 98.5 A in Frederiksted, VI. Channel 106.1 B was moved from Christiansted to Vieques. Arso Radio argued to no avail that it is not in the public interest to reallocate a channel from a rural area to a well-served urban area and that the Commission should have considered the disruption in service to the residents of Vieques. The Commission's consideration was that the facility will provide city-grade coverage to a limited portion of the San Juan and Caguas Urbanized Areas specifically Las Piedras which is an independent community receiving its first local service.

**ELSEWHERE**

An early morning fire destroyed most of the contents of the studio and transmitters of Equity One Media Partner's WSDM AM & FM in Brazil, IN. About 5 am, the sports director for the stations discovered an intruder, who was later apprehended. Although the Fire Department responded within ten minutes, the building, both transmitters, and all studio and office equipment were destroyed. The tower and satellite dishes remain intact. A new FM transmitter has been ordered and the FM station hopes to be on the air from a Terre Haute studio the first week of December. The AM will return sometime later. Equity One recently agreed to purchase the assets of WJSH, AM 1300 in Terre Haute, which is currently off the air but their studio contains much of the equipment necessary to broadcast as a temporary site.

SFX Broadcasting and Multi-Market Radio have completed their merger. The boards of both companies approved the merger this week. The combined companies now own 80 stations in 23 markets.

Children's Broadcasting Corp. has closed on a \$16.5 million credit facility provided by Foothill Capital Corp., a division of Norwest. The loan is secured by the company's assets. The figure is \$1.5 million higher than CBC recently announced.

The Arbitron Company announced that complimentary copies of the Summer 1996 First Preference Report have been mailed. The Report provides users with estimates of those listeners who spend more time with that station in a one week period than with any other station they listened to and provides cume listener information for Persons 12+, 18-34, 25-54 and 35-64, Monday-Sunday, 6 am-Midnight in all 94 Summer markets. ABC Radio Networks is in the process of restructuring. It's eliminated the Oldies Operations Manager position occupied by Pat Clarke. Clarke has been at ABC and predecessor Satellite Music Network for the past 13 years managing all the oldies programming and the three Dick Bartley programs. Clarke's Beatles documentary won an International award for ABC in June of this year. Jim Zippo remains Program Director for ABC's Pure Gold.

SW Networks will give a listener and their guest a chance to win with its radio contest, "New Year's in Nashville With Country's Most Wanted," which will air on the "Country's Most Wanted with Carl P. Mayfield" show.
