Media Analyse Includes More Cable/Satellite Data

GERMANY by Miranda Watson

Cable/satellite radio operators in Germany will finally receive indications of their ratings this year when the country's ratings survey Media Analyse (MA) includes data covering listening for those stations. The survey, due to be published mid-June, is the first to include detailed questions on cable/satellite radio.

The fact that there is no concrete data for cable/satellite stations has been a point of contention for years and a major headache for those trying to market the stations. The MA '92 survey included only two specific questions on cable radio and none on satellite radio. This year's MA has increased its emphasis on both, with six questions covering both cable and satellite radio.

One major complaint is that the sample used by the MA is too small. Interviews were conducted in 33.000 households last year out of a total population of over 60 million

Another complaint is that interviewees are still not asked which cable/satellite programme they listen to, but only which radio programme(s). The MA uses face-toface interviews to collect its data, each of which lasts one hour 45 minutes. The specific cable/satellite questions are placed very near the end of this year's MA, which has raised concern among some broadcasters.

NRJ Opens Outlets In Stockholm, Saxony

NRJ has pulled Scandinavia into its plans for international development, spearheaded by the recent launch of its first Swedish station Energy/Stockholm, which started broadcasting on 91.1FM on May 24. The French group operator has also stepped up its German plans and is participating with local broadcasters to open three stations in Saxony's most important cities: Chemnitz, Leipzig and Dresden.

NRJ's new Stockholm outlet is run by radio operator Radio ETT ("Radio One") in which the principal shareholders are NRJ (60%), Swedish distribution and supermarket giant KF, free newspaper Gulatednenggen and two other small investors.

'Sweden is a very important territory for NRJ," says NRJ GM Alain Weill, who says plans are currently under discussion with possible partners to move further into Scandinavia with outlets in Norway and Denmark. Although declining to give further details, he comments that stations are likely to be in place there before the end of the year.

A team of some 10 staff are already installed at the Swedish station, which has a reach of (continues on page 21)

Radio 3 Fights Racism With Letter Campaign

HOLLAND by Machgiel Bakker

Dutch pubcaster Radio 3 has started a campaign to fight the recent racism outbursts in Solingen, Germany, where six Turkish

people were killed in a fire started by far-right groups last week.

An initiative of Peter van Bruggen and Jeanne Kooymans, hosts of the popular weekday morning show "The Breakfast Club," the campaign intends to mobilize public opinion by inviting listeners to send in postcards to the programme which, in turn, will be sent to the German parliament.

Producer Brian Hoolahan says the idea was born spontaneously and the campaign kicked off at 08:03 on June 2.

"Response has been overwhelming," he says. "Within twoand-a-half hours, the phones were burning and already 15 printers have offered their facilities to print the card. Distributors and graphical companies have joined in as well as several organization and advertising bureaus, including accounting firm KPMG."

The post cards will be printed in a run of 1.5 million and will be distributed among stores, supermarkets and other outlets. Contact with other European broadcasters has already been sought, including BBC Radio 1/London and BRTN Radio Donna/Brussels. Although not undertaking a similar action, BBC jock Mark Goodier will be interviewing Hoolahan about the campaign. In addition, numerous German radio stations have reported on the Dutch initiative.

The Breakfast Club is one of Holland's most popular programmes and its mixture of music, games and journalism attracts a daily audience of 1.5 million listeners.

DENMARK: GRAMEX Wins Royalty Case

Performing rights society GRAMEX has been granted permission to demand royalties from radio stations, according to a court ruling on May 13. Rates will be based on potential listeners. The association of commercial stations KOMM has contested the decision, arguing that it will cause financial difficulties for a series of stations. Nine stations declared bankruptcy in mid-May, with many owing money to rights societies KODA and GRAMEX. Kai Roger Ottesen

This was despite a cash injection of L2 billion following Dischi Ricordi's acquisition of 10% shares in the firm. RAI, however, claimed to break even overall with revenues totalling L4.18 billion. Jazz FM Awarded North West Licence

The UK Radio Authority surprised the industry on May 27 when it awarded the North West regional FM licence to Jazz FM. Headed by MD David Maker, the station plans to offer a mix of jazz, blues and soul music.

The franchise, with a potential reach of about 4.3 million adults. covers most parts of greater Manchester, Merseyside, south and central Lancashire (including Fylde), and the northern districts of Cheshire. The licence was the second regional franchise awarded this year and the most sought after, with 11 applicants in the bidding (M&M March 27).

Published reports say Jazz bid around £30.000-£40.000 for the licence, which will run for eight years and has as an earliest start date September 1, 1994.

Jazz reportedly is targetting an immediate reach of 10% and at least 14% by 1996. In the last

SNEP Signs Deal With IFOP For A New Single Chart

Two different singles charts may be in place in France by the end of the year, as French industry organisation **SNEP** is poised to launch a new singles chart in the autumn. Industry officials believe the new chart will be much more reliable than the current Top 50 chart operated by **Top No. 1**, an affiliate of broadcaster **Europe 1**.

SNEP has signed an polling with agreement organisation IFOP to create the new chart and monitor sales with a computerised point-of-sale system. IFOP is expected to be able to deliver its first charts by October 15. A list of 100 titles will be available, giving a broader view of the sales situation, and encouraging "more chart activity.'

The chart will be based on a weighting system covering all

types of stores (super and hyper markets, chains, independent stores), according to their market share. This will better reflect the current retail situation in France, according to SNEP. Super and hyper markets account for more than 50% of all singles sold in France, but are not considered by the industry as "breakers." Buyers for these stores tend to concentrate on the top 20 or 30 titles charted.

SNEP GM Bervrand Delcros says "the panel will respect the current balance between the different stores."

Nevertheless, leading retail chain FNAC, with its 40-plus stores, will not be part of the new panel. SNEP officials consider it will not affect the final result of the chart, as the outlet is more albums-oriented.

Delcros refused to unveil the cost for the new chart, saying "it will be in the same bracket price as the existing single chart." The record companies—the majors in particular, are due to pay for the chart, and are trying to recoup the investment by selling the results to broadcasters.

SNEP has hired former Virgin GM Dominique Leguern to investigate ways of exposing the charts via TV and radio. She is said to be in discussion with different channels including Canal +, which is considering dropping the current Top 50 single chart.

The current chart, monitored by Nielsen and IPSOS, is based on a point-of-sale system. It lost its backing from SNEP at the end of 1992, following SNEP claims that it was "unreliable" and a source of discrepancy.

The albums chart is generally considered to be properly working, and has not been affected.

RTL Germany Builds Up Its Holding

RTL Germany is to build up its holding over the next two months with a view to gaining 100% ownership of the RTL German group, reveals MD Berndt von zur Mühlen in an exclusive interview with M&M. This will involve introducing RTL Germany into other major German cities such as Munich and Hamburg.

At present, RTL Germany is a 100% daughter company of parent group CLT, but as Von zur Mühlen explains, "If we can build up the holding, then CLT will be prepared to give up its ownership and hand it over to RTL Germany. Once we gain full ownership, then I can concentrate on consulting the RTL Group. This year I will be looking at the possibility of building up new formats and of introducing RTL Germany into other major cities such as Munich and Hamburg so we can achieve this goal." Von zur Mühlen says it is RTL Germany's aim to be reach a market share of 10-15% in given areas of Germany.

RTL Germany launched in January 1991, with the start of operations in Stuttgart at ACE-RTL format Baden-Württemburg. In September '91 hot-ACE RTL formatted 104.6/Berlin was set up-the first frequency that RTL Germany really owned. The next step was to research the formats, says Von zur Mühlen, which led to the decision to introduce an oldies blanket programme broadcast from RTL Luxembourg. Now Von zur Mühlen is happy with Berlin, the formats of the Luxembourg and Baden-Württembourg branches of RTL. His goal is to expand the interests of RTL Germany, gain 100% ownership and in two years time he expects to have the restructuring in place.

Danmarks Radio Puts Together Music Only Proposal For P4

Pubcaster Danmarks Radio (DR) has revealed its interest in controlling the as-yet unallocated fourth national station P4, by putting forward plans for a diversified format featuring Danish music, classical

and jazz for the outlet. The pubcaster's new proposal for an 18-hour-a-day music station marks a U-turn in its hitherto indifferent policy towards the frequency, which has been available to DR for several years. The pubcaster's earlier plans had been to air only debates from the Danish parliament.

Although Danish regulations currently limit national broadcasting to DR, the government has discussed the

possibility of awarding the frequency to two other operators besides DR, namely a group of commercial stations, or national TV network TV2. The latter two groups have expressed interest in bidding for the station.

The future of the frequency will be discussed during licence talks later this year, according to DR associate director of radio Knud Ebbesen. He claims that to give the frequency to Danmarks Radio would provide a well-needed alternative to the three national stations—news/talk P1, classical P2 and album rock/ACE P3 currently running.

In addition to these three, DR has a fourth outlet, classicalformatted Danmarkskanalen, which shares a frequency with P2. Targeting the 30+ age demo,

Danmarkskanalen airs from 06.00-18.30, while P2 airs form 18.30-01.00.

"Our plans are to restructure without extending licence payments or firing employees," says Ebbesen, who sees attrition and early retirement as cost saving. The proposed budget for the new frequency represents 40% of DR's total budget of Dkr2.1 billion (app. US\$333 million). Also included in the funding process is a radio fund of Dkr500 million, which would be used to train the employees. 1.300 people Although are currently on the radio payroll, it is not yet clear how many people would be employed at P4.

The law stating that only DR can run a national radio business may not be such an obstacle to DR's competitors, claims John Steenberg, head of Denmark's commercial stations organisation KOMM, who adds, "If we are awarded the P4 licence we would dismantle the frequency and give the air power to between 30-50 stations, so they can broadcast on a local basis. There are 13 transmitters throughout Denmark which are so powerful that building similar transmitters would be likely to cause interference." Danish Telecom has, according to Steenberg, tested KOMM's plan, but has not yet given any feedback.

Some indications of which group will be awarded the licence were expected on June 7, when Fællesrädet For Elektroniske Medier was scheduled to meet with minister of cultural affairs Jytte Hilden.

San Remo Organiser Aragozzini Faces Four Years In Jail

Adriano Aragozzini, past organiser of the San-Remo Song Festival and joint executive producer of this year's event, has been sentenced to four years in jail after being found guilty on corruption charges in connection with the

festival. The full motivation for the sentence imposed by judges at San Remo's Tribunal will not be revealed for a month, but the case first came to light in 1991 when Antonio Gerini, an expartner of Aragozzini, made the accusation that Aragozzini had paid out L870 million (app. US\$544.000) in bribes to San Reino pubic officials to secure his position as organiser of 1989's festival.

Gerini, now a self-declared adversary of Aragozzini, was sentenced to two years imprisonment for his part in the affair along with the three San Remo local government officials and Aragozzini's accountant, who have received sentences ranging

from two to almost four years.

The annual song festival, renowned as Italy's major showcase for domestic talent, has always been linked with controversy. International guest artists slated to appear at this year's event were suddenly withdrawn by major record companies belonging to industry federation FIMI. The federation also threatened a total boycott of future events unless a number of conditions were met by pubcaster RAI and the Commune Of San Remo, the two key San Remo backers. It is not rare for artists excluded from the final song contest line-up to stage hunger strikes or take the organisers to court because of their omission.

The annual event, screened exclusively by pubcaster RAI to nightly audiences of over 14 million, looks set for a facelift. RAI, along with music industry associations including AFI, is currently staging a number of meetings in an effort to improve future editions. Asked if Aragozzini's jail sentence signalled a setback to progress,

AFI vice-president Franco Donato comments, "There'll be no problem. Aragozzini will appear and most probably get six months jail, but that's not the real issue. He, with his RAI organisation, is an external organiser, along with the Publispei company. I believe RAI will appoint its own internal manager in the future and drop both firms. It's fed up with the both of them. But San Remo will continue. It's an integral part of Italy's music industry. And as for Aragozzini, it's a case of 'those who make mistakes must pay.'

Capital Ad Sales Decline 1.4%

Saying the London advertising market "remained difficult," UK radio group owner Capital Radio reported a 1.4% drop in turnover after agency commissions of £14.1 million (app. US\$21.2 million) for the six month period ended March 31. Gross turnover fell 0.5% to £16.1 million.

A 6% decline in staff costs and a 34% reduction in royalty payments contributed to a 17.5% jump in operating profits to £3.7 million. Operating margins rose accordingly, up to 26.3% from 22.1%

Comments chairman Ian Irvine, "While Capital Radio's national advertising revenue during the period has been flat, our policy of directing greater resources to the London regional market has resulted in a considerable increase in local advertising revenue."

With regard to the future business climate, Irvine adds, "The radio advertising market remains volatile and very shortterm. While we are enthusiastic about the prospects in the medium-to-long-term, we continue to take a cautious view of the immediate future."

Capital, which completed its buyout of Midlands Radio Group on April 14, reported that turnover at that company increased 1.8% to £5.4 million while profits before tax, including costs related to Capital's acquisition, rose 6.4% to £644.000.

Radio Donna **Continues** "Dans Folie" Compilation

ARS, Sony Music, PolyGram and pubcaster BRTN's Radio Donna are continuing their collaboration on the Dans Folie compilation albums. A first volume spanning 1973-75 was released earlier this year, selling close to 20.000 units at presstime.

The Dans Folie series, advertised both on BRTN TV and Radio Donna, is based on Radio Donna's Friday and Saturday dance slots and compiled by ARS MD Patrick Busschots. "What I wanted to have on the album were the best dance tracks [from artists like Fred Wesley & the JB's, Moments and Whatnauts, Wild Cherry and so on]," says Busschots. Unlike Arcade, whose Dance Classics series mixed hits from various periods, the Dans Folie series aims to build a logical sequence, year by year, of original dance tracks in their best versions, says Busschots, who adds, "Our goal is to supply the audience with a good and complete survey of dance since 1973 in five or six double CDs.

Radio Donna has also launched a road-show to tie in with the programme.

This point in particular has raised objections from some station executives, who complain that it causes inconsistencies and unfairness by overlooking actual numbers of potential listeners.

As part of moves to implement the clause, stations already reaching more than five towns have been allowed to maintain their reach, while other stations covering less than five townships could extend theirs.

EHR-outlet Radio Viborg/ Viborg PD Knue Kyllested claims the system is unfair, pointing to the fact that a township of 10.000 inhabitants which applied to receive Radio Viborg two years ago was refused recently by the authorities. Radio Viborg covers nine townships and was refused another on the grounds that the station would then become regional. "That particular township would bring us up to a total of 130.000 potential listeners," he says. "Meanwhile, [EHR] Radio Aalborg was allowed to add three townships, giving them a potential listenership of 215.000. Obviously, there are some inconsistencies in the clause."

EHR, N/T-formatted Radio ABC, which has outlets in the north, east and west areas of Jutland, has also witnessed consequences of the media legislation. Chairman of the northern outlet Stig Hartvig had to leave his position because of a clause forbidding one person from being in charge of more than one station. His wife, Lene Hartvig then took over as chairperson. Radio ABC will also gain an extra 50.000 potential listeners in east Jutland, with the inclusion of two extra townships. Moves to add a sixth township will require exemption from the authorities.

One obvious reason for the changes in the law was the alleged networking of **The Voice**, according to John Steenberg, head of the organisation for commercial stations in Denmark KOMM. He adds. "The legislation brought one good thing: until 1993 we were allowed to air only six minutes of advertising per hour, but now we've been allowed to broadcast 12 minutes per hour. In practice, stations can air double amounts of advertising in the best ad slots, while compensating with a reverse amount in less attractive ad slots.



Turning The Swedish Radio Scene Into An Advantage



Bengt Berg, marketing manager; BMG Ariola Sweden



With the Swedish radio landscape currently in a state of flux, the record companies are restructuring their respective promotion arms to get the most out of the new situation. BMG Ariola marketing manager Bengt Berg views the coming changes in stations and formats as opening up new opportunities to market artists in the Swedish market

Because of its wide audience Berg believes that pubcaster SR (Swedish Radio) is still the most important station and will continue to be so. "In the future there will be more [EHR] City Radio stations like Radio City Stockholm and the stations in Gothenburg and Malmo. These will be the trend-makers that influence other stations. However, I do believe that people are listening more to national radio than they are to the City Radio stations. That could change, but I don't think national radio can be beaten if it continues to do as well as it does today." Berg also believes that SR's versatility in offering a wide variety of programmes and formats gives it an added advantage over

its competitors.

Of the 150 radio programmers in the present market, about 60-75 of them are important for getting airplay, but it depends on the type of music, says Berg. At the moment he doesn't see the market as being diversified enough. "We try to make diversity, but it isn't that easy. It takes a lot of money and personnel. For the few dance stations that exist, we ask them if there is specific music they do or do not want."

Swedish radio is currently undergoing a dance trend, as reflected in the singles sales chart, but Berg is quick to point out, "Even if both rock and dance are played on radio, there are a lot of rock bands playing danceable music as well."

International product makes up the most part of the charts, national product accounting for 40%, according to Berg.

While BMG services stations with the same music, it treats each one differently, he says. "You can't do competitions and giveaways on Swedish national radio for example. We try to follow the way stations operate, sometimes selecting regional stations for specific activities.

BMG works closely with TV, radio, clubs and the press to break new artists, says Berg. "You have to use every media tool available to break artists; you can't work with radio alone. If you can get heavy airplay for a record on radio, you go for it all the way." He believes, however, that commercial radio will allow for more flexibility. "You might be able to influence the programmer as well as the public if you have a spot running over and over again. This could also be the case with other programmers, as I believe they listen to their competitors."

Berg's priorities for the next couple of months include Eros Ramazzotti, Waterboys, David Bowie, Hooters, U2 and Deep Purple, to mention a few on the international side. Locally, artists Freda, Louise Hoffsten and Kayo are among the top priorities, not to mention Thomas Ledin and Anders Glenmark, who are doing the biggest tour of the summer, the "Rock Train."

He sees interviews as very important, especially outside the major cities. "Even a short interview is enough to get the stations outside the main cities to play the music, which is very important. Only 25% of the entire Swedish population lives in Stockholm, Gothenburg and Malmo. There's a lot of potential out there in the other 75%. Of course the trends start in the main cities, but we should still concentrate on the rest of the country."

When asked about the outlook for the

Radicalising Finnish Public Radio

Programme Director Of The Week

Jukka Haarma, Radiomafia, Finland

When recent image study results showed that pubcaster YLE's Radiomafia was not only considered the most colourful station in Finland but also the most annoying, PD Jukka Haarma was not upset about these claims. Then again, being a part of the most-listened-to station in Finland for the 15-24 age group, why should he be?

After commercial radio started in 1985, YLE began to watch its figures fall. To climb back into the hot seat, the pubcaster reorganised its stations, and as a result, national channel YLE 2 turned into the new and vibrant Radiomafia. The station now reaches 37% of its main target group audience, 15-34 year-olds, and has a cumulative daily audience of one million.

As YLE is the only broadcaster to air nationally, Radiomafia's competitors are all local stations. "We consider our competition these 40 local stations as a whole, not individually. Most of their formats are ACE [adult contemporary], so it's really not tough competition. Their main asset is being local, and because we can't beat them here we beat them on other terms; being modern, more fun and more exciting."

Haarma believes these points make his station radical, both in music and

programming strategy. Although he finds it difficult to place Radiomatia under one format, he claims the only format one won't hear on the station is Gold. "Our music format is not, and can't be, so strict as most European stations," he says. "I would say it's a combination of EHR and US-type album rock stations. As the only national 'youth' station we really have to cover a whole lot of different tastes; we can't just be only dance, rock or pop."

Haarma backs this up with a list of songs heard during a typical hour on Radiomafia: Midnight Oil My Country, Eppu Normaali Hipit On Rautaa, An Emotional Fish Rain, Pretenders I'm Not In Love, Foley If It's Positive, Tomas Ledin Släpp Hästarna Fria Aku Ankkuli Atomi-Yökerho, Terence Trent D'Arby Delicate, Veeti & The Velvets Always There, Aerosmith Cryin', Esa Kaartamo Onnen Kulkuri and Rob 'N' Razz Clubhopping.

This playlist not only raises the eyebrows of Radiomafia's listeners, but the labels as well, claims Haarma. "Record companies are more and more interested in our playlist, which as a concept is really quite new in Finland. We play new music and new talent and that, of course, increases their interest." However, Haarma adds that record companies aren't always smiling about his station. "What they are not always happy about is that we also pick album tracks for our playlist and not the current single. For example, we were already playing the current single from **Bon Jovi**'s new album, *In These Arms* when the album came out in 1992."

But Haarma feels record companies should look over this to the real issue: new talent. "Radio's most important issue today is who's going to play the new talent as the competition gets tougher; who's going to take the risks? In the end, it will probably be the public radio sector that takes these risks, just as the **BBC**'s EHR outlet **Radio** 1 and other public stations have done in the past."

Haarma started his career for YLE in 1979, a year later becoming a main power behind YLE 2's "Rockradio," Finland's most popular rock programme in the early '80s. After YLE restructured its programming in 1990, Haarma was appointed music coordinator for Radiomafia. Mary Weller

For information on TrackFax contact Kitty: tel.: (+31)20 669.1961 fax: (+31)21 669.1941 future Berg replies that a record executive can only make predictions about major artists. "It's easier to guess what will happen with established artists, but I never know whether a debut artist will be big in advance. There's no way of telling."

Berg's career in the music business started in the stockroom of EMI. In his 15 years with the company he climbed to the position of label manager and then head of promotion before leaving EMI to act as **Mega Record's** representative, a job that gave him a lot of responsibility, including what he wanted most—to become involved in marketing. He left Mega and the music industry briefly in 1988 before being tapped by BMG MD **Hasse Breitholtz** for his current position.

Berg attributes his success as marketing manager to a combination of factors. "Good artists and a good relationship with the artists are important. That, along with good management and good people like we have here at BMG." Ken Neptune

Station Operations

A Jingle Here, Or A Jingle There?

Twenty-five years ago, American songwriter Tom Merriman sat down and wrote a song which made radio history. No, he wasn't a songwriter for the Hollies or the composer of "Hey Jude"; he had composed what was to become the first recorded radio jingle.

Mastered on a three-track machine, Tom Merriman's first jingle wouldn't exactly be called a masterpiece today. The singers then had to sing non-stop over the track, limiting the quality. But that isn't the case today. With modern technology, a production company can make Frank Sinatra and his orchestra sing your station letters to the tune of My Way.

After jingles had become a sound market in the US, these American companies moved to new ground, namely Europe. As with other radio services. Americans had an extra jump over their European competitors, with more years of experience and better technology. However, unlike other radio services, Americans found that European jingle companies already existed, and could only watch them make remarkable strides in catching up whith their competition.

Making The Mark

Although the majority of jingle compa-nies today are found in the UK, jingle studios can be found in every European country. In Italy, for example, after Clay Remini had such success with his jingle company Zero DB, he opened up another company three years ago in Geneva.

Remini realises that the US remains the home of the jingle, adding that American influences can be felt as far away as Italy. "We tend to do jingles with the 'American style' in mind. However, we have an obvious advantage over American companies, as radio stations here find it difficult working with a US studio because it's so far away. On top of that, language is no barrier for us; we have singers from London, Japan, Germany, you name it, and we only sing jingles in the mother language.

Remini tends to favour jingles sung in English, but claims it is rather hard to sell in Italy. "In Geneva, about half of the things we do are in English. For Top FM in Brussels, I would say about 40% is in English, the rest in French.

Aside from several stations in Italy, Switzerland and Greece, Zero DB has made jingles for stations such as RNM Switzerland, NRI/Paris and BBC Radio 1 in London. But Remini doesn't want to stop there. "Right now we are represented in Holland by Music Reclame. This company represents us and already sells our sample CDs. But I would like to expand my reach in northern Europe. We already have some projects in mind," he says.

There's No Place Like Home

Located in continental Europe's second largest commercial radio market, the German jingle studio Geising Team is sitting pretty. With no connections to the US besides archive music from KPM Selected Sound, sound engineer Paul Goodyear claims US jingle companies can't compete as well in his market. "There are certain aspects the several German stations are looking for in a jingle which makes it impossible to compose in America," says Goodyear. "They just can't catch the same flavour of something. Schlager instruments such as the hackbrett don't exist in the US. And the traditional brass arrangements

known as 'oom-pah' bands can't be found on CD archive collections. We cater for these needs.

In the firm's seven-year history, the Geising Team has crossed its borders, making jingles for companies in Austria, Spain, Italy and Scandinavia.

Although studios such as the Geising Team have a good hold on their own market, the borders are still in America's reach. Over the years, Los Angeles-based Killer Music has made Germany its largest market outside the US, as well as stations Radio Rio in Rio de Janeiro, RMI in Poland, and Capital Radio in the UK

Killer Music MD Michael van Droffelaar says American jingles are more sophisticated than those made in Europe. "This is simply because the talent pool in the US is bigger," he adds. "The level of vocal work here in Los Angeles is much higher than in Europe. There is a greater amount of well-educated singers here. Jingles made in the US are also more song-oriented.

In addition, Van Droffelaar believes the results Europeans receive doing business with his company will pay off the long-distance phone bills. "We are more versatile and extremely professional-we sing in any language. We have 20^s years experience, he says, adding that the company will fly in native singers if so requested by a station. "We're the company to come to if someone wants a singer who sounds like Frank Sinatra. European studios don't have that yet.

But it won't take much longer before jingle companies come to that level, believes Van Droffelaar. "As one of the first American studios to do business in Europe, it's hard not to notice how European companies are catching up. The production value is much better than a few years ago. It seems that the old middle-of-the-road American jingles don't seem to be what stations are going for nowadays.

America's Long Reach

In keeping up with European competition, some of the major American jingle companies started linking up to jingle companies throughout Europe. Top Format in Holland, for example, has a direct link with Jam in Dallas, one of the most successful jingle companies in the US. Top Format MD Bart van Gogh receives all orders from the office in US for European jingles, and Top Format organises native singers. The studio can be considered a success, having top-name stations in Holland and Germany

Van Gogh feels there is a large difference between a US-made jingle from those made in Europe, both in the song and the singing. "In America, you will hear a short, choppy jingle, while European jingle companies usually make nice little songs," he says. "As far as singing is concerned, America jingles often try to do them in the native language, but they usually sound rather amateurish. We always work with native singers when singing a jingle, except the bass singer, simply because he's unreplaceable

Are English-spoken jingles on demand?

"English jingles are sometimes asked for but it varies from station to station," says Van Gogh. "America is, of course, a very interesting country for most Europeans, which brings the English-spoken jingle to the market in the first place. We are known for imitating America.

UK-based Standard Sound also has direct links with a leading US jingle company TM Century. Over the last 15 years, Standard Sound president Muff Murfin has managed to score the business of stations in several European countries, including Germany, Holland, France and Portugal

Murfin claims the best jingle for European stations are made close to home. Americans use a different chord structure, and although the singers are more experienced in America, they can't sing in foreign languages. Usually they sing alright in French. Spanish vaguely works, but jingles in German or Dutch just don't make it.

With links to America's first jingle company and making quality product, Standard Sound has earned a top name in European jingle companies, claims Murfin. "We have a very honourable, strong reputation and we are very careful about that," he says. "If it's not correct the first time, we work on that jingle until its what they want."

Murfin says that as of this November, TM Century will be represented by Radio Express, while Murfin and jingle founding fathers Merriman and Gerald Stockton will be opening a new company in the US. When asked why he would set up his new company in America, Murfin simply says, "If you are a jingle freak, you will want to go where it originally came from.'

on what is hot and what is not in today's jingles.

Standard Sound president Muff Murfin:

"English-language jingles are becoming much more hip, simply because more and more English music is being played on continental Europe. Of course, this all depends on what country it is. The spoken jingle is becoming more and more popular in Europe, with an exciting bed underneath. This is exactly the opposite of what's happening now in the US, where most of the jingles are sung. A jingle needs to be sung in order to create memorability of the station; music has more penetration than words."

Top Format MD Bart van Gogh:

"A lot of people are now asking for the one-liners, with sound effects in the background. The longer jingles are starting slowly to come back."

Zero DB MD Clay Remini:

"What's now hip seems to be more of the shotgun singles, the very short jingles. Stations aren't going for the long-lasting songs anymore. Also jingles with text aren't in-songs make a lasting image. Of all our customers, only about 30%, ask for a customised jingle; the syndicated ones sell the best."

Killer Music MD Michael van Droffelaar:

"A jingle has to be sung over contemporary music. Nowadays they use more rap and house, such as groups like Salt 'N Pepa. What seems to be hip now are jingles in the native language with the hook line sung [or said] in English; this gives it an international vibe."

Geising Team sound engineer Paul Goodyear:

"There are very few stations nowadays which ask for jingles with vocals, simply because syndicated jingles are the most popular product and they have no vocals. And if a station does ask for vocals, they are most often in the native language. It is very rare that someone asks for a jingle in other than their mother tongue. Archive music is seemingly the most popular, but it has to sound expensive. But the standard for archive has definitely improved over the years with digital recordings."

Here the songs are played tighter and with even more fire than in the studio. Some of the really thundering standouts are *Majesty*, *Journey Through The Dark* and *Valhalla*.



The Sky Is The Limit For 2 Unlimited



Crossing dance acts over to the mainstream is no longer exceptional. Developing them into solid album selling acts is still unique, however. In week 23 Belgian/Dutch dance unit 2 Unlimited's second album "No Limits" was already at number 5 in M&M's European Top 100 Albums. Indies with a well-coordinated parchwork of deals can come as far as the majors. Depeche Mode (Mute) proved it, and now 2 Unlimited (Byte) is doing it, and the sky is the limit...

EUROPE

2 Unlimited was there two and a half years ago, and it is still kicking. That can't be coincidence in a world where new acts come and go like rain and sunshine. Radio was rather hesitant with the first single Get Ready For This back in 1991, but with the latest Tribal Dance, it is beginning to soften a little. The current position at number 23 in M&M's EHR Top 40 is probably the best indicator.

Better still are the incredible results realised with the new album No Limit, in the top 10 all over Europe. Byte MD, coproducer and one of the two artistic masterminds behind the Belgian project along with Phil Wilde-Jean-Paul de Coster compares 2 Unlimited with all the dance one-hit wonders. "Most producers never think about tomorrow. Their problem is that they never come up with a good follow-up to the first, mostly accidental first hit. Those who strive for long-term success should release a new single every three or four months and every year a new album. At this very moment we're already preparing the successor of Tribal Dance. My history as a club DJ and retailer has been very instructive in this. You're more in touch with the market than anybody else. The whole process is a logical evolution from underground to pop act. I see no difference from the development Nirvana has undergone."

Toco International European manager Marc de Raaff who secured the so-called "scatter deals" across Europe also likes to talk in terms of a pop act. That requires a different strategy. Says he, "All the licensees had one goal—to break out from the clubs to the charts. We organised meetings with all the people involved to discuss the demos for the album and decide about potential singles. The release policy is simple and strictly coordinated from our office in Hilversum [Holland]. We go for *simultaneous* releases of the *same* single everywhere. We want to avoid chaos and parallel import."

According to de Raaff, who did the same job with Depeche Mode for Mute, all partners for masters owner Byte (Zyx in Germany, Scorpio in France, PWL International in France among others) were chosen because of familiarity with the repertoire and good contact. "Such a direct communication line to the territories is the big advantage of working in the independent field. Working this way, we have achieved a continuity in hits which is unique."

Realising such continuity is only possible with a public image that the people can relate to and with rapper Ray Slijngaard and singer Anita Doth from Holland, 2 Unlimited is not just another faceless dance act. In the UK, however, until the release of Tribal Dance single, mixes without Slijngaard's contribution were always issued. The duo's almost weekly appearance in the BBC TV1 children show "Ozone" raised a public awareness of his existence. So far the UK hit history of de Coster's and Wilde's artistic baby was one of an instrumental dance act. And still the UK version of the new album is different from the continental one, with fewer vocal tracks

"Different countries, different tastes, different demands" certainly applies to France. All the ground work for the French current success was done with a special mix of the lead-off single *No Limit*. Scorpio MD **Henri Belolo** is a dance veteran in the business—in the '70s he was the creator of the **Village People** and the **Ritchie Family**—and he knows the trick of the trade like no other. "2 Unlimited always did tremendously well in the clubs, but it never got airplay on the major networks here. Techno was considered to be too aggressive for their listeners. We were very happy when the producers were kind enough to listen to our advice to supply us with a special radio friendly mix. Then it all started on NRJ, Sky Rock and Fun, and for the first time the band made the top 50. What's more, it reached number 1! Suddenly France was ready for techno, and subsequently we didn't need special mixes for the French market anymore for it successor *Tribal Dance*."

The album entered the French chart at number 6, and from June 6 it has been heavily marketed via a TV campaign on M6. In Italy Alabianca has bought 20-second advertising spots on Radio Deejay Network to be broadcast 10 times per day in the first three weeks of June. Alabianca MD Tony Verona is happy to announce that 2 Unlimited got the theme song to the national summer event "Festival Bar," comparable only to the "San Remo mania" in the spring time. "The event taking place in seven cities will be televised by the Berlusconi-owned station Canale 5. This is quite an achievement for an indie, because everybody is fighting for this honour. In the last show-in the famous Arena in Verona-the band will appear live.

Aztec Camera: Snapshots Of Dreamland



UNITED KINGDOM by Robbert Tilli

The lyrics to some songs should be framed because of the poetic way they reflect everyday conscious and subconscious life—better than any photo could ever do. The repertoire of Aztec Camera, Roddy Frame's band and alter ego, is a collection of snapshots of his (love) life and dreams set to music. The words to last year's single Spanish Horses—the first one selected from the new, fifth album Dreamlanddraw up images of **Gaudi**'s architecture, ships setting sail and horses coming together in a way only possible in dreams.

The Spanish setting is retained on the track *Pianos And Clocks*, enhanced with, yes, piano and the tick-tock rhythm of a clock. Frame really takes us into dreamland on the current single *Dream Sweat Dreams*, while the **Motown** beat assures you you're definitely not asleep. The world leaders should listen to his "hippy" ideal of a

world without war and famine. The album is co-produced by Japanese sound wizard **Ryuichi Sakamoto**, who has

restrained himself in a remarkable way. The result is still Roddy's framework rather than Sakamoto's, whose activities are more on a skindeep level.

Frame's style has developed from folky to more soulful over the years. The Scotchman met the reverend Al Green the world's most supple-voiced singer—in an American studio where the two jammed for an hour. To prove he had learned something from it, Frame played the intro to Green's *Love And Happiness* during a live performance on Jools Holland's late night show on BBC TV 1 on May 14.

The stage is WEA's prime tool to market the album. Says international marketing director Mark Crossingham, "The UK tour has just finished. Roddy did a lot of promo on the continent recently, highlighted by various acoustic performances at radio stations. For the fan base we issued the single as two separate CD singles, each containing three different live tracks recorded at Ronnie Scott's club. Combined with the two CDs for Spanish Horses, the idea was to build up a Roddy Frame live collection. The joined spines form a picture of his face."

GAZELL SIGNS WITH WARNER SWEDEN

M&M hears Warner Music Sweden has inked a licensing deal with former Sonet Scandinavia chairman Dag Haeggqvist's Gazell Music. The agreement so far is for Scandinavia only.

UK CLASSICAL UNIT SALES UP 6%

The **BPI** has announced that classical trade deliveries for the first quarter have increased almost 6% in volume and a 4.8% rise in value to £13.7 million (app. US\$21.1 million). Included in the survey are the first figures for DCC, which sold about 4.000 units worth £29.000. No sales figures were given for Sony's MiniDisc.

NO CHAOS FOR GROENEMEYER

Congrats to EMI Electrola, which managed to get the new Herbert Groenemeyer album, *Chaos*, straight at number 1 in the German sales charts, a first for the artist. On the day of release, *Chaos* sold over 250.000 copies, good for a gold certification.

SONY/SACEM SIGN MECHANICAL LICENSING DEAL

Sony Music International (SMI) and French mechanical rights organisation SACEM/SDRM have signed an agreement, covering the granting of mechanical licenses to SMI throughout the European community, excluding the UK. Signed by SMI president Paul Russell and SACEM chief Jean Loup Tournier, the deal applies to the company's international recordings together with those made in Belgium, Germany, Greece, Italy, Portugal and Spain.

has proved an exception to the unwritten rule. His single Cose Della Vita, culled from his latest album Tutte Storie (DDD/BMG), is moving up in this week's EHR Top 40 with a bullet from 20 to 17 in its fifth chart week with strong crossover airplay in the GSA territories, the Benelux, Spain and Denmark. Regardless of format, more than 30% of M&M's active station reporters (261 outlets) are playlisting the song. In M&M's European Top 100 Albums, Tutte Storie is at number 3 after having topped the chart for one week.

Germany has always been an important market for Ramazzotti. Tutte Storie has sold 185.000 units since its release on May 3, and the single is currently at number 42 in the national sales chart. Radio airplay for Cose Della Vita has been very encouraging, but it wasn't easy at first, says BMG Ariola Munich head of marketing for international repertoire Angelika Ruge. "It was a bit of a struggle because it wasn't like his past releases, which you could describe as typical Italian songs," she comments. "It's strong and rocky and that makes a difference. But, according to [national airplay organization] Media Control, it registered 178 plays by the week ending May 23. That is an achievement when you consider that past releases usually registered around 50 plays."

Some European radio stations, especially the ACE-formatted outlets, have cut off the rocky guitar intro to make the song more suitable to their audiences. However, **M&M TrackFax** data shows that this hasn't prevented programmers from airing the track, and Ramazzotti's new musical direction is widely applauded.

Swiss ACE Radio Basilisk/ Basel head of music Nick Schulz says the new album shows the singer to have matured a great deal, both musically and lyrically. He says, "We not only have the current single in high rotation, but six other tracks off the album in low rotation. They have proved to be extremely popular with our listeners."

Tom Blomberg, producer at Dutch pubcaster NOS's prime-time "Avondspits" programme agrees. "He has obviously grown a lot and it's very interesting to see how he is edging toward a much rockier sound."

Northern German regional ACE network Antenne Niedersachsen/Hannover head of music Antje Schmidt says the single is playable at all hours and, considering the favourable audience response, it will be in high rotation for some time to come.

Radio airplay lies at the base of all promotional activities for Ramazzotti's record company DDD. "It's getting more and more important on all markets," stresses DDD international manager **Donatella De Gaetano**. "There's less and less promotional space on TV. Take Germany for example: there are hardly any programmes for either new or established talent."

The importance of radio is underlined in DDD's choice to release Ramazzotti's *Cose Della Vita* single 20 days before the album on April 30. "We did that with only markets outside Italy in mind," she explains. "We wouldn't have needed it on domestic territory, but other countries wanted the single in advance for airplay purposes. This was in order to keep people hot for the album."

Ramazzotti is one of those rare Italian artists to have product released almost simultaneously throughout Europe. De Gaetano confirms that this has happened since his *In Certi Momenti* album released in 1987. "There's great demand for his product so we have to release simultaneously in an effort to combat parallel imports," comments De Gaetano. "No country wants to release an album later

pel what he describes as malicious rumours against him and his **Fininvest** group of companies. Other national TV network stations are expected to be placed under investigation.

Sergio Natucci, secretary of the national private radio stations association RNA, dismisses as ridiculous any notion that operators in his sector could be involved in corruption. "With a total advertising revenue of L320 billion (app. US\$200 million) in 1992 and a negative projection for this year, who could afford to bribe anyone?" he retorts. Natucci also stresses that a decree announced by current telecommunications minister Maurizio Pagani on December 17 last year eliminated any prospect of bribes from the radio sector.

Carlo De Giacamo, executive at the key local stations association AER, explains the decree. "We learned from the mistakes of the TV sector, for which frequency plans

than others, but we still have some problems in France where prices are higher than other territories."

DDD's European affiliates are involved in the promotional process right from the outset. The company hosted a Milan meeting in March to present the album, sleeve, artwork and video project and a promo plan was put together. "We try to meet all requests," stresses De Gaetano. "But people would like Eros to be in two places at once. Our partners know their own territories better than us but what we do stress is image and style. There's the need to recognise that Eros is an absolute top artist and that means choosing the best magazines, radio and TV stations for advertising purposes.

As is common with artists coming from the mainland, the UK market is often hard to crack. De Gaetano confirms that meetings are being held in London to discuss possible release and marketing strategies. "Arista in the US is going for the big push and I'm convinced Ramazzotti will break there," she comments. "If the UK doesn't move soon I'm afraid that they'll miss the train."

service net **RMC** and will present to official bidders a detailed financial analysis at the end of June.

One of the main problems, says Star*Sat and Radioropa-Info MD **Peter Lepper**, is that MA doesn't cater for nationwide broadcasters, which he says creates big problems for stations like Star*Sat. "Star*Sat has a loyal audience throughout Germany. The problem is that this audience is spread over the whole country. At the moment we are looking into what other methods there are of proving nationwide listenership to advertisers."

In last year's MA, Lepper says Star*Sat had missed the minimum audience score to be included in the ratings by just two points.

Klassik Radio MD Manfred Kühn says he is convinced the present MA system is not really covering cable distribution. "I think the MA uses too small a sample," he says. "If you are a nationwide broadcaster, figures for each individual town will be relatively small. The MA has to go deeper and take a much bigger sample if it is to be representative.

so many enemies that a second legislation package might be as incorrect as the first because people want to punish Berlusconi. The thing is, he's as clean as anybody, but failed industrialists like **Agnelli** or **De Benedetti** are jealous of his success. We, in the radio sector, might end up losing what we earn because of these attempts to destroy him."

Hazan admits there were good things included in Mammi's original package. "It allowed a company to own three national network stations and transmit live around the clock throughout national territory," he explains. "But a national station can't air both national and local advertising. We've cropped all local ads from Radio Montecarlo and cut them by 50% on Rete 105. The thing is that our ex-clients have not taken their business to local stations which can air both local and national advertising, so who is benefitting?"

I am sceptical that the changes the MA is making this year will make much of a difference." Klassik registered 20.000 listeners per average hour in last year's MA.

RTL Germany has a full cable reach in Germany, as well as terrestrial frequencies in Berlin, Stuttgart and Luxembourg. MD **Berndt von zur Mühlen** is looking forward to this year's MA results and comments, "It will be interesting to see the figures, as it's the first time that the Media Analyse is really using cable data and finding out what people listen to."

In last year's MA, RTL Germany (i.e. RTL Berlin, Strasbourg and Baden-Württemburg) scored 450.000 listeners per average hour.

around two-million inhabitants in the greater Stockholm area. Programming will be based on the French formula, says Weill, with emphasis on EHR, but 100% in Swedish.

Commenting on its new German stations, Weill says, "We have received the authorisation from the German radio authorities, and the stations will begin transmitting in June."

Three separate operating comnanies have been set up, in which NRJ owns 45% (Leipzig), 10% (Chemnitz) and 10% (Dresden), respectively. NRJ sees Germany as an important target for the group. During its annual meeting in March forecasts were made of an overall German investment of Ffr20 million (app. US\$3.7 million) for the company (M&M April 3). The new foreign outlets will represent increased international development for the group, which until May 24 operated three foreign stations-Radio 2000/ Berlin (known to listeners as Energy Berlin), CGS FM in Belgium and NRJ Genève in Switzerland.



EHR In Love With UB40

There is hardly any room to move up in this week's **EHR Top 40**, especially in its upper half. And it is typical that the fastest mover of the week in terms of chart points, UB40's version of (*I Can't Help*) Falling In Love With You, gains only one position (landing at number 4). The top three records prevent it from moving higher, as they are all stalled at last week's positions, all still scoring considerable gains.

UB40 are also enjoying the Most Added status this week, thanks to 18 more first-time reports, notably from Denmark, France and Belgium. Along with their homeland, massive airplay support for the UK band is found in Holland and Austria; in all three countries their single books an impressive 100% penetration, according to M&M's EHR reporter roster. Next in line are Denmark, Sweden, Switzerland, the Czech Republic and Belgium, acceptance levels varying from 64% to 77%.

Another British band, making a good move in the top 10 area are **Tears For Fears**, whose current 15 adds is good for a top 5 record, coming from number 7. It is also interesting to see the high caliber of those adds, 10 of them coming from "platinum" and "gold" reporters. Support base for *Break It Down Again*, the first single from the group's fourth album, *Elemental*, is strongest in the UK, Ireland, Italy, Portugal, the Czech Republic and France (60% to 100% penetration).

This week's highest new entry is *Fields Of Gold* by Sting. Entering at number 35, the Englishman's new single does best in the South (Italy), where it is already charting EHR-wise for six consecutive weeks, peaking at 9 in issue 21 (see Regional EHR Top 20). Territories where the record is currently gaining airplay impact include Germany, the UK, France, Portugal and finally Spain, where Cadena 40 Principales/Madrid has added the song straight to its heavy rotation list.

Second highest entry (at 36), and second most added record at the same time (16 adds), is *Black Tie White Noise*, the title track from the current album by yet another Brit, **David Bowie**. The song enjoys its best figures in Sweden (63% penetration), followed by the UK (57%), Norway (36%) and Belgium (29%). *Pieter Kops*





CHRONOLOGY: THE HISTORY

Jean Michel Jarre is, without doubt, one of the most creative and innovative musicians of our time. Since his album Oxygene rocketed to the top of the charts back in the '70s—to date, he has sold more than 37 million records. But even now, it is impossible to categorise either artist or his music.

Born in Lyon in 1948, Jean Michel Jarre started learning music at the age of five and went on to study classical music at the Paris Conservatoire. His father is composer **Maurice Jarre**, though perhaps he was more inspired by his grandfather, **Andre Jarre**, who was an oboe player, engineer and inventor.

Jean Michel started experimenting with electroacoustic music when he joined the **Music Research Group** in Paris in 1968, releasing his first album a year later. By the time he left the group in 1971, he was composing music for films, stage, television and commercials—most notably, a ballet score AOR, for **Paris Opera** and the soundtrack for **Jean Chapot**'s film Les Granges Brulees. He was also recording his own experimental, synthesizer-based music as well as writing for and producing other artists.

Jarre released Oxygene in 1976 and it became an international success, unprecedented in the history of the French recording industry. The album represented a new kind of music and gave Jarre the reputation of being the forerunner of synth-based groups today. Equinoxe followed in 1978 and was a resounding success in 35 countries, firmly establishing Jean Michel internationally.

On July 14 1979, Bastille Day, Jarre gave his first public performance—a concert staged in the Place de la Concorde, Paris. Jean Michel attracted one-million spectators which gained him a place in the *Guinness Book Of Records*, and 100 million television viewers. For the first time, he used pyrotechnics, giant projections and lasers, thus sowing the seeds for the concerts to come in China, Houston, Lyon and London's Docklands.

Magnetic Fields appeared two years later. It was in the top 10 all over Europe and placed in three chart categories in America pop, classical and jazz.

In 1981, Jarre was invited by the Chinese government to be the first Western artist to perform in China. That October he played a series of five concerts, with a 34-piece Chinese orchestra,

in Peking and Shanghai. This extraordinary adventure was filmed as a television documentary, *The Concerts In China*, and the live double album went platinum worldwide.

His album Zoolook released in November 1984, is seen by many as his most avant-garde to date. Here he used vocal effects as rhythm tracks, creating a kind of electronic opera.

On April 5 1986, celebrating Houston's 150th Anniversary, Jarre created the ultimate multi-media concert, using the city's skyline as a visual canvas, utilising lasers, massive projections and a breathtaking light and firework display. It was estimated that 1.3 million people were in the audience, ensuring another entry in the *Guinness Book of Records*. His album *Rendez-Vous* was released to coincide with the concert and Jarre went on to win two Victoire De La Musique awards in France, for "Best Record Of 1986" and



"Best Show."

On October 5 that year, Jean Michel returned to his birth place, the city of Lyon, to stage a special concert in honour of Pope John Paul II. Accompanied by 60 musicians and 120 choristers, he performed at the foot of Fourvieres Hill, with a backdrop including the magnificent law court building and the hillside rising to the Basilica above.

The music for *Revolutions* was composed very much with a concert in London's Docklands in mind. Continuing his fascination with architecture and the environment, the Royal Victoria Docks were the antithesis of Houston, evoking the sights and sounds of the industrial revolution. The event consisted of two shows on the October 8 and 9 1988. With Jarre's stage afloat in the middle of the Dock and the rain pouring down on both evenings, the setting looked virtually apocalyptic. However, thousands of fans braved the English weather to applaud this unique experience. The film

"Destination Docklands" and the "making of" documentary has now been screened worldwide and is regularly repeated.

Paris La Defense—A City In Concert was the result of several invitations from the likes of the French Ministry of Culture and the City of Paris to celebrate Bastille Day in the most spectacular fashion. So, on July 14 1990, Jarre and his 50 musicians performed on an enormous "pyramid" stage in front of the extraordinary, modern architecture that makes up La

Defense, including the monumental "Grande Arche." It was reported that approximately two-million people partied in the streets between the Arc de Triomphe and La Grande Arche, watching the show on the specially erected giant screens and the lasers, pyrotechnics and light projections for which Jarre is now renowned.

His studio album Waiting For Cousteau was released. This was inspired by the legendary marine biologist Jacques Cousteau and the environment he represents. For this, Jarre composed some totally unexpected new sounds, mixing electronic expertise with traditional Caribbean music. Some parts of the album Calypso Parts 1, 2 and 3 were recorded in Trinidad with a steel band of 40. This band also performed at the "Paris La Defense" concert.

As well as all of the recordings mentioned above, several other Jarre albums have been released: The Essential in 1983, In Concert Houston/Lyon in 1987, Jarre Live in 1989, Images: The Best of Jean Michel Jarre in 1991, an essential collector's item featuring not only some classical compositions but also two new tracks, Eldorado and Globe Trotter and one previously unreleased track Moon Machine.

CHRONOLOGIE: THE MUSIC

The inspiration behind the album Chronologie is a definition of the word not usually found in the dictionary; that definition is of a series of dates or historical events that happened in order over a period of time. Says Jarre, "My interpretation is rather that since time began, life is a series of events and sequences made up of seasons, days, years, generations, chromosomes, birth and heartbeats. They may not be events featured in history books but are in themselves the chronology of our lives. The music is a poetic evocation of these cycles."

Disques Dreyfus, president, manager and friend of Jarre, claims the album "is also a cycle on its own. If you listen to the album, the end brings you back to the beginning of it. It is a perfect circle that just continues. The tracks on the album are



numbered as with the majority of all his albums, but

in this instance, it makes the whole album a sequence of music that goes beyond time."

A very important aspect of Jarre's new work is that it contains several tracks which are potential singles. The first single Chronologie 4 comes with several remixes. "I have tried not to work on this project with remixers, DJs or engineers, but rather with artists who would give Chronologie 4 more the interpretation of a song than a remix." For the first single, Jarre has worked with young musicians Praga Kahn, Suncreem, Black Girl Rock and Jamie Petri, an engineer involved in the Rave scene. The connection is hardly surprising, as ever since the start of the Rave movement, first developed in England, a sort of "parental" link had established itself between the work done by Jarre and the young groups from



this movement who often cite him as a source of inspiration.

Praga Khan are responsible for two continental versions of Dream Time Mix and Atomium Mix, and Sunscreem for versions styled for UK: Emotion Mix, S X S Mix and Emergency Mix. Black Girl Rock is working on a more underground interpretation, Tribal Trance Mix.

"The remixing of different artistic interpretations will be a continuing process for this album," remarks Dreyfus. "It will give each track a chronology of its own."

Says PolyGram International marketing director Mike Allen, "Radio is very important for promoting virtually any artist and Jean Michel Jarre is no exception. While he has a big album base which does not necessarily listen to pop radio, we believe that the new single Chronologie 4 has great radio potential.

PolyGram International marketing director Europe Margarita Scheckel recounts, "Jarre's audience is always

between 25 and 40, but this time Jarre has a fresher style. The great re-mixes will broaden his audience to encompass the younger generation, who don't know very much about Jean Michel. They might know *Oxygene*, but this came out some 16 years ago. He has gone back to that kind of audience. It is very important that the young people also discover his music and we are quite sure they will like the new Jarre."

Through the albums Zoolook, Revolutions and Waiting For Cousteau, Jarre explored the various fields of ethnic music, working on vocal samples and going in various different directions like on Revolutions with Arab music. "Back in 1981 he used the clicking sound of a camera for Souvenir Of China," recalls Scheckel. "At that time such a sound was very unusual in a new recording. Since then this sound has been used everywhere." Explains Jarre, "For Chronologie I have made a sort of cycle and it is, in a sense, quite close to Oxygene and Equinoxe. The melodies are not necessarily the main purpose of the music—they are ingredients, parameters and part of the structure of Chronologie; the other aspect is the use of analog synthesizers."

THE VISUAL

The concept behind the sleeve is five women. Jarre comments, "Our life is driven by women. I like the idea in the Greek mythology that a lot of forces in action on earth are of female nature, particularly in the Latin countries, like for example passion, war, death, destruction, life, etc."

THE VIDEOS

The videos are also not a static affair. A long-time admirer of **Jon Klein**, Jean Michel asked him to direct the first videos because of his rare ability to combine images and visuals to music with no lyrics, so the music is not fixed to one single image. The first single *Chronologie 4* has spawned two completely different clips, based on the themes of time and space. One video showing a series of events, time being a series of events that develop throughout the video and the other one shot in Brazil, linked to the notion of space, a voyage through the different aspects of time.

"We want to give the consumers something to think about," says Dreyfus. "We approach them as adults, no matter what age they are. We don't force them to understand one specific video, which is why we decided to give them two

completly different visual suggestions. This is totally new and therefore an extra challenge."

THE TOUR

Jarre is also known for his spectacular one-off live multimedia events. For the first time in his career Jarre will

undertake a series of concerts having the character of a real tour. "The concerts are in themselves close to what I have done in the past," states Jarre, "It is a one-off concept in itself, except that it has various parts in different cities."

The first step of his tour, entitled Europe In Concert will start in France at the Mont St. Michel, at the end of July. It will then continue in 1994 in North and South America and then Asia. In 1995 Jarre will play in several symbolic places around the planet to celebrate "The Year Of Tolerance" decreed by the **United Nations** on the initiative of **UNESCO** for which Jarre has recently become an ambassador.

"Jarre touring is a very exciting prospect. In the past Jarre's live performances were one-off events," notes Allen. "With *Chronologie* he will for the first time undertake an European tour covering both major and minor markets. This is great because it takes the live performance element into markets where he has never been before, and gives us a series of very high-profile events around which to continue our marketing effort. We will extend our marketing push to the entire catalogue as the tour rolls on."

The stage will represent an imaginary city of 150 metres long and 24 metres high, composed of modules and screens of variable size installed in stadiums, parks, squares or other open air locations. The stage opens out in a semi-circle with 12 giant screens set up as buildings from 6 to 25 metres high on to which giant and mobile images will be projected. Five high-power lasers will paint graphics in the sky in direct synchronisation with the music.

Dreyfus, the "Éminence grise" behind Jarre's events, elaborates on this striking performing concept, "Jean Michel has always believed in trying to establish a new format of performance where the artist is not the only centre point. Rock concerts distinguished themselves by having more lights and other songs. At big stadium concerts people get frustrated because they pay a lot of money to see very little. I believe therefore that a lot of people are curious to see Jean Michel "live" just to experience a new kind of show."

The partner for "Europe in Concert" is **Swatch**. The company asked Jarre to design both the visual and a rhythm sequence with two notes and 15 pulses for its new sonar Swatch.

"I don't know if it will be Jarre's biggest project ever,"

continues Dreyfus, "but one thing I can tell you is that when I listen to the album I have the same feeling as when I first heard *Oxygene*. I guess that's the best sign!"
