

### NRJ Eyes Up New **London Licence**

PARIS - Although a trial two years ago wasn't fruitful, French radio group NRJ has high hopes that its second attempt to apply for a radio licence for the greater London area will be crowned with suc-

The difference this time is that NRJ has learned from experience and has decided to go solo in its application for an FM radio licence. NRJ managing director Alain Weill told Music & Media that the barriers that hindered the development of a continental european media group in the UK are no longer valid. "The idea that a non-UK radio group could operate a British station is no longer shocking," says

Weill. "Being an European actor on the London scene is now regarded as something natural. Besides, NRJ has a significant knowledge of the radio field and we don't need partners." Weill says NRJ will announce the station's board of directors within the next two weeks, and assures that it will be "rich with British personalities". In addition, he doesn't rule out opening the shareholding to new partners if the decision from the Radio Authority is positive next December. "There are a lot of candidates but we are reasonably optimsitic," says Weill.

He goes on to stress that being present in a market as important as London is of strategic interest for NRJ.

### Beatlemania's Back Again

So it has arrived this week: the latest Beatles Anthology on Apple. Preceded by a five-track promo CD, the release ends an impressive campaign by Apple and EMI to unearth the hundreds and hundreds of tapes with out-takes, tryouts, studio chatter and new songs. Although many of these were available on bootleg before, often presenting surprisingly high-quality recordings, the Anthology set does offer loads of new stuff for the dedicated fan (count me in).

But the Beatles chapter is not yet over it seems. Although Apple will not

release any more Beatles material, the legacy of Lennon & McCartney as the century's most important songwriters will continue to be honoured. Last week I heard of yet another Lennon & McCartney tribute album forthcoming on Blue Note. Strawberry Fields - Blue Note Sings Lennon & McCartney, (the same label issued another tribute in 1991: The Music Of Lennon & McCartney - Love Me Blue, featuring Stanley Jordan, Bobby McFerrin and Stanley Turrentine). There is no other band in history that is honoured with so many different tribute albums as The Beatles. They come in all different sorts of styles and genres-salsa, reggae, jazz, classical, muzak, panflute, Beatles songs delivered by dogs, Beatles songs for babies, and many more deviants. For those radio producers looking for an original angle to yet another show on the Fab Four, I've prepared a (selective) list of some Beatles tribute albums that were released just in the last two years.

### All Change As Naples Network Kiss Kiss FM Grows Up

MILAN - A new management at Naples based Kiss Kiss FM have switched format to adult contemporary in an effort to turn around flagging ratings and a disappointing financial performance.

The switch from EHR to AC has been implemented by ex-RAI presenter Roberto Barone who replaced Gianni Simioli

as programme director last month. The changes follow a virtual clean sweep of management and onair staff. Only Ornella Rauci has kept her afternoon drive slot whilst Simioli

and Nino Manzarini, until recently presenter of the evening acid jazz/new age show Vibes, have crossed town to join Naples regional station Radio Club 91.

Kiss Kiss FM, owned by local businesswoman Lucia Niespoli, has failed to make significant headway in Italy's stiff ratings and advertising battles, where the top four out of ten private national music radio networks share the majority of listeners and national advertisers. In the last Audiradio survey covering the second quarter of this year Kiss Kiss FM registered a 4%

drop against the first quarter with a daily average of just over 1.1 million listeners ranking them eighth in the league of private music networks.

Prior to his departure, ex-PD Gianni Simioli put KKFM's disappointing ratings down to incomplete national coverage and a lack of resources to finance an effective promotional campaign. The new PD Roberto Barone,

who has also taken over the morning drive slot, said he would maintain many of the comic and infotainment elements created by Simioli but that he would drop the old

slogan "The Show Radio".

We are shifting our target the 18-35 demographic, whereas in the past the station had a much younger appeal,' says Barone adding, "We will be playlisting less aggressive music and increasing our news output from five times daily to bulletin every hour." Antonello Irace who has been appointed KKFM's new marketing director says the new executive had been given 6 months to show results. "We have changed the whole internal structure of the station, and our first goal is to concentrate on programming which we hope will show positive results in terms of audience growth within six months," says Irace.

### Baltic States Get Groovy

COPENHAGEN - At presstime the Baltic States are preparing for the launch of a new seminar. Danish rock promoters will lead a Nordic delegation to the Baltic States where they will share their experiences in a seminar, "Groovy Management '96" for band and festival managers in Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia.

The idea was initiated by the Danish Music Information Centre & the Baltic Music Network, and financed by the Danish Ministry of Culture. Music consultant Mikael Højris from MXP says that the October 20-28 seminar will strive to provide Baltic promoters and managers with the tools necessary to survive in the jungle of the music business.

In Tallinn, Estonia, the first of the two-day sessions will focus on PR and promotion, with tips on strategies, products and export potentials, along with lectures on IT. Høiris will deliver the address. "Sign your life away on the dotted line." The Riga gathering will also take a look at promotion, management and the organisation of festivals, followed by a panel discussion with label representatives. The final sessions, October 26-27 focus on contractual aspects of the industry, as well as promotion topics.

### Basque label celebrates

Fiercely independent Basque label Esan Ozenki ("sav it loud" in the Basque language Euskera) celebrated its fifth anniversary with concerts on October 19 in five different cities: Madrid: Barcelona and Valencia in Spain, as well as Paris and Bordeaux. The label's best known band is Negu Gorriak, which has played in many European and Latin American countries. Typical of the label's philosophy was the Madrid event in a large building occupied by squatters. Two Basque bands and a group of four Swiss teenagers called Wemean played. Wemean record for the imprint Gora Herriak ("long live the regions") as do many radical non-Spanish acts.

### Pepsi Renews Chart Deal

Pepsi has renewed its sponsorship of The Pepsi Chart thanks to a new deal with Commercial Radio Companies Association worth an estimated £3 million (app. US\$4.6 million), Off-air marketing initiatives being coordinated by Broadcast Innovations will help establish The Pepsi Chart as a brand name in its own right, and proposed plans already include a retail



compilation album, a live event programme and a range of branded merchandise. Pepsi UK managing director Simon Calver says, "The youth market is extremely important to Pepsi-Cola, and this sponsorship deal illustrates how we are constantly building our relationship with youth entertainment. Music is an ideal way of communicating with this age group-with its specific teen relevance and contemporary values-and we feel that the chart remains the most appropriate media vehicle for Pepsi in the UK. Furthermore, developing The Pepsi Chart as a property will enable us to develop this across a broad cross section of disciplines.

Licence Fee To Be Raised? Government consultants Braxton Associates have determined that the BBC has cut costs as far as possible and requires an increase in the licence fee to fund its digital broadcasting plans. The fee, now set at £89.50 (app US\$139), is currently pegged to the retail price index. Braxton recommends a new fee of £100.

### **Dance Heralded** In Amsterdam

AMSTERDAM - The first Amsterdam Dance Event took place in Holland's capital, October 17-19, and played host to more than 700 international dance industry members, exceeding the organisation's expectation of 550 participants.

A music conference set up to celebrate dance music and strengthen its international network, the Amsterdam Dance Event included an exhibition of stands filled mainly by independent dance labels, a small new media demonstration room and panel discussions. The ADE's strongest point, however, proved to be getting the right people to attend. Top dance industry members and media players from across Europe and the US took part in panel discussions, as well as general discussion going on in the Networking Lounge. Subjects spanned from cultivating the underground to increasing market shares with an overall accent on dance music's broad spectrum and future.

Smaller, more focused conferences seem to be the trend these days. The Amsterdam Dance Event, organised by Conamus, covered strictly dance music. The specific focus made it possible to delve more deeply into the different aspects of dance music and allowed the nightime club programming to examine the span of dance subgenres.

The fact that the first edition of the Amsterdam Dance Event attracted participants from as far and wide as Argentina, the Czech Republic, Malaysia and Japan is a statement in itself and bears witness to the power and influence of dance music around the world today.

Dates for next year's event are to be announced soon.

### Prague's Radio 1 Gets A Makeover, US Style

PRAGUE American-based broadcast group Metromedia International (MMI) has International expanded its Central and East-European portfolio by acquiring a majority stake in Radio 1, Prague's only alternative radio station.

New Radio 1 general director Hank Loeser says he intends to steer the station into a successful commercial environment by retaining the station's streetwise and introducing a image playlist. After extensive market research to determine what potential listeners want from the new look Radio 1, changes are expected to take effect early in the new year.

Radio 1 was the Czech

Republic's first independent privately-owned broadcaster. It began transmitting in October 1990 as a pirate station amid the state radio and television monopoly, and had a licence granted in February 1991.

Although it enjoys wide domestic name recognition, latest audience figures from Media Project assign Radio 1 with 2.12% of listeners, one of the lowest in the Czech capital. The station has consistently failed to attract a wider audience because of the quality of its offerings fluctuate wildly. Since the station went to air, its crew of volunteer DJs have enjoyed almost total control of the airwaves. Many of the station's prominent DJs closely follow trends of British dance music, non-commercial

American hip-hop and independent rock-elements almost entirely absent from Prague's other commercial radio stations.

According to Loeser, the new Radio 1 will still be, "unique, but we can make it more reliable. It will never be the dominant station in Prague, but it can be the coolest. And it won't be hard to take some of the larger stations' listeners as they all sound the same.

Among MMI's current European holdings is Radio Seven in Moscow, Radio Katusha in St Petersburg, Radio Niko in the Black sea city Sochi, the Latvian capital's Radio Skonto and Radio Juventus in Budapest. MMI is also seeking stations in Turkey, Romania, Belarus, Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan.

### Radio Contact **Recaps With Sony**

BRUSSELS - As a part of its communication strategy, the Belgian Radio Contact network is releasing a series of six double-CDs with Sony Music, recapitulating the private network's sixteen vears

Titled Radio Contact Top 15, the series marks the first ever major partnership between a leading private network and a multinational record company. collaborations Other media-sponsorship mainly deals, with Radio Contact setting up campaigns on radio, TV and print media and Sony Music handling the retail promotion side.

"The idea was to create something special both for the Radio Contact aficionados and a broader audience," Jean Lou Bertin, head of programming and station manager with the French language wing of Belgium's leading private network, "and that's why we have included station-calls and ID's on each CD, one for each language group.

The album series was compiled by the network's PD's Bertin and Danny Debruyn and depicts 15 hits per disc from 1980 to the present. "It wasn't easy indeed getting the necessary clearance for all of the tracks," comments Sony Music strategic marketing manager Henk Penseel, "but we have been able to make a very interesting package for the audience as Danny Debruyn has written the Radio Contact story featured in each volume.

### **New VP For** Nordic BMG

STOCKHOLM - BMG has become one of the first record labels to take a step towards a co-ordinated Nordic approach by appointing Hans Breitholz, managing director of the BMG Ariola Swedish operation, as vice president of the Nordic region.

Breitholz says his appointment will enable BMG to centralise administration, while strengthening other areas such as marketing, on a local level. "At the same time we'll be able to present the outside world with a united front," he says.

As well as the five Nordic nations: Sweden; Norway; Finland; Denmark and Iceland, Breitholz's brief will also cover the Baltic states. BMG already has a marketing office in Riga, the capital of Latvia, and although Breitholz is wary of the wide-scale piracy industry there, he is optimistic about the future. "There's a lot of good music in the Baltic states," he says. "In a few years I think we're going to see plenty of talent emerging.

Efforts to create a common music market throughout Scandinavia have floundered before as the countries have sufficiently differing tastes to make it impossible to predict an act that will sell everywhere.

However, this may be the start of more pan-Nordic moves. "Topp 40", the music industry magazine published in each of the Scandinavian countries, has announced it will soon bring out an international edition titled "Topp 40 Scandinavia".

### AB Disques Switches Distribution To EMI

PARIS - AB Disques, one of France's leading independent labels, has switched distribution from BMG to EMI in France.

Operational since October 1, the deal is a sign of EMI's increasing aggressiveness in the French market, developing both through internal growth, with the recent signings of major acts including Charles Aznavour, Michel Jonasz and Supertramp, and external growth by attracting indie labels, such as AB, for distribution.

Jean-Michel Fava, managing director of AB Disques, says he chose EMI because, "it's a very assertive company, and I believe their market

share will grow in the coming years."

AB signed with BMG three years ago under the former president Bernard Carbonez. Sources say that Fava also had a good relationship with former BMG vice-president Claude Amrane, who moved to EMI earlier this year where he is in charge of operations, and no longer had close ties with any members of the new team at BMG.

In a statement, EMI president Gilbert Ohayon thanked AB for their trust is EMI. "We are very happy to welcome one of the most important independent French producers," says Ohayon, adding "managed by a music professional, Jean-Michel Fava, AB Disques is a major actor in our industry and has produced many artists, among them Dorothée, Hélène, Les Musclés, Carlos, Christophe Rippert, Anthony Dupray, Manuela, Les Jumelles, annette and Alain Barrière. AB Disques has also diversified recently with the creation of a new label, PàM (Pense à Moi), which focuses on artist development.'

AB's catalogue comprises some 600 recordings and according to Fava, has grossed up to Ffr 120 million (app. US\$22.5 million).

### DJ Causes Storm At Danmarks Radio

COPENHAGEN - A listener called Casper Christensen in the studio to complain that he did not listen to other people. Before she could finish, Christensen hung up. The zany former TV-show host was doing a week-long guest stint at Danmarks Radio's morning program, Strax.

The popular 09:10-12:00 show is a theme-oriented, call/fax-in weekday feature. Christensen's guest appearance during the October 14-18 holiday week was billed as Strax Fiction, with a photo of him in drag, posing as if Uma Thurman from "Pulp Fiction". The shows certainly grabbed listeners' attention, in fact the Danes have never heard anything like it.

"We plan to feature him on Strax every Friday until Christmas," says Judith Skriver, Strax producer from DR's P3. Another DR spokesman said that so many people became indignant at the shows that it caused a storm of protest phone calls.

Christensen told the press that he has been inspired by the BBC's Chris Evans. To be Strax Fiction absolute mayhem. Music & Media's ear in Copenhagen listened to segments of the week's programming, and was infuriated when Christensen played the first 30 seconds of Stairway to Heaven, and then interrupted it with his motormouthed jabbering. But Led Zeppelin was replaced by humour from a man who is able to ride with a radio programme, taking his wit close to the line of indignation, and providing a fresh spark to the airwayes.

Skriver says the numbers on Strax Fiction are not in yet, but judging by the media coverage and the writing on the wall, it's a hit. P3 listeners have something to look, forward to on Fridays between now and Christmas.

### Salone Della Musica Signals Steps Forward For Italy

TURIN - October has been designated "A Month For Music" by Italy's music industry, who used the first edition of a new trade fair, Salone Della Musica, held in Turin October 10-15, to announce a series of initiatives aimed at turning around a long term decline in music sales. The measures include a re-launch of the CD single format, new music awards, and a review of CD price structures.

The Italian government contributed by offering to support efforts to reduce sales tax (IVA) on recorded music from 16% to 4%, and announced a tough new law to fight audiovisual piracy. Italy's minister of culture and deputy prime minister Walter Veltroni minister Walter Veltroni announced that the government intended to introduce a new law to support live music by next February. "We are working on a proposed law with the main objectives being to support local authorities to construct or renovate suitable live music venues. Existing dusty sports arenas with terrible acoustics are not adequate," said Veltroni adding that more extensive music education and facilities will be introduced into schools.

Italy's IFPI recognised industry federation FIMI declared October a special music month. To coincide with the Salone Della Musica, the five major multi-nationals (BMG, Warner Music, Poly-Gram, EMI and Sony) offered 150 best selling titles at 20% discount throughout Italy.

The CD single format, until now used primarily as a pro-motional tool will be relaunched as a new format next January (Music & Media, October 5). PolyGram Italy president Stefano Senardi said that FIMI's new single chart compiled by the Nielsen market research company, which was to have been launched in Turin at the Salone Della Musica, will now be launched in January to coincide with the CD single format re-launch. "We preferred to wait until January when the new CD single is launched before starting the new singles chart," says Senardi adding, "at moment the majority of singles sold are vinyl 12" mixes through very specialist outlets, making it difficult to extrapolate an accurate sample of singles sales.

The new CD single will market three tracks in a cardboard sleeve for L9.900 (app. US\$6.5). "We will have a special CD single display in around 200 outlets and hope that the new format will show significant growth by next May," says Senardi. It is hoped that the psychologically significant price of less than L 10.000 will promote impulse purchasing, and reintroduce the music-buying habit in Italy where the annual per capita spending on records of US\$10 is very low compared with other developed markets.

Franco Cabrini, president of Sony Music Italy said that the first FIMI sponsored music awards "Gran Premio Italiano Della Musica" will take place in December 1997 with the nominations announced in September. The awards will be decided by a panel of music industry professionals including press, radio & TV personnel, composers, video clip producers, retailers, producers, managers as well as record company personnel.

Categories for the awards include separate Italian and International awards for best album, single, group, new talent, dance artist, soundtrack, classical and operatic release. In addition there are awards for best Italian artist (male and female), best Italian video-clip and a special prize defined by the organising committee.

Commenting on the success of the first Salone Della Musica in Turin, Senardi says, "This is the first time outside of the Sanremo Festival that music has received so much sustained media attention over a whole week."

### Umeå New Swedish Pop Mecca

STOCKHOLM - Umeå, a small city far up in the very north of Sweden, has been selected as the country's "Pop Town '97" by the national youth channel

The pubcaster's award means that Umeå will be the site of live broadcasts throughout a special weekend at the end of January, and that the town will be the focus of attention for much of the channel's music reportage during 1997.

The award, which is in its second year, is designed to highlight towns which have created an atmosphere where pop music, both live and in clubs, can thrive. One of the criteria is that the town in question should have produced substantial new talent of its own.

In 1996 the first Pop Town has been the southern university city of Lund, at the other end of the country from Umeå. Lund is the home of several of Sweden's best young artists, including guitar pop kings Brainpool. A national tour by three new bands from Lund—Loosegoats, Dipper and Pornostar—has been arranged this winter, and will end in Umeå.

### Jamiroquai Travels High Into Album Chart


AMSTERDAM - Although it's not the easiest title to pronounce, Jamiroquai's single Virtual Insanity conquers all boundaries in radio-land and is receiving automatic airplay on numerous EHR, dance and rock-slanted formats throughout Europe. The third album Travelling Without Moving, from which the single is taken, has registered impressive crossborder sales too; recently, it reached a number 3 position in Music & Media's European Top 100, the highest-charting Jamiroquai album so far.

A large part of the success can be attributed to Jamiroquai's clever and accessible '70s-based jazz-dance sound. Another part, says Sony Music UK international marketing director Jon Fowler, is frontman Jay Kay's MTVfriendly appearance. "His charisma makes him a pop star in the true sense of the word. His collaboration with M-Beat on the track Do You Know Where You're Coming From [featured as a bonus track on the album], warmed up the audience for a reintroduction, while his own single put him firmly back on the map. In terms of promotion, the artist has matured and developed. We made a geographical plan based on strong areas to further strengthen his appeal.'

The biggest market outside the UK for Jamiroquai is France. Three weeks after release, the album had already reached gold status (200.000 copies sold).

Sony Music France's S.M.A.L.L. product manager Olivier Bealu was involved with the artist at a very early stage. He remembers putting Jamiroquai flyers in specialised shops in March 1993, the in getting an item broadcast on the primetime evening news programme, around the time of the album release.

Good teamwork between management, label and the artist is essential.



time of the debut single  $When\ You\ Gonna$  Learn?.

The key strategy for most of the marketing campaigns that S.M.A.L.L. undertakes is guaranteeing an early setup. Way before the actual release of the new album, in April of this year, Bealu started the promotional campaign. A video crew from national TV station Antenne 2 was invited to attend the mixing of the album in June. This helped

believes Bealu. "You always have to explain to an artist why he has to get involved in promotion." Other reasons for the band's success in France are Jamiroquai's "soul grooves, the French just love them. Also, Kay's nonconformist image helps in this respect," he adds.

In Italy the album is already close to platinum. Italy marketing director Marco Boraso has been very busy with the European launch of the album. "As you might know, Jay Kay is very much involved with Formula One racing. We came up with the idea of launching the album at the day of the Italian Formula One races in Monza. It was a great day," Boraso remembers, "but logistically not so easy to organise. About 200.000 spectators were following the races. We invited about 100 guests to listen to the album in the morning and watch the races together with Jamiroquai in the afternoon. Surprisingly, Jay Kay's favourite car brand won the races!"

Jamiroquai's European tour starts on November 15 and will bring the band to Holland, Belgium, Germany, Denmark, Switzerland, Italy, France and Spain.

Although Sweden is not included in the tour schedule, Mattias Arwidson, head of music at Swedish Radio FM 104.3/ Nörkoping thinks direct access to the artist is not so vital anymore. "Recent call-outs to our audience have taught us that they don't have the patience to listen to interviews anymore. What's more important for programming the single is that it has proven to put a broad range of our listeners in a good mood."

### The Corrs' Irish Pop-Rock Joins Celtic Trend

London - The Corrs are three sisters and one brother who hail from Dundalk, a border town 50 miles north of Dublin. They're massive in their home country, huge in Denmark and their album dislodged R.E.M. from the top of the charts in Australia. They sold over a million copies of their debut album Forgiven, Not Forgotten (143/Lava/Atlantic) worldwide, and yet a year after its release across most of Europe, the buzz is only just beginning in several territories.

The quartet went professional in 1990, honing their characteristic musical style which Jim Corr, calls "traditional Irish pop-rock." They soon met their manager John Hughes who was getting musicians together for Alan Parker's "The Commitments" and one of the sisters, Andrea, starred in the film. "They're good musicians, they're friendly and the music is



global," says Hughes, explaining their appeal. "It has rhythm, it has melody and it's fresh. There's a Celtic trend going on everywhere at the moment." The group has spent the past 12 months promoting the record from North America to Australia and Europe.

Although Forgiven, Not Forgotten is six times platinum at home, they are still relatively unknown across the Irish sea. Their major European success story has been in Denmark, where the album reached number 4 and went platinum. Their debut single Runaway went to Danish radio last November to coincide with the band's support slot with Celine Dion. Two subsequent singles received good airplay and the new one Love To Love You is to follow suit. It's the fourth single from the album which will be released all over Europe, although France has started working the previous single The Right Time. So far, their Celtic sound has been wellreceived in France. According to Warner Music Europe marketing director of US

labels, Andy Murray, airplay has definitely generated sales. He adds that radio has also been supportive in Germany, Sweden, Spain, Italy and more recently Holland, where regional radio ran a promotion in co-operation with retailers at the end of September around the single's release. Acoustic sessions have also proved popular and Murray sees the quartet play live

for stations as an important part of their promotional activities.

Radio's next material from the Corrs will be a promo-only minialbum of live tracks recorded in Denmark by Danmarks Radio P3, to be released in November. As for the second album, John Hughes says it will be recorded in the US with David Foster producing half of it, while Jagged Little Pill producer Glen Ballard will take care of the rest.

### **Creating A** Win/Win/Win Situation

by Vincent Turco

### RADIO SALES

In previous articles partnerships between radio and advertisers in Belgium and Germany were examined. Good coordination between the programming department, sales and the advertiser can result in successful campaigns and a win/win/ win effect.

As a salesperson or sales manager, how many times have you gone to your programming and promotion department with an idea that you know will not be put on the air? It is the nature of sales people to try and say yes to every client's request to air a promotion on the radio. But we do this without thinking first about the overall goals of the programme director and promotion department. If salespeople first defined their position as well as their advertiser's in relation to the programming department, many conflicts could be avoided.

and Programming receive their mandate from the managing director of the station. Some of the main goals are to:

- Increase ratings
- Create listener loyalty
- Develop a "brand" for the radio

In Italy, network RTL 102.5 Hit Radio instructs its salespeople to obtain a detailed brief from the advertiser prior to presenting an idea to promotion and programming staff. They have found that by communicating programming's objectives to sales, it's easier to create the type of on-the-air "value-added" promotion targeted to the advertiser's strategic marketing goals. The sales department already has the interests of the programming department in mind because they know the station's position in the Italian market and how its listeners identify with their favourite station. Programming knows that the audience ratings will grow if they include the following elements on

- Audience participation
- Interesting and exciting games
- A fun and entertaining listening

In one case RTL 102.5 approached Nestlé to see if the station could help them with a new product launch. In 1994 Nestlé introduced "Cappuccino Nescafé," an instant hot beverage available in individual powdered servings. The target audience for the campaign on RTL 102.5 was adults 18-35. Nestlé wanted to enhance the spot campaign with an on-air promotion in order to achieve the following objec-

- 1) Communicate to a younger target audience the on-going consumer promotion called "Fly away on vacation with Cappuccino Nescafé.
- 2) Create and stimulate use and purchase of the product by describing the taste of the product along with its convenience-it's quick and easy to use. It should be noted that in Italy people prefer to drink cappuccino in a café or coffee bar, so the positioning statement used in the campaign was, "The cappuccino that you can prepare at home just like the one you drink in the bar!"

### Radio For Marketing

Tasting or sampling the product was necessary to reinforce the advertising message and stimulate sales. Here we can see the power of radio used as a marketing tool to advertisers. Not only can the radio commercial be used to create a brand, but it also can incorporate marketing techniques like redemption and sampling for advertisers.

The actual on-air promotion involves listeners being invited to call in to guess a "mystery nation." The prize is a "Cappuccino Card" and a Nescafé cappuccino sample product. Every day the DJ takes the listeners to a different "mystery' country where they can use their card. The listeners are advised not to call unless they are willing to have some fun. The DJ instructs the caller to imitate sounds such as airplanes landing and taking off, flamenco dancing, castanets, ocean noises and the like, while clues are given to the identity of the mysterious country they are about to visit.

The station benefitted a great deal from the promotion. Listeners were entertained and the advertiser received numerous promotional spots. Nescafé was able to get its product sampled by their target audience through the campaign. Through sampling the product, the advertiser was attempting to establish its "brand" in the Italian market.

### **Theatre Of Mind**

In another campaign, RTL 102.5 used radio's "theatre of the mind" qualities to help a brand create a line extension. Aperol "Soda" was introduced by the Barbero company in Italy in 1995, and wanted to use radio to achieve the following goals:

- Increased awareness of the product
- Expanding the consumer base to a younger target

Aperol, a traditional alcoholic aperitif, is a direct competitor with Campari in Italy. Aperol Soda is a pre-mixed beverage with only a 3% alcohol content, which the company wanted to position as both a healthy drink and a thirst



At designated "aperitif" times, 12:00 and 19:00, RTL 102.5 created the "Aperol Soda Meeting At The Bar." Listeners are transported daily into an imaginary bar where they are invited to call in to "drink" Aperol Soda along with the DJ on the air. As in the case of Nescafé, the radio station attempts to create a "real" bar with sound effects. During the call, the DJ promotes the various qualities of the product as he drinks it. At the end of the meeting in the "bar," he offers the caller the opportunity to invite someone to drink a real Aperol Soda in a real bar in the caller's home

The example illustrates a classic case of image building by the advertiser. The fact that you are inviting someone to drink the product reinforces the desired advertising message which is that Aperol Soda is:

- A good drink in social settings
- Fun to drink
- Young and modern
- Healthy—with low alcohol content

### Radio, Brand Loyalty

The on air "virtual bar" also reinforces the atmosphere created by the accompanying TV campaign in which young people are seen drinking the product, socialising and having fun in a bar setting. Radio can be seen as the important connection to the "visual transfer" of the TV campaign. The interactive promotion is able to create the sensation in the mind of the listener that he

or she is actually drinking and enjoying the product.

The image of a product is usually seen by marketers as being that "intangible" element which is necessary to create the brand. We buy the product because of the way it makes us feel as opposed to such tangible aspects as taste and smell. We associate brand loyalty with the product which is able to communicate this feeling better than its competitors. The DJ's strong association with RTL 102.5's listening audience also helped Aperol Soda break through to achieve an image association. The listener reasons, "If my favourite DJ likes Aperol Soda then maybe I should try it also." Or more directly, "I want to feel as good as the DJ who is drinking Aperol Soda."


What we can learn from these examples is that when we as radio marketers study our position together with our advertisers and programming department, we can achieve a win/win/win situation where all participants receive benefits from the radio campaign and promotion.

Italy's Radio DeeJay has a simple but attractive site that serves as an extension of its on-air character. Basic information such as scheduling details and local frequencies are easy to find, as are the personal e-mail addresses for each member of the staff. Sponsorship is not obtrusive, and a page of links to external sites that might be of interest to the

station's listeners is provided. There is also a Usenet-style bulletin board area where visitors can carry on discussions about whatever they like. Virtually everything is in Italian, with a few English buzzwords.

### Iberic Rhythms Swing On World Stage

The term 'world music' defines an attitude as much as it describes a genre. An attitude on the part of consumers to move outside the conventional limits of western pop, and on the part of musicians and producers to look beyond those limits for their artistic inspiration.

HEN viewed from this perspective, the term surmounts the rather narrow definition of ethnic or folk music from outside the western tradition. As more attention is paid to world music by all sectors of the industry, from the media to festival promoters, record companies and retailers, the genre itself is evolv-

ing, resulting in higher quality pro-

ductions and more interesting collaborations.

Spain is one of the richest of European territories, offering a variety of musical styles deeply rooted in local traditions, which are having an increasing influence on pop music everywhere. In this regard, two of the year's most awaited albums, Temporal from Radio Tarifa and Santiago from the Chieftains (both BMG) recast very different Spanish musical traditions into exciting contemporary

Radio Tarifa's 1993 debut. Rumba Argelina was one of the most acclaimed albums within world music circles. Temporal continues the group's exploration and

expansion of Spanish music and its Mediterranean

sources. adding elements modern to medieval compositions and mixing instruments like the electric bass, accordion and saxophone with traditional ones like the

cane flute and a host of Arab and Turkish string instruments and percussion. Long forgotten Iberian popular songs, sephardic tunes, Greek modes, Saharan influences and flamenco give rise to a fascinating and infectious contemporary sound which has made the group a particularly popular draw on its recent European tours.

Reed player, multi-instrumentalist and Radio Tarifa member Javier Paxariño uses some of these same elements to extraordinary effect on his Perihelion (Nuba), which approaches the material from a more personal, experimental standpoint.

### **Galician Celtic Roots**

The Celtic music of Galicia, on Spain's northwest coast, is the inspiration for the Chieftains' Santiago, featuring native Carlos Nuñez on the gaita, or Galician bagpipes, as well as performances by Ry Cooder, Eliot Fisk, Linda Ronstadt and Los Lobos. The album not only celebrates Galicia's Celtic roots, but the influence of Galician emigrants on the music of the new world. Nuñez has travelled extensively with the Chieftains, and his own album, with help in turn from the Chieftains and Cooder, will be released internationally early next year.

The Galician connection has been mined for years by Spain's own Milladoiro whose new double CD, As Fadas De Estraño Nome, recorded live in Buenos Aires, was recently released by Barcelona indie Discmedi. The first cut on Santiago is called Txalaparta after the evocative Basque percussion instrument which is also highlighted on composer Tomas San Miguel's beautiful and intriguing

> homage region Basque Lezao (Nuevos Medios), which fea-**Javier** tures Paxariño, Kepa Junkera who also plays on Santiago-on trikitixa, or box accordion. Further Celtic bloodlines can be traced on Basque

trio Hiru Truku's more traditional debut on Nuevos Medios, which includes appearances by renowned UK fiddlers Eliza Carthy and Nancy Kerr.

### **Afro-Portuguese Wind**

The other Iberian culture which is generating a great deal of musical activity of late is Portugal's, and its Afro-Portuguese and Brazilian brethren. Lisbon, Salvador da Bahia and Luanda are the vertices of a triangle stretching across the Atlantic Ocean. Luso Mania (Piran-

ha) is the name of a brilliant new collection recorded live in the summer of 1995 at Berlin's Heimat-Klange Festival which presents artists from throughout this flourishing musical matrix. Gumbé, forró, morna-three styles, three different countries-united by a common heritage. Brazilians Margareth Menezes and accordionist Oswaldinho, Angola's Bonga and Waldemar Bastos (familiar to listeners of last year's Luaka Bop compilation Telling Stories To The Sea), and violinist Agostinho de Pina of the Cape Verde Islands are just a few of the dozens of musicians who contribute to this Portuguese garden of delights.

Portugal's own national musical style is known as fado, and Paulo Bragança is a young fado singer intent on renovating the melancholy form by adding far-flung rhythmic and melodic elements such as hip hop or bossa nova, imbuing it with a contemporary, urban edge. He has already enjoyed wide success in Portugal, and his upcoming Luaka Bop release, slated for November, will deservedly introduce him to a

wider audience.

But it's Brazil's rich multitude of styles which has provided the world with the most popular and influential Portuguese inflected music, from bossa nova to lambada, samba to the more explicitly African sounds of Bahia. Hemisphere, EMI's world music label, has many discs dedicated to documenting this abundant heritage, such as Yele Brazil, a gathering of Bahia's best, and the latest, Samba, an impeccable anthology of some of the genre's best known artists, including Ivan Lins, Elis Regina, Djavan, and Clara Nunez. The late Nunez, one of samba's greatest stars, is the focus of another Hemisphere release, Com Vida, an enthralling tribute in the form of a series of duets, created in the studio after her death, with the likes of Chico Buarque, Gilberto Gil, Milton Nascimento and Joao Bosco.

Crammed Disc's Moleque De Rua, a gritty musical reflection of life in the streets of Brazil's cities

from a group composed of streetwise kids who sing of their own poverty, social-exclusion and survival, spent months heading the World Music Charts Europe last year. Although it can hardly be called a world music album, Verve's collaboration with the Red Hot Organization, Red Hot & Rio, with participation from Brazilian musicians like Astrud Gilberto, Flora Purim, and Caetano Veloso teamed with international pop stars such as George Michael, Sting, Ryuichi Sakamoto, Crystal Waters and David Byrne, demonstrates the interest Portuguese music is currently engendering.

### Ethno-Coloured Rock

Ethno Punk, Around The World With Attitude is another unusual and vibrant compilation from Hemisphere, a sampling of rootsy rock from as far afield as Japan (Parsha Club), China (Ciu Jian), and Brazil (Paralamas Do Sucesso), as well as closer to home, with cuts from Italy's colorful Mau Mau, Sweden's Den Fule, France's Mano Negra, Spain's Ciudad Jardin and Poland's Raz, Dwa, Trzy, among others. Scotland's Shooglenifty will also appear on the upcoming Folk 'N' Hell collection covering that region's exciting new alternative folk/rock scene.

### Afro-Celtic To Afro Beat

Celtic music's influence and inspiration is only comparable to that of Africa. Now the Afro Celt Sound System (Real World) means to merge them. It is less ambient and more rhythmic than this summer's Nusrat Fateh Ali Khan album Night Song, which was also a hit for the label. Lightly textured keyboard washes frame a dialogue between the celtic harp and a talking drum, or the kora and uilleann pipes. Dance rhythms alternate with reels, and members of Senegalese superstar Baaba Maal's band jam with Shooglenifty's self-described "hypnofunkadelia." This is an evolving project so we can expect more in the future.


The other bright star in this season's world music firmament is Malian singer Oumou Sangare's terrific new album Worotan (World Circuit) currently number 1 on the World Music Charts Europe. Faithful both to her homeland and her humanist principles, this is her most consistent album to date. Her voice is capable of both soaring energy and imploring sadness, aided by affecting backup vocals, fabulous guitar playing, and the help of reedman Pee Wee Ellis, all wrapped in pristine production which captures all the subtle force of Sangare's voice. Upcoming from the label is singer/composer Cheikh Lô's Ne La Thiass, the first international release by Youssou N'Dour's Jololi label. His November 17 concert in Cologne will be broadcast live by WDR.







### **Breakin' & Entering**

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Bob Macdonald

Winning the Sales Breaker award for the second week in a row, Simply Red cruises from number 7 to the very top of the European Top 100
Albums chart. Greatest Hits (East West) is the fourth consecutive number 1 for Mick Hucknall and friends, and is currently ranked first in the UK and Austria, with top 5 placings also in Germany, Belgium, Sweden and Ireland. The imminent release of the single Angel, a cover of the 1973 Aretha Franklin hit on which Hucknall is backed by members of the Fugees, should ensure continued momentum for the album.



Phil Collins

Competition is likely to come in the shape of fellow Warner Music artist Phil Collins, who earns the highest new entry at number 7 with Dance Into The Light (WEA). The album's Euro-position is helped by number 1 debuts in Germany and Switzerland. Collins is looking for his fourth European Top 100 Albums chart-topper of the '90s, having already hit the top spot with ... But Seriously, Serious Hits...Live! (which enjoyed a new lease of life in France earlier this year) and Both Sides.

The second highest newcomer is Only

Human (Mercury), in at number 20 for Dina Carroll. It's the follow-up to the singer's long-running A&M debut album So Close, which first entered the chart in February 1993 but did not reach its peak (number 8) until exactly a year later.

On the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles, the Spice Girls' success story continues unabated. Wannabe (Virgin) logs its eighth week at number 1, tying the Fugees' Killing Me Softly (Ruffhouse/Columbia) as the second longest survivor among 1996 chart-toppers. This year's most tenacious number 1 to date is Robert Miles' Children (DBX), which ruled the chart for 13 weeks between March and June. Meanwhile the Girls could become the first act in recent years to replace themselves at the top, as their more R&B-flavoured follow-up Say You'll Be There zooms 23 places to number 5 in only its second charted week. The song not only wins the Sales Breaker honour on the Eurochart, but also receives the Radio Active award on the EHR Top 40 (page 25).

Also emerging as a number 1 contender is Faithless' Insomnia (Blow Up), which surges four places to number 3 in its 23rd week on the survey. The single gets a boost from its successful re-promotion in the act's native UK, where it bounds from 49 to number 4. Insomnia was only a minor British hit on its first release in 1995.



"The reason for the arrangement with Virgin for parts of Europe, Latin America and Africa, is that we are not ready to go into these territories on our own," Calder says. "The independent network in those territories was not as strong as it is in, say, the Asia-Pacific region for us to have strategic partners in each of the countries.

For Weiss, the big attraction of independent partners is that they are more likely to take a chance on new artists. In his view, "We are very adventurous and on the cutting edge with our A&R, and we always try to be ahead of a trend," says Weiss. "Our partners have to have some vision because often our artists don't break on the first single, or the first album. You need to be putting down the basic grassroot foundations of artist development on the first two albums. I think it is a case with most multi-national companies, not just BMG, that they are looking for a shortcut-'Where is the hit single in America, where is the hit single in the UK?'

The move towards a network of independent partners coincides with Zomba's acquisition of 75% of Pinnacle, a company with distribution operations in the UK and in continental Europe. Asked whether Zomba would be looking to take equity in any of its new independent partners in the future, Calder says, "They all know we are always interested in that. We are in for the long-run."

In Europe, Zomba is commited to building up its repertoire from this area of the world. In the UK, that will mean an expanded role for Pinnacle. Calder explains, "Pinnacle has traditionally been a distributor. What we are now doing in conjunction with Steve Mason [Pinnacle chairman], is developing what we are calling the Pinnacle Label Group. We are going to be developing a group of grassroots independent labels, which Pinnacle is going to fund and own, that is then going to become part of the repertoire mix that goes out to the rest of the world under the Zomba umbrella.

"In the same way you will have a record coming from Jive in New York, you are going to have repertoire that is being developed in the U.K. within the Pinnacle group.'

Calder hopes to see the first fruits of the venture in the first quarter of 1997. Zomba's European presence will also be strengthened in the new year with the opening of a Scandinavian office, which is expected to be in Sweden and up and running by April.

He explains, "London is the centre of the music industry in Europe and there are several projects that we'll be able to set up in London and spread to our other stations around Europe. In terms of advertising, London is also becoming a major payer, with internationbudgets concentrated

According to the applica-tion NRJ's affiliate Energy London Ltd has filed to UK Radio Authority, the French operator is proposing to launch an EHR station targeted at the 15-35 demos. "The format will not be dissimilar to the one we have in France but closer that in Stokholm," says NRJ programme director Christophe Sabot. "But it will be adapted to local needs. Our goal is to create a young and innovative station.

Sabot says the group has invested heavily in research and marketing to better evaluate the needs of the local audience. "London is a very complex and tough market, but we believe there is room for new stations targeting the youth, says Sabot.

### Cecchetto Rumoured To Be Courting Naples Kiss

Industry sources report that Claudio Cecchetto is negotiating with Neapolitan businesswoman Lucia Niespoli to acquire part of her Naples based radio holdings. Cecchetto who began expanding his Milan regional Capital Radio nationwide last January, still lacks coverage in the south of Italy. Due to a poor ratings and financial performance at Niespoli's national network Kiss Kiss FM, she appointed new management last month who in turn have replaced all but one of the networks on-air staff. KKFM's new PD Roberto Barone dismissed industry rumours that KKFM itself was up for sale as "lies circulated by our rivals." However Cecchetto is said to be also interested in Niespoli's other two regional outlets, Italian music only formatted Kiss Kiss Italia and Kiss Kiss Napoli.

### Branson On The Prowl In France

OTR hears that Richard Branson's new label V2 has been hunting for a general manager in France to oversee its operations there. It is rumoured that a final choice has been made and that a Sony Music executive will be their man in France. The initial plan calls for a very "light" structure, with less than ten staffers. In addition, discussions have been engaged with several distributors, among them Sony Music, Virgin and indie PIAS, for a possible distribution of the

The taster for the soundtrack album of "Evita", the film version of Webber's musical, starring Madonna, kicks off at number 20. It is

boosted by a 39-station roster, spread out over 11 European countries. At this stage, Denmark, Italy and the UK are best represented on the list, with national penetration ratios between 47-57%.

You Must Love Me is the 16th hit on European Hit Radio for Madonna since the inception of the chart in December 1990. Three of her previous hits on the format achieved number 1 status-This Used To Be My Playground (1992, eight weeks at number 1), Erotica (1992, four weeks) and Secret (1994, three weeks).

The most added song of the week is the Bee Gees cover Words by Boyzone. No less than 22

programmers have reported the track for the first time this week. It has gained ground particularly in Poland, Denmark, Belgium, Spain and Portugal and has

### On The Road

Border Breakers commentary by Pieter Kops

The fastest climber in this week's Border Breakers chart is Italian pop idol **Eros Ramazzotti**'s *L'Aurora/La Aurora* (DDD). The single leaps up 11 places, landing at number 10 with 11 non-Italian stations at its side, while earning the Road Runner award in the process. The artist's previous single, the six-week chart topper Stella Ĝemella, is still positioned at number 2.

Crossover support for Ramazzotti's new single is spread out over five countries. Spain leads the list with a 44% penetration ratio, due to rotation on four heavyweight reporters, including the national networks Cadena 40 Principales, Cadena 100 and Cadena Dial, all based in Madrid. Other countries where radio has welcomed the track include Denmark, Switzerland, Belgium and Poland.

Danish songstress Hanne Boel (EMI-Medley) grabs the highest new entry in the chart at number 12 with *Broken Angel*, a classy ballad, mixed by **Bob Clearmountain**. This remarkable, international radio following for Broken Angel was anticipated in our September 21 issue, when the track was chosen as single of the week. No less than 20 stations outside Scandinavia have now put it on rotation, 51% of these being Gold or Platinumranked. Its crossover roster counts five territories; of these, Switzerland, Poland and Italy are most supportive, while the Czech Republic and Latvia complete the list with one station each.

Entering the chart closely behind Boel at number 13 is Beyond The Invisible by German Virgin act Enigma (the nom de plume of Michael Cretu). Outside GSA, the track—the taster for Enigma's forthcoming album Le Roi Est Mort, Vive Le Roi!has been put on the playlist by 12 stations, spread over six territories. Particularly in Italy, it has encountered considerable support, as four programmers in that country have joined in-two of them Platinum-ranked (RTL 102.5 - Hit Radio/Bergamo and Radio 105/Milan). Beyond The Invisible has also met with Platinum radio support in Spain (Cadena 100/Madrid) and Portugal (Antena 3/ Lisbon). Other countries that appear on the list include Denmark, Norway and the UK. Since the inception of the Border Breakers chart in October 1993, Enigma enjoyed one number 1 hit—1994's Return To Innocence, which occupied the chart's top slot for seven weeks, six of which were consecutive.

Finally we must inform you that Axelle Red (Virgin), whose A Tatons jumps up from number 19 to 15 during its fourth charting week, was not the person portrayed in our October 12 issue, contrary

to the photo caption. Moreover, this person was of a different sex, being the artist's manager Filip Vanes. For those who want to know what Axelle Red really looks like, here she is. We apologize for any inconvenience caused.



The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful Non-European artists according to airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M aims to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.







