

GWR Reshuffles Management

London - GWR Group plc, one of the UK's largest commercial radio groups, has revealed details of a reshuffled management structure designed, among other things, to give its local outlets more programming autonomy and profit responsibility.

The group, which currently owns 32 commercial licences in the UK, plus extensive radio interests in

Europe and New Zealand, has been intensely active in the acquisitions market following relaxation of ownership rules in the Broadcasting Act 1996, and is about to secure full ownership of national commercial station Classic FM.

The group's new management structure is considered by industry sources to be a necessary response to its rapid increase in size.

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Euro-Station To Launch In '97

LONDON - A new pan-European radio station plans to begin broadcasting in the first quarter of 1997.

The European Broadcasting Corporation, whose backers include the owners of the UK armed forces network BFBS, says it will start broadcasting its station—Euro-Zone—next year on terrestrial frequencies in at least four different European countries.

The frequencies obtained by EuroZone so far are in Brussels, Gent, Antwerp, Gibraltar, Costa Del Sol, Rome and Milan. The frequen-

cies are understood to have been obtained by the direct purchase of stations, the winning of advertised local licences and joint ventures with existing local operators. EuroZone says it is also "optimistic" about winning licence applications in the London and Dusseldorf areas in time for the launch. EuroZone will not be available as a satellite radio service in the immediate future, although it will be using satellite to deliver programmes to its network of terrestrial stations. The service could, however, also be made available to stations as a sustaining service.

EuroZone will broadcast an EHR format based loosely on Music & Media's Eurochart Hot 100, although there will also be some specialist music programming. The station's programming board of EuroZone will have representatives from six key countries, and local affiliate stations will also be a considerable amount of local autonomy in music programming.

Programme director Aidan Donovan says, "The music policy will aim to put the 'broad' back into broadcasting, and avoid the narrowcasting of so many other radio stations."

MTV Awards Sold To RTL2

LONDON - MTV Europe has struck its biggest ever single programme sales deal with national German TV station RTL2 for the repeat transmission of the 1996 MTV Europe Music Awards (EMA).

MTV's flagship programme will take place on November 14 at London's Alexandra Palace. Under the agreement, RTL2 will produce a 90 minute edit of the show for terrestrial broadcast on November 17. The edit will be presented by Viva VJ Heike Makatsch who will start her own show on RTL next year.

The RTL deal follows just three weeks after a similar agreement with UK broadcaster LWT to transmit an edited

Danish ZTV To Close

COPENHAGEN - After one and a half years the Danish music and youth TV channel ZTV is to close at the end of November due to poor advertising revenues.

Managing director Ole Inggaard admits that the satellite channel's revenues were disappointing, but he lays the blame at the door of the Danish ad market, "We were up against a lot of conservatism," he says.

"Here advertisers are only interested in huge viewing figures, like a big soccer match. They don't seem to understand that we could hit just the slice of the market that would suit their product. They see that big is beautiful, but miss the fact that small is sexy."

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Entering The EuroZone

Between The Lines

There are two things in the European radio business that have so far never worked. One is operating a truly alternative rock format, the other is launching a genuinely pan-European radio station.

I am optimistic about the prospects of alternative rock radio (one day variety will be the name of the game in Europe), but I am still sceptical about the potential of "Eurovision" style radio. Obviously I am not referring to the successful crossborder investments of French radio operators like NRJ and Europe 2: they have launched foreign

franchises (who often take on a very local character) after they have firmly established themselves on the domestic market.

But in the case of EuroZone (see front page), it's the opposite case: they're intending to beam out their signal to a number of satellite stations who, for the most part, will adopt the centralised programming approach.

Despite the increased communication between EC member states, and the rise of the homogeneous Euro-pop genre, the road to pan-European radio is paved with stumbling blocks.

First of all, there's the issue of pan-European advertising. Believe me, we struggled with it (and still do) when we launched this publication: there are only a handful of brands who are active in all major European markets and even if they are, advertising concepts can hardly ever be applied across the

Problem number two: the programming concept. Unless you take the narrowcast route (and that's precisely what EuroZone says it doesn't want to do) and air only music which is accepted Europe-wide (i.e Euro-dance), your audiences will turn off. Although this publication has campaigned long and hard for a broader acceptance of continental European music, the reality is still that local audiences want to be served by local programming content. And what about the quotas? If you start airing 40% French music (as is required by French law) you can hardly speak of a pan-European service.

And I don't want to sound too negative, but securing local terrestrial licences is even harder to accomplish; we all know how hard it is for foreign radio operators to enter a domestic market.

It's a bold move to launch a service like this, and I really would like to see it succeed. But if EuroZone can't provide the numbers (and pan-European audience research is non-existent), advertisers will not be convinced.

Even before I launched NewsTalk 93.6 in Berlin, I was convinced that Europe is prime territory for talk radio because of the experience with the media environment I've had covering the Continent since the early 1980s as a news correspondent for NBC

For me it is exciting that there is such widespread talk experimentation on European commercial radio. Obviously each market is different, but one of the things we've proved in the US is that talk radio requires a long-term commitment: the real rewards start arriving in the second and third years of consistent programming.

My own programming, training and consulting work at the Berlin news and talk station only confirmed for me the ripening of the European marketplace for talk, especially because the spontaneity of talk clearly appeals to listeners frustrated by repetitious music programmes. In addition, we've seen the value for European radio of the skills we've developed over the last generation with American talk radio—skills I now know without question translate across cultural and linguistic borders.

First Italian Private Radio Ad Statistics Revealed

MILAN - Official statistics measuring the advertising market share of Italy's private radio stations have been released for the first time by the Italian affiliate of the international market research company Nielsen.

Whilst figures for Italy's public radio service RAI have been regularly revealed by Nielsen and other surveys, until recently Italy's private radio operators have been notoriously shy about revealing their financial performance.

Industry observers say that the inclusion of private radio advertising revenue in surveys officially sanctioned by the advertising and media business follows the recent rapid growth in Italy's radio advertising market, and indicates a maturity in the country's previously chaotic private radio sector.

Statistics for the first nine months of this year (January-September '96) put total radio advertising spend at billion (app. divided US\$144.7 million) into L117.33 billion for private radio and L102.3 billion for pubcaster RAI's three radio networks. These figures give total radio advertising spend a 3.4% share of the global advertising spend in Italy.

Whilst there are no comparisons available for private stations, advertising on RAI increased 10.3% against the same period last year, in line with the overall growth in advertising in Italy for the first nine months of 1996.

Figures revealed by Italy's second largest private radio network, Rome based Radio Dimensione Suono (RDS), illustrate that the leading four private national networks and the top regional stations in each local market are taking the lion's share of advertising, with estimates claiming that three out of four local stations are operating at a loss.

RDS managing director Eduardo Montefusco says that there is still room for extensive growth before Italy's radio market expands reach market shares achieved in other western

European markets. "We estimate that total revenue for RDS will reach L40 billion (app. US\$26.4 million) this year compared with L35 billion in 1995. Calculating revenues based on full capacity of available commercial airtime puts our potential revenue at L90 billion which will put us in the same level as leading European radio markets such as France and the UK," says Montefusco adding, "special live events including recent open air televised concerts sponsored by RDS and Renault Clio, and joint sponsorship of sports events have surpassed expectations in terms of promotion and revenues for RDS.

MCM To Launch Atlas Video Awards At Midem

PARIS - French music channel MCM International will present a completely redesigned music video competition at Midem in Cannes, January 1997.

Renamed MCM Videomusique Atlas, the new international music awards are meant to crown the most innovative videos produced anywhere in the world over the past 12 months. MCM International managing director François Thiellet says the event has been designed to highlight creativity and put

video production from various countries in focus, especially that from Europe and Africa. Thiellet says the Atlas awards will provide a window to clips, "which rarely have the possibility to get exposure.

A jury of professionals, presided over by music producer Martin Meissonnier, will gather in Paris on December 10 to screen several hundred videos and select the entries and winners in each category. The jury will award prizes in the following categories: best film-making; best editing; best screenplay; best cinematography; best lowbudget title as well as best European and best African video. A grand prize will be awarded to the overall best video clip of the year.

The results will be presented at Midem at the Palais des Festivals in Cannes in a 90 minute programme featuring three entries and the winners from each category. In addition, the winning videos will get extra exposure on MCM.

Bjork's Army Of Mine won the grand prize at Midem 1996, and the competition included videos from over 40 countries.

Spanish Awards Commend European Radio Shows

MADRID - Britain's BBC, France's SRF and Germany's ARD/WDR have won the top three prizes in the radio section of Spain's Premios Ondas audiovisual awards covering radio, television, music and cinema.

A record 160 candidates from 30 countries entered the competition, which is Spain's Oscar, Grammy and Emmy ceremonies rolled into one and is organised by the Grupo Prisa media holding company which owns the country's largest private radio company, Cadena SER. The 43rd award ceremony will be held in Barcelona on November 14.

BBC Radio's "Word or

Mouth" won its Onda prize "for the intelligent and amusing way it deals with certain educational matters," according to the jury. The SRF programme "Lieux de Memoire: La 2CV, Une Modeste Huitième Merveille du Monde", was selected for the "sparkling and intelligent method of using an original focus on one of the apects of a nation's character, in this case a legendary car."

Germany's "Mein Wunderbares Schattenspiel" was noted for its artistic qualities put to use "in an intelligent and honest focus on certain aspects of the history of Germany."

For the first time, the national radio awards were split into categories. Best national programme was Onda

Cero Radio's "Un Mundo Sin Barreras," which "each after-noon carries to the listener a message of solidarity, creating sensitivity and interest in the problems of all types of handicapped groups." Best local radio programme went to "El Programa de Carlos Herrera" on Canal Sur Radio in the southern Andalucia region. The jury noted its imagination and creativity in broadcasting an Andalucian view of the world. DJ Angel Alvarez was voted as best musical presenter for his long-running Cadena SER M-80 programme 'Vuelo 605" which, said the jury, "has constituted an obligatory reference point" in the knowledge and broadcasting of pop music.

Musical discovery of the year was singer-songwriter Rosana Arbelo, who has sold some 350.000 units of her debut album Lunas Rotas. She won two awards in the music section: best album and revelation. Not surprisingly, the ubiquitous Macarena by Los Del Rio, which has become the most successful Spanish single ever, won a special mention from the jury. Other awards went to Luz Casal (best song -Lo Eres Todo), Ketama (best Spanish group), Miguel Bosé (best video for *El Autorradio* Brazil's Caetano Veloso (best latin artist), Ricky Martin (latin revelation), Héroes del Silencio (best live group), José Menese (jury mention for flamenco singer), and both Phil Collins and Paul Anka for their contribution to popular music.

Roadrunner Plans Further Expansion In France

PARIS - Roadrunner, the Amsterdam-based indie label which specialises in heavy metal and hardcore rock, is planning to expand in France, with the arrival on November 1 of Olivier Lebeau, former marketing director of EMI label Chrysalis in France, as general manager of Roadrunner's Paris-office.

Over the past eight months, Lebeau has been working for multimedia company Infonie, supervising their Internet activities. Lebeau reports directly to Roadrunner founder Cees Wessels. Former general manager Stéphane Saunier left the company to join pay-channel Canal+, where he is in charge of the music programming for the TV show "Nulle Part Ailleurs".

Lebeau says he wants Roadrunner to be perceived globally not only as a heavy metal/hardcore label but as a label for all musical styles. "We want to optimise our sales and marketing efforts and do our best in a rather depressed market," he says. "One of my main concerns is to find ways of working with national radio nets who obviously don't need us to fill their playlists. It's a problem for

indie labels but also a real challenge."

Another priority for Lebeau is to develop the local roster. Roadrunner already had signed some local acts, but this strategy will be strengthened. "We are going to search for new talent," says Lebeau, who adds that the scope of the signings will not be limited to rock acts. For a transition period, Lebeau will be acting as A&R manager until the position is filled.

Roadrunner employs ten people in France and is expected to gross some Ffr 30 million (app. US\$5.5 million) in 1996

PARIS - Radio group Skyrock is beefing up its management staff with the arrival of former Fun Radio scheduling director David Massard, also known as Difool when he hosted Fun's show "Lovin' Fun".

Massard was let go by Fun president Benoit Sillard at the end of August as part of a programme of global restructuring at Fun. Skyrock president Pierre Bellanger says Massard will be in charge of local programming Syrock, respecting a non-competitive clause Massard had

signed with Fun Radio, preventing him from being on air, and dealing with matters of national programming.

"In order to respect this non-competitive clause, we have decided to be open and allocate local programming to Massard," says Bellanger. "We have about 40 local programmes which represent 20% of our total programming. There is a lot to do and this is extremely useful work."

In addition, Bellanger has decided to promote his two closest aides, programme director Laurent Bouneau and

Skyrock Staffing Irish Ratings Show Gains **For Commercial Stations**

DUBLIN - Latest JNLR/MRBI audience research shows that the commercial radio sector in Ireland is continuing its steady growth.

54% of Irish radio listeners tuned to a commercial station every weekday in the six months between April and September this year, a 2% increase on the same period last year.

National audiences for talk/ MOR pubcaster RTE Radio 1 declined by 1% to 34%, although RTE's EHR music station 2FM managed to hold its audience at 29%, despite the increased competition from local commercial stations.

Michael O'Keefe, chief executive of the Independent Radio and Television Commission (IRTC), comments, "Independent stations have once again reinforced their position as the preferred option for Irish listeners, with over half the country's listeners tuning into an independent station each weekday."

The commercial sector chalked up its best figures in the Munster area (60%) and Connacht/Ulster (57%)

In Dublin, FM104 built on its recently-won status as the city's number one music station (Music & Media, May 18) with a daily audience reach of 229.00. FM104 now has a 41.000 daily lead over former market-leader Classic Hits 98FM.

Intercord Closes Stuttgart Distribution Centre

STUTTGART - EMI-owned label Intercord will relocate distribution, logistics and part of its administration to EMI Electrola's distribution centre in Cologne, effective July 1, 1997.

Intercord MD Herbert Kollisch announced the closure of the company's 20 year old warehouse in Stuttgart on October 30. Kollisch expects

some 40 jobs to be cut as a result of the restructuring. The cost benefits from shed-Interding cord's distribution department

will be used to expand the company's A&R and promotion activities.

Kollisch points out that the move will increase Intercord's competitive advantage and safeguard the company's creative staff. According to own estimates, Intercord currently has a 5% share in the German market thanks to a flourishing domestic A&R policy which has established acts like Pur and Fettes Brot in the German charts. With Fool's Garden the label also boasts one of Germany's most successful pop exports.

We act like a small creative team but have the market clout of a large company," explains Kollisch of the label's

A&R successes. "Thus we can operate with major muscle without giving artists the feeling of being ignored in spite of the flood of new releases.

Citing the performance of Fool's Garden and E-Rotic, EMI Europe president and CEO Rupert Perry says in a written statement that he is confident that Intercord will continue to show that German artists can also have international impact.

Talent Meets Know How

Sony Revitalises Portrait Label

FRANKFURT - Sony Music Germany is reactivating "de facto" its Portrait label with the appointment of Tom Ströbele as director, effective December

Ströbele is currently employed as label-manager national at EMI affiliate Inter-

in Stuttgart. Sony Music senior VP GSA Jochen Leuschner is mapping out ambitious plans for the Portrait label and is supporting the appointment due to Ströbele's track record in local A&R. Ströbele responsible Intercord's signing of million sellers Pur. Leuschner is confident


that, "Tom is the ideal candidate to develop Portrait to a third force in Sony Music's artist marketing next to Columbia and Epic.

As Portrait director Ströbele will report directly to Sony Music Germany deputy MD Uwe S. Fendt. According to Fendt the label faces a significant boost in importance as a 'fully fledged national pop label operating parallel to Sony international Music's imprints." Portrait will focus on commercial pop music for the domestic market as well as for export. Revealing his immediate priorities for the new year, Ströbele says, "we will definitely work at establishing

German artists on the international market."

The appointment closes the final gap in Sony Music Germany's restructuring which started last August (Music & Media, August 10). The company has achieved a turnover of DM 207.4 million (app. US\$130 million) for the first

six months of 1996. This represents a 11% growth compared to the first half of previous year. Sony Columbia division Music's accounts for 24.3%, Epic for 18% and Sony Music Mediacomprising strategic marketing, classical and Portrait-for 48.8% of the company's total turnover during this period.

Cadena 100's 'Jungle' Walks On The Wild Side

Bad luck, or what? Even the best radio shows have their off days, and *Clockwatch* was certainly out of luck when we tuned into Cadena 100 for "Bienvenido A La Jungla" ("Welcome To The Jungla")

Jungie).

Where was El Pulpo ("The Octopus") with his awful singing voice? What had happened to El Ciego ("The Blind Man") and his excellent imitations of politicians and rival nets' jocks? And why was there so much out-of-character interviewing of Carlos Goñi, the lead singer of Spanish band Revolver?

The answer is that, apart from it being Monday morning, not all "zoo" members were in their studio cages, and an agreement with Warner Music Spain meant that the show's main presenter, José Antonio Abellán (probably Spain's most popular jock) was committed to doing a lengthy promotion for Revolver's new album Calle Mayor during the show.

So, "Bienvenido A La Jungla" is usu-

ally much wilder than this, but it's still good to hear the tamer side of what the latest EGM ratings say is the most

popular morning show in Madrid and many other Spanish cities.

The EGM survey also gave Cadena 100 as a whole more than one million listeners for the first time since the net was launched in 1992, leaving director Rafael Revert euphoric. Owned by Cadena COPE, it is essentially a rock-based full-service station.

Revert is a veteran of music radio, and helped set up Spain's first music FM station—Cadena SER's Los 40 Principales—in 1966. He acknowledges that "The Jungle" is largely responsible for Cadena 100's current success.

Indeed, cynics (that is, the rest of the radio industry) suggest that Cadena 100 would be nothing without Abel-

lán. Revert and Abellán's partnership goes back nearly 20 years, when the 16 year-old with obvious potential was taken on at Los 40 Principales by Revert.

"I could see the lad would go a long way, and his popularity at Los 40 and then here has been well deserved," he says. "I once sacked him, and he went to work for a while at Onda Cero Musica [now Onda 10], but when I moved here to set up Cadena 100 we got back together again."

So what happened on Monday's show? "Ah, nothing really. It was just an off day. He [Abellán] doesn't usually do straight interviews, but we had a commitment with a label and things didn't quite take off."

Mayhem, Irreverence

Even so, a first-time listener tuning into the show that morning would still have been impressed by the degree of mayhem and irreverence offered by "The Jungle." Our *Clockwatch* hour started with the show's "zoo" giving a lamentable version of an unidentifiable song amid much cackling and howling,

with El Pulpo and El Ciego joining Patricia—who is always liable to burst into song at any moment—in vying to tell

stories about their weekend.



Abellán has a completely free hand in his choice of music, and it is no exaggeration to say that he has created stars. His method? If he likes a demo tape or a new record, especially if the artist is virtually unknown, he will play the songs frequently without saying who the artist is.

This year he did it with an unknown singer-songwriter, Rosana Arbelo. Within days, fans were calling the programme and almost begging him on air to reveal the singer's identity. He refused for a long time, until the buzz had got around and MCA released her debut album, Lunas Rotas. By late-October, the album was

still number one after 20 weeks, and had sold over 330.000 units. When asked in a recent interview the reason for her success, Rosana said "It was probably Abellán—he was like my godfather."

Revert claims the current success of EMI's female duo Ella Baila Sola is also due largely to Abellán's initial airplay—sales of its debut album of the same name are now in excess of 100.000.

Zany Humour

But the real strength of "The Jungle" is Abellan's zany sense of humour, which often has a cruel streak running through it. How else can you describe the phoning up of unwitting members of the public who are then ridiculed on the air (usually though a "friend" of the victim who has written to Abellán to tell him something about the victim).

An example during our *Clockwatch* hour was a call to a young woman who had just had a baby. Abellán made the call on an old dial phone (or so it sounded) and the woman answered. Abellán introduced himself as a representative of a well-known chain of baby-care shops, and told her that if she could name 10 baby-care items, the chain would give them to her for free.

The woman seemed tired and confused, and was finding it difficult to think beyond basic items like nappies and milk bottles. She was hindered considerably by Abellán's hectoring and one suspected she would have liked to put the phone down. But Abellán finally said the items would be on their way soon—a complete lie, of course.

"We always contact the person soon after [the call] to say that it was a joke," explains Revert. "Nobody minds, and when we say that so-and-so friend contacted us with the idea, they see the funny side. The jokes work because Abellán uses real references. Some people think the companies mentioned are paying for the advertising, but it's not the case."

"The Octopus" who appears on the show is, in fact, producer Carlos Moreno, and the nickname refers to the fact that while he is singing like the Bard in Asterix, his hands are busy operating the desk. "The Blind Man," with his excellent and hilarious imitations, really is blind—Revert discovered him through a Los 40 DJ talent contest.

Another ex-Los 40 participant in the show is Jordi Casoliva, who contributes via an open microphone at the Cadena 100 studio in Barcelona. Revert says that almost nothing in the show is premeditated, and that "The Jungle" works precisely because it is "absolutely natural and spontaneous." And of course, chaotic.

Student Audience

Revert says the show has all types of listeners, although university students form a strong core. Certainly, the humour of "The Jungle" smacks of college pranks, but it also tends to be a little exclusive in the way that the "incrowd" humour of students often is.

"The Jungle" has few competitions, and those that it does run tend to be of the very participative "tell us your craziest holiday story" variety. News, traffic and other information bites are inserted by the network's local stations around the country into three-minute breaks every hour.

Revert is a big fan of the show in his roles of both station director and ordinary listener. "Abellán's skill is that he is a great communicator with young people," he notes. "He's close to being a kind of preacher man, if he isn't that already."



Baby Boomers Cry Out For Own Format

'Wrinkly radio' is the wrong attitude toward a potential market numbering some 120 million Europe-wide. Broadcast sales specialist Tony Grundy says radio is missing out on a potential listeners base not only strong in numbers, but in economic clout. He pleads for serious attention to his demographic.

■ RADIO FORMATS

It's a simple enough question, and yet nobody so far has got the answer. I'm nearly 48 years old (finally admitting it!). That makes me a "baby boomer"—a post-war baby—a teenager in the swinging '60s. Part, therefore, of a demographic phenomenon which today sees 120 million people across Europe over 50 years old. By comparison, the US has only 67 million people 50 years and older.

Quoted in *Music & Media* (November 4, 1995), French advertising executive Jean-Paul Tréguer said that in Europe this age group would increase in size by 75% between 1990-2020, while those under 50 would only increase by 1% over the same period. He went on to affirm, by way of example, that France has 17 million over 50 year-olds representing a wealth of US\$137 billion. So why have we so far failed to create a suitable format to sell to advertisers that will access this valuable demographic?

Babies Holding Reins

The interesting thing is that in most other areas, be it politics, sport, fashion or music, baby boomers are in control. Much of today's charts contain re-worked versions of hits from some 20 years ago-TV and radio advertisements feature music from the same era. Today's fashion makes it difficult to tell a person's age just by the way they dress. The baby boomers are getting older, but they aren't anxious to admit it or don't think it's relevant. This group is not about to let go. It has tremendous economic clout and yet, in radio terms, we don't seem to know how or don't care about the need to market to

Across Europe the story is the same. Apart from the odd exception, nobody is giving the demographic the attention it deserves. Could it be that the people who programme the music are getting younger and can't relate to these listener's needs, or is it a vicious circle created by simplistically referring to this market as the "grey economy" or "golden oldies," which many advertising agencies are not apparently interested in? If you look at the UK market, with some 18 million peo-

ple over 50, 15% (2.7 million) don't listen to radio at all (Saga Radio/Infinity 1995). There are many more that do listen, but my premise is that they are listening because it is what they grew up with—but it is largely by default that stations still have them. Let's look at what's on offer in the UK:

- BBC Radio 1 is just not aimed at them any more;
- Radio 2 is too old and patronising;
- Radio 3 is, well, Radio 3 really!
- Radio 4 is very professional but predictable and old-feeling, and no music:
- 5 Live is great if you're into sport;
- Commercial radio FM is, largely speaking, aimed at a younger market, presented by DJs;
- Commercial radio AM is "golden oldies." Great if you're in some type of '60s time warp, but there's a limit to how many times you can hear Gerry And The Pacemakers without cracking up;
- BBC local radio is "wooden box" radio—safe, boring, and aimed at the 70+ market;
- Commercial national brands do offer something, but, Virgin on AM, come on!
- Classic FM is classy—but it's only part of the equation.

Lumped Together

The problem is that, so far, whenever people come up with a format they lump all of this vast number together and say "over 50s." So apparently that means that at 48 I am going to have the same musical tastes and interests as my mum who is 73? I don't think so. I would have a great deal more in common with today's 40 year-old and younger (it's worth noting that when I'm in my car, the Oasis tape I play is mine and not my 15 yearold daughter's). Perhaps programmers have been looking at this matter from the wrong standpoint because, surely, if they were able to deliver a strong 40-60 year-old profile as a niche market, advertisers would flock to buy.

So don't think of it as "oldies" or "wrinkly radio"—that's a real turn off. In fact, don't talk about age at all. It's not about age, but more about attitude and outlook, and the baby boomers have got lots of it. Don't assume anything, but do please surprise us. Create radio

that we won't switch away from because we're not sure what you're going to do next. The presenters should be *real* personalities with brains.

Selling The Format

You need to think about who should sell this product and how it should be sold. Why is it that most selling in radio goes to the FM channel when both AM and FM are available? The answer is that the salesperson very often doesn't listen to the AM Gold channel, so they can't relate to it—a self-fulfilling prophesy if there ever was one. The station that's crying out to be created would be sold by professional sales people, possibly older, and presumably likely to be bright enough to appreciate the massive value of becoming an expert in a market that is going to continue growing by some 75% over the next 25 years or so.

With the help of people like Tréguer in France and radio consultant Claudio Astorri in Italy (Music & Media, March 23 1996), perhaps the radio business in Europe will wake up to the true potential of this powerful demo-

graphic. I am a firm believer that until radio presents a clear, well-branded product that reaches the 40-60 age profile, we have no right to accuse advertisers and clients of being the barrier to success in reaching baby boomers. So there is the challenge—now create the format!

Nobody can find their way around the Internet without using search engines. Yahoo, one of the leaders in this field, has now taken steps to localise its service by adding home pages in Germany, the UK and elsewhere in addition to its US page.

The new sites provide two main innovations for users. Choice of language is the most noticeable. Secondly, the search results are heirarchically weighted in favour of the geographical base but without omitting international findings. Therefore, a search for radio stations, for example, would list those in the user's home country before stations elsewhere. Sponsorship logos are also localised.



Sliding And Diving - 4AD PRODUCER: Tanya Donelly, Wally Gagel A true product of Boston's Fort Apache studio, this first sign of life from Belly's frontwoman has a surprising freshness to it. Whereas Bum plays with stark techno beats and fuzzy guitars, Restless is a stunningly beautiful ballad with Rich Gilbert on pedal steel guitar, in which Donelly's warm vocals reach dizzying heights. More rock-oriented is Human with its out-of-control guitars and wah wah pedals. Swoon easily matches Restless in subtlety.

THE CARDIGANS

Been It - Stockholm/Polydor ehr/ace PRODUCER: Tore Johansson Sometimes innocent music hides indecent lyrics. This new midtempo track of the Swedish easy listening-poppers is a censored radio edit. In the original, which is delivered as track number two, the naive female voice sings "I've been your whore", which is hidden under an organ lick in the controlled version. Lyrics notwithstanding, your listeners will love this snappy, jazzy tune.

Love To Love You - Lava/Atlantic ehr/ace PRODUCER: David Foster

The Irish Corrs are three gorgeous sisters and one brother. This poppy melodic track from their worldwide million-selling album Forgiven, Not Forgotten is wellarranged and easy to enjoy. At the end, you have a chance to discover their Irish background by the traditional violin riffs.

GLORIA ESTEFAN

I'm Not Giving You Up - Epic/Sony ehr/ace PRODUCERS: Emilio Estefan Jr., Kike Santander

The prominent percussion and Spanish guitars take your mind to warmer places... and such a response is imaginable, because this characteristic Estefanballad is one of her best for a long time.

GOTA & THE LOW DOG

When The Morning Brings Another Day - SPV PRODUCER: not listed d/ehr/ace "I got the answers on the radio today, sounds like I'm all alone again". That's one way to start a radio-friendly jazzdance tune with a nice bluesy voice, wahwah guitars and old organs. If you're looking for an intro for a funky radioshow

you should give the extra track Live Wired Electro a spin.

HEROES DEL SILENCIO

Maldito Duende - EMI r/ehr PRODUCER: Andy Jackson They may have retired for a while, but the Spanish goth-rockers can still be enjoyed on CD. This live single with its mighty drums breathes a little life and drama into their anthemic brand of rock.

WALLY McKEY

Dreaming - Masters/ZYX ehr/ace PRODUCERS: McKey, Laverman It's time to have fun! McKey manages to recreate the sound of the '20s on a modern synthesizer, although it's an original song. Expect lots of funny sounds, even the sound of a musical saw is modernised.

Universal - Virgin ehr/ace PRODUCER: Andy McCluskey, Matthew Vaughan, David Nicholas OMD's Walking On The Milky Way received a lot of airplay thoughout Europe and it's obvious that this one walks the same way. Universal has a Christmas season sound with a delicious

AXELLE RED

A Tâtons - Virgin ace/ehr PRODUCER: Wouter van Belle, Axelle Red

Red's blue-eyed soul has a surprisingly genuine feeling. She can definitely stand her own with the Memphis vets who joined her in the Nashville Castle studio. Her warm, deep voice can obviously handle this mid-tempo funky soul track.

SOUND OF R.E.L.S.

All The Best Girls - Fazer/Warner ehr/d PRODUCER: R.E.L.S.

Finnish Eurodance with a soulful twist. The mid-tempo beats and the Wham!sounding horns give it a poppy flavour, but the vocals are distinctly R&B. This deserves a spin outside of Finland too.

2 FABIOLA

Universal Love - Circus/EMI ehr/ace PRODUCERS: BVBA, Krimson This eurohouse-act is already very popular in Belgium. Starting with a staccato intro, a pleasant parlando female voice is added to warm synthesizer layers, which give this slow song some seasonal feeling.

UNDERGROUND CIRCUS

I Am The King - SPV d/ehr PRODUCER: Tom Frederikse Not the sound of the underground, but a little reminiscent of the late ABC. Though the single version has a rockattitude with slight synthesizers, this can simply turned to more dance-oriented stuff, as the three remixes show.

WILD WOMEN OF WONGA

Thank You - S+F ehr/d PRODUCER: not listed We're not dealing with riot grllls here, but with a pleasant dance track, which has a great salsa piano riff, cute female vocals and a mid-tempo poppy beat.

JOHNNY CASH

c/r/ace Unchained - American/BMG PRODUCER: Rick Rubin

Rubin really goes out on a limb here, with Cash doing Beck (Rowboat) and Soundgarden (Rusty Cage) compositions, accompanied by Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers. Other guests include Flea, Marty Stewart and Linsay Buckingham. Cash's collaborators pick up on his unapolegetic rawness, which is really the star of this album. His own Country Boy and Mean Eved Cat have a no-holds-barred rockabilly stomp, but it's death songs like Spiritual ("Jesus I don't wanna die alone") that really bare Cash's soul mercilessly. Warmer in tone is his version of Petty's Southern Accents.

ETIENNE DAHO

Eden - Virgin ehr/ace/d PRODUCERS: Daho, Turboust The French pioneer of sensitive melodies has discovered electronic dance beats and ambient trance sounds, resulting in an exciting album. Particularly strong is the sure-fire EHR hit Au Commencement with its mellow jungle beats and *Les Pluies Chaudes De L'Été*, which is based on a Massive Attack shuffle and a languid, breezy Brazilian sound. Daho gives an enigmatic Twin Peaks twist to it, which gives it a little spice. He continues his Brazilian trip with Astrud Gilberto in Les Bords De Seine. Daho's easy listening streak comes out in the Swingle Singers collaboration Timide Intimité.

The Explorer - Stockholm/Polydor d/ehr PRODUCER: E-Type, Denniz Pop, various Opening with a traditional medieval track E-Type surprises fans and critics. You can't believe your ears when you hear him rock in the speedy We Gotta Go and toast in the dubby reggae track So Dem A Com. Both well produced and very catchy as always. Single candidates are the slight funky driven Fall From The Sky or I Just Wanna Be With You with Ace Of Bass-beats. But with this album E-Type shows he explored his broad musical capabilities.

THE FUTURE SOUND OF LONDON

Dead Cities -EBV/Virgin PRODUCERS:The Future Sound Of London The electronic Pink Floyd of the '90s designed another adventurous soundscape of nearly seventy minutes. Radiowise FSOL is still making hard accessable music, but there are some possibilities for programmers who aren't playing it on the safe side. They can opt for the Chemical Brothers-influenced hard-hitting We Have Explosive or try the beautiful dolphin-sounding ambientwise Yage to encourage their listeners to catch this extraordinairy project.

THE PRESIDENTS OF THE UNITED **STATES OF AMERICA**

II - Columbia ehr/r/a/ace PRODUCERS: Presidents "Let's Rock!" (Ladies And Gentlemen) is the opening line of the Presidents' second

album and that's exactly what they do. Despite a gruelling tour schedule, these guys have found the time to deliver another fresh album full of melodic radio gems. Lunatic Love and Tiki God have a fun punk feel, while the happy surf melodies of Volcano are just as radiofriendly as the current single Mach 5. Froggie is a jazzy novelty track with its furious rockabilly beat, fast riffs and a funky feeling.



Axelle Red Records Blue-Eyed Soul Album With Memphis Vets

BRUSSELS - "Axelle Red is the kind of singer whose success is not defined by her hits, but her talent. Whether her career goes up or down, she will always be there." That's how Virgin Belgium MD Firmin Michiels introduces the Flemish speaking French language artist, whose second album A Tâtons was recorded with the aristocracy of Memphis soul.

Hawkins was the real thing for her. Steve Cropper's typical guitar licks from Otis Redding's and Booker T's hits, have found their way in to Axelle's

The album also features an extra hidden track featuring Axelle Red and soul legend Isaac Haves. "Axelle and Isaac met in Amsterdam-he talked to her about 'wanting to do something in French' and they were off to Memphis's House of Blues studios after the album

"The new album also keeps up with the initial 15-25 core audience who have grown three years older," adds Vanes, "and I hope they follow Axelle. That's why we're launching A Tâtons on all radio formats. She will also be available for interviews with a broad range of stations."

Firmin Michiels says the album will be put on the market "the gentle and easy way": no press conference or what calls "over-the-top-stunts". He

prefers awaiting the momentum of the album release, which will at least yield four or five singles.

Although Axelle Red is signed to Virgin Belgium, the company has devoted quite some attention to the singer on an international level. The fact that Axelle has been incorporated in Virgin France's national artist roster, alongside Julien Clerc, Renaud, Françoise Hardy and Etienne Daho, is the best illustration that Virgin takes things seriously. Also, non-French language territories like Holland

and Germany agreed to release A Tâtons simultaneously on October 18th. Scandinavia, Italy, Spain and Greece will follow before the end of the year as they all are convinced of Axelle's talent

and her blue eyed soul.'



Axelle Red joined Virgin after her second single, Kennedy Boulevard opened up the way to the charts in Belgium and France. Her 1993 debut album, Sans plus attendre was propelled by the single Sensualité. Radio hits such as Je T'Attends and Le Monde Tourne Mal, sold close to half a million units in mainly French speaking territories.

Axelle's second album A Tâtons was recorded in Nashville's Castle studios. which to her was a dream come true. As her manager Filip Vanes of Music & Roses, explains, "She always wanted to go out and record with the people she admired as a fan. Working with Stax and Atlantic veterans like Steve Cropper, Lester Snell and Roger considers it a gadget, stepping away from the album", explains Vanes.

All Format Launch

For A Tâtons, Axelle Red teamed up producer Wouter -having written the bulk of the Bellesongs herself, with contributions by Albert Hammond and the Seff brothers. A Tâtons has become a very personal album. "The album also sounds more mature compared to Sans Plus Attendre," says Michiels, "and the fact that Axelle has been more involved in the production and songwriting makes it a different record.'

Tailor-made for FM Radio

Virgin France product manager of local repertoir Nicolas Dufournet says Axelle Red is particularly loved by French radio. "She delivers what I would call music tailor-made for FM radio. To prepare for the release of the album, we have sent our radio promo team on the road to push the single. Programmers were informed about the album's recording process and its guest musicians. We created a buzz which

resulted in the single entering the Top FM playlist within a week of release, something Virgin hasn't seen in the last three years.

The Real Thing

Dufournet adds that Virgin France concluded a deal with Europe 2 to advertise the album on radio, TV and print. "It's a common practice here," he says. "Europe 2 applied for it almost a year ago. Their access to print media has been decisive in the deal, as radio is happy to play Axelle, but printed advertising is quite expensive in France." Europe 2 head of music Nicolas Du Roy says A Tâtons will soon move up from three to five plays per day as the single reflects both melody and freshness. "What we like about Axelle's new single is the catchy melody and groove-it's no 'chanson' but music that fits our concept," says Zürich-based Radio Z head of music Michelle Raue. "Most of the liked the programmers immediately and although we have no quota on foreign products, it's always nice to pick a song like A Tâtons.'

Also BRTN Radio 2 producer Rino Ver Eecke is equally enthusiastic about the new album. "Axelle came to visit us in the studio to present the album. We really appreciate her taking the time to sing live in the studio, so the audience knows it's the real thing."





Research Companies Versus **Do-It-Yourself Software**

Software seems to be the answer to everything nowadays, and radio research is no exception. Several European stations now turn to in-house software to fulfil their call-out testing needs. Mary Weller compares the advantages of two systems: what do research professionals recommend?

F you're not using one of these programmes yourself, you have probably at least heard of BPR Programming (Broadcast Research) or RCS' SongTrack. These two programmes seem to be the two most popular in-house software packages available today. With them, some stations are conducting research call-outs from their own offices, instead of relying on a research expert, as they often did in the past.

in call-outs. If they want to do it themselves, we will raise as many red flags as possible, and try to paint as accurate a picture as we can of what awaits them.'

Holding The Reins

The benefits of such software to most stations seems obvious--lower costs and more control. Says RCS technical support for SongTrack and Selector Dean Cheriet, "Our software [and other packages] allows you to enter any questions you want your

Although these products have not been in Europe longer than a decade, they seem to have taken the market by storm. UK-based research company QuestionAir **UK-based** (which represents Australian-based BPR for the UK) director Rachel Steel says that in the UK market, some 50% of stations now use inhouse software. Paragon Research executive vice-president Chris **Porter** estimates that in his market in the US, for every station which turns to a research company for callout testing, there are five stations which do it themselves in house.

Paragon Research, therefore, does not offer call-out research services, focusing its efforts on auditorium research and consulting. However, Porter is often asked for consulting on call-outs. "For callouts, we recommend both in-house software and help from a research company, depending on the station in question. If we know that a station has no interest in taking it on themselves, we will refer them to a research company which specializes

Paragon Research interviewers to ask, from the popularity of a particular song to the time slot of a programme. You can perform all the operations you like, and as often as you like." The other bonus is the number of times a station can create a printout of results. Most of Cheriet's clients count on monthly reports with their research software, although when quick responses are required on particular questions, these results are sometimes printed

Chris Porter,

QuestionAir's Steel agrees with this. "Having your own research department in house means that you are constantly on top of your market. For a fraction of the price, a station could be doing call-out testing themselves in-house all year round, tracking the market on an eight-week basis. They are able to see how their market is moving, continuously monitoring it. Software allows you to start investigating yourself."

For stations which have chosen RCS' SongTrack, its compatibility to Selector, one of the most widely

used music schedulers in Europe, is also a bonus. SongTrack allows you to export songs from Selector, and also allows the music director to import research results on a particular song back into Selector. This capability could come in handy when deciding to schedule a particular song in a playlist.

The Human Touch

Carrying out this part of the research process in-house has a number of dangers, according to The Research Group Europe president Jim Woodyard, the most important being the lack of attention spent on the entire research process. "You have to look at music testing in a broad manner," he says. "A research company doesn't sell just testing; the software you are talking about is only one step of the process it takes to become part of a station. If I'm going to do testing, the software is important to keep the results in

some kind of organised fashion, but that's just a small part of the overall picture.'

US-based Strategic Radio Research managing director Kurt Hanson agrees, saying, "The software in question is no more than step 10-C of the 14 steps of research-Īt does not address the other facets of research at all. It's like a company selling snare drums which tells its clients,

'Now you can do your own jingles!' Sure, the drum is important, but only a small part of the entire pro-

"That leaves an entire list of tasks this software cannot fulfil," he continues. "Coming up with the right questions and telephone numbers, making sure the station is researching the right issues, selecting the right song hooks, analysing and interpreting results and selecting the right interviewers."

Staff Hassles

This last point is something most researchers agree is a very important decision, and something that stations will always have difficulty with when doing call-out testing from their office. Says Paragon's Porter, "In-house call-out teams are harder to keep staffed permanently. It's a typical job that people do part time, often students who don't care all that much about the station, and don't have its best interests at heart.

"Above all, a station's in-house department is never going to approximate the quality a specialist offers. If you hire a professional who does research full time, the results are going to be good."

Hanson adds, "Hiring interviewers in-house tends to be unreliable. What you have is unsupervised kids, calling friends to complete interviews, or if they're in a silly mood, making up interviews themselves. The result is that you end up Monday morning with a handful of tests and you're not sure they're truthful."

Human Frailty

As the biggest pitfall for in-house software seems to be the lack of human research expertise, is it possible to combine the two worlds, having your own in-house call-out team and making use of the expertise of an outside research company? That all depends on which expert you ask.



Strategic Research's Hanson does not believe such a set-up would benefit either party involved. "Bringing call-outs in-house is almost like starting up your own research company," he says, "which doesn't make any more sense than starting up your own jingles company. Doing so is a mis-allocation of management time and effort, which means you are spending less time on other important areas of your radio station.

In House Works

RCS' Cheriet agrees that the two don't mesh easily, but believes radio management is capable of doing testing without the help of a research company. "If you are familiar with the software you have purchased, then you won't need any outside help, besides initial support to complete your research work," he says. "As long as the callers understand what they are asking and why, that's all they need to know. It's also difficult to misinterpret these results. SongTrack simply supplies you with numbers. There's only one way of reading them. Consulting for these readings doesn't make sense. If you are confident, you won't need their advice.'

Joining Forces

QuestionAir's Steel, however, sees the two forces coming together to combine the advantages of in-house software with the advantages of an outside professional. "Stations just have to make sure they get a professional involved with their inhouse research," she says. "Companies like my own offer detailed training and instruct stations on quotas and waiting periods. In short, we supply them with everything they need to know. Where the professional comes in the process is during the interpretation of the results. Without this advice, a station takes the risk of seeing what they want to see in the responses."

The majority of Steel's clients work with her company not only for her help in performing call-outs, but also for other research needs, such as auditorium testing, programme formats, license application research, and analysis of RAJAR ratings. "Some stations who have the software, but don't ask for an outsider's opinion, lack an objective view. You can see it as a backstop. Most stations work with us for the whole mix, right through to inhouse research.

Some management subjects include advice on organising and planning your time hosted by David Gifford; how to use information elements to keep listeners tuned in by Metro Networks David Saperstein and developing customer loyalty by building their brand, presented by RAB's George Hyde.

Programming seminars rate high among radio operators questioned, and some of the speakers featured are Strategic

Media Research managing director Kurt Hanson (whose columns are regularly featured in Music & Media); The Research Group president Dennis

Clark and The Radio Consultants' David Martin.

David Gifford will present advice on managing, coaching and counseling sales people; Vincent Turco (also a contributor to M&M's "Making Waves" columns) will discuss how radio can compete with TV and print media for advertising budgets and George Hyde will delve into the problem of maximising sales potential.





The Red Hot series of AIDS benefit albums began in 1990 with Red Hot & Blue, a spirited reinterpretation of Cole Porter's songs for the 90's. The next seven albums targeted specific genres: Red Hot + Dance, No Alternative, Red Hot + Country, Stolen Moments: Red Hot + Cool, Red Hot + Bothered, Offbeat and America is Dying slowly. With these albums, the Red Hot Organization continued to raise and give away millions of dollars to fight AIDS.

Red Hot + Rio returns to the original idea of a cross-genre concept album, this time paying tribute to the music of Antonio Carlos Jobim and the rich tradition of Brazilian pop music from the 60's and 70's.

Red Hot + Rio is designed as an informal tribute to the peruasive beauty and influence of Brazilian pop music from Bossa Nova through Propicalisimo.

We began by asking Jobim's blessing and he graciously agreed to allow us to proceed, and donated his songs to the project just prior to his untimely passing in 1994. We then approached a wide range of artists around the world to confirm our instinct that Brazilian music continued to hold sway and be relevant. The response was tremendous. Red Hot + Rio became a true collaboration in which the artists chose songs and styles, then remade them in such a varied and powerful way as to prove our point more effectively than these words ever can.

In addition to paying tribute to a great musical tradition. Red Hot + Rio is the first in a series of Red Hot projects designed to deal specifically with the impact of AIDS outside the US and Europe. Brazil currently has the most significant rate of HIV infection in Latin America and is consistently ranked as having one of the five highest number of AIDS cases in the world.

AIDS is not a problem of certain countries or type of people. It is a global human tragedy of epic proportions; perhaps the worst world health crisis ever known. So much needs to be done that one pop album may seem trivial and poorly suited to the task. But music brings people together. And the everlasting beauty of Brazilian pop is that it celebrates love with a knowing sense of its complications. The lesson we hope to share in this samba school is that although the language of love now includes latex, it will never end...

Breakin' & Entering

A weekly Eurochart analysis by Bob Macdonald

The commercial juggernaut that is the **Spice Girls** continues to dominate the Eurochart Hot 100 Singles. This week they achieve the unique feat of replacing themselves at number 1, as the two-million selling *Wannabe* (Virgin) slips one notch to make way for the group's second single, *Say You'll Be There*. Strangely, the Girls manage to lock up the two positions without being number 1 in any individual country this week (see Top National Sellers, page 22). Their strength lies in their pan-European appeal—*Say You'll Be There* has already been a chart-topper in the UK and Finland, and this week climbs to number 2 in Denmark, Norway and Ireland; in addition, Belgium and Switzerland have both singles in their national top 10.

The Sales Breaker award goes to **Robson & Jerome**, whose third single What Becomes Of The Broken Hearted (RCA) charges from number 46 to number 14 in only its second week on the chart. Though also charting in Ireland, the jump is mainly fuelled by the single's instant success in the duo's native UK, where the Jimmy Ruffin remake climbs from 11 to number 1. RCA has caused a stir in the British music industry with its strict no-discount policy on the R&J single, which has led most retailers to sell it at ú3.99 from day one, twice the price of most new releases. The move, which is being closely watched by other companies, does not appear to have harmed the singing actors' commercial clout. A wider international push for the duo's recording career is planned for the new year.

Making headlines on the European Top 100 Albums chart are the perennially united members of the **Kelly Family**, whose latest album *Almost Heaven* (Kel-Life) is the highest new entry of the year so far. The number 4 debut eclipses the first-week positions of two veteran superstars—Tina Turner entered at number 7 in April with *Wildest Dreams* (Parlophone) and Phil Collins debuted at 7 two weeks ago with *Dance Into The Light* (WEA), now in its second week at number 1.

Just behind the Kellys at number 5, **The Beatles** earn the Sales Breaker award with *Anthology 3* (Apple). Though already charting in nine countries, the third and final album in the *Anthology* series is not in the official Greek top 20 album chart, which makes its first appearance on the Top National Sellers page this week. Greece is nevertheless caught up in Beatlemania, with *The Red Album* at number 12, *The Blue Album* at 14 and *Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band* at 20. Three further albums from the Fab Four catalogue are listed lower down the country's top 50.

The second highest new entry on the European Top 100 Albums list belongs to the unstoppable Celine Dion, whose Live A Paris (Epic/Columbia) bows at number 12. That gives the French-Canadian superstar no less than four entries on the current chart—Falling Into You holds at number 3 in its 35th week, D'Eux slips to 58 and The Colour Of My Love re-enters at 97. With a quadruple whammy like that, Dion is well on course to be crowned Europe's best-selling album artist of 1996.

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



EMAP Acquires The Box

LONDON - UK media group EMAP's acquisition of cable music video channel The Box has set the stage for competition with MTV Europe and other European TV music services. The Box is an interactive music channel which plays chart, dance, R&B and rock music videos selected by its cable audiences from a specified playlist.

Sources say EMAP, which publishes youth-targeted consumer magazines such as Smash Hits and Q, and owns 17 radio stations across the country, plans to launch the interactive service Europe-

wide on satellite. Currently The Box is available to 90% of the UK's 1.5 million cable subscribers. It has a weekly reach of more than 20% of its core audience.

A Source close to the deal comments, "Expansion to the rest of Europe is an obvious thing to think about. Europe is a big market. So, satellite and digital broadcasting there are things that have to be looked at closely.'

chief executive Robin Miller also hints that the company's intentions for The Box extend beyond British shores, saying, "We anticipate developing the revenue of The Box in what is already a rapidly growing non-terrestrial television market."

EMAP acquired the channel from its US owners, Video Jukebox Network Inc. and Ticketmaster on October 31, for a cash consideration of US\$12.5 million. EMAP's broadcasting arm, EMAP Radio, will be mainly responsible for the operation of The Box, which will, it claims, be profitable in 1997 on an anticipated turnover of more than US\$3.2 million.

The Box was launched in the UK in 1992 by managing director Vincent Monsey and director of programmes Liz Laskowski. Both executives will remain with The Box.

Assuming the Classic FM acquisition is completed, GWR will operate in three divisions: UK national radio comprising Classic FM; UK local radio, comprising the group's local commercial stations; and overseas operations, with responsibility for holdings including Prospect Radio in New Zealand and the 60%-owned Radio Edelweiss in Austria and Italy.

Bernard takes direct responsibility for the UK national and overseas divisions. Taylor will head the local division, split into three geographical regions, each with its own regional managing director.

Every local radio station in the UK will have a managing director (formerly station director), reporting to the appropriate regional managing director.

According to sources at GWR, the station managing directors "will be responsible for the station's programming output and for advertising sales". They will also be accountable for their individual station's profitability. According to GWR chief executive Ralph Bernard, the new management structure "provides the means for the group management to focus on growing the overall business." He adds, "It also enables our local management teams to run their businesses in an autonomous way so that they can be responsive to the needs of their listeners and of their advertising clients."

version of the event on Saturday, November 16, through the ITV network. Together with further TV deals in nine European and four Latin American territories as well as Singapore, the MTV Europe Music Awards will be Europe's largest ever pop music event in terms of audience figures.

MTV is fast developing into a key player in the international TV programme market. Flamboyant flagship programmes like the EMA are likely to cement MTV's advantage in an industry where commercial TV faces declining budgets and stiff competition. "Music TV is in danger of

being pushed into a low budget corner," observes MTV Europe president and creative director Brent Hansen in a recent interview. "The viewers, on the other hand, still want to be entertained with exceptional programmes on a grand scale.

The EMA commands a comparatively large production budget," admits Hansen, "but it has become a trademark programme and part of that is down to the fact that we don't settle for cheaper solutions." The international interest by programme buyers in the EMA shows that spending money on music programming pays off in the long run. It can even bring pop music back onto prime-time family

He adds, "Many artists [in Europe] are forced to record their songs in English because there is no vehicle for their own material outside their own country. EuroZone will provide that vehicle and will hope to set trends in European listening patterns, providing a chance for members of the community to enjoy each other's culture through music."

The output of Eurozone stations will be around 80% music and 20% speech. The speech content will mainly be in English, although local stations will provide news and information bulletins at appropriate programme junctions in their local language. European news will be broadcast at the top of the hour, and there will be a daily news magazine, Today." Various sh "Europe Various short speech features throughout the day will include pan-European press

reviews, European travel and event highlights, economic news and spotlights on individual national charts.

One or two big-name UK and French presenters are already lined up to sign for the station, which will employ DJs from a variety of countries to present shows in English. Donovan says, in general, EuroZone will be looking for "good all-round communicators" rather than household radio names in local markets. EuroZone says it also plans to regularly swap their presenters' studios, so that a German presenter may broadcast from Spain, or a French DJ from Italy.

EuroZone is one of a number of organisations to recently declare it will be starting a pan-European radio service. Plans announced earlier this year (Music & Media, May 4) by Fin-S for a satellite-only service and by Delta 171 for a longwave station have yet to bear fruit.

So far, MPG Group owned ZTV has refused to reveal the figures behind the decision, but Inggaard admits that there was no way the company could be restructured to exist on its income.

When the Danish channel was launched in March last year, the idea was to copy the success of the Swedish original ZTV and do the same in Norway, thus forming a Scandinavian network with the accompanying economies of scale. But despite Denmark's ZTV gaining the same ratings as the Swedish equivalent with its mix of music video, youth programming and comedies, the advertising didn't arrive.

The loss of the channel will be a blow for the Danish recording industry, as it gave valuable exposure to homebased acts. Some 32 staffers will lose their jobs, although Inggaard hopes all will find other jobs within MPG, and freelancers and suppliers will be hit hard. "We were just a couple of years too early," Inggaard laments.

Spice Girls

Spice Girls don't settle for less—number 1 that is. Only five weeks after the two-week EHR chart reign of the vocal quintet's debut single Wannabe terminated, the follow-up effort Say You'll Be There has also managed to grab the

most wanted chart position on European Hit Radio. This coincides with the attainment of the Eurochart number 1 position, taking over from Wannabe.

The triumphant move of the new Spice Girls single, which has pushed Donna Lewis I Love You Always Forever into second position after a three-week stay at the top, is due to 17 adds on EHR. Particularly in Poland, Belgium, Portugal and Turkey, Say You'll Be There has attracted significant new airplay this week. The single's roster has increased to 81 stations in 23 countries. Holland and Denmark currently provide the broadest support, producing national penetration ratios of 80-83%. Looking at things from a regional perspective, it is interesting that the new Spice Girls single now tops the Scandinavian and Benelux lists, while the previous one still dominates the Hungarian list (see Major Market Airplay, page 31).

The highest new entry in the EHR Top 40 goes to British singer Baby Bird. You're Gorgeous, the lead single from the album Ugly Beautiful (reviewed in our November 2 issue), debuts at number 23. It marks the first EHR entry for the Echo label, following MCA's licensing deal with the Chrysalis Music Group-owned imprint last year. Before Baby Bird's Echo deal, the singer released four lo-fi albums in a nine-month time span.

You're Gorgeous is reported in rotation by 31 programmers in 13 countries. The artist's native UK leads the list with a 59% acceptance level, while Denmark and Portugal follow closely with 50-53%. Other territories where the song fares well on the airwaves include Belgium, Finland, Ireland and Norway. On a regional level, the Stephen Jones and Steve Power-produced track does best in-again-the UK, where it is positioned at number 2, followed by Scandinavia (number 19).

R.E.M. has the hottest track on EHR on their hands this week, as Bittersweet Me leaps up 12 places in Radio Active form. Boosted by 10 adds, the track—the follow-up to E-Bow The Letter and the second single to be taken from the band's Eurocharting album New Adventures In Hi-Fi—has built up a 42-station roster, encompassing 15 countries. As yet, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Germany, Spain and the UK are most supportive (35-60% penetration in those countries).

Bittersweet Me is the 15th EHR hit for the US band since the launch of the chart in December 1990. Of all previous hits, seven made it to the top 10, which makes up a formidable 50% proportion. Those toppers were 1992's Drive (peak: number 2), 1991's Shiny Happy People (7), 1994's What's The Frequency Kenneth (7), this year's E-Bow The Letter (7), 1991's Losing My Religion (8), 1994's Bang And Blame (9) and 1992's Man On The Moon (10).

On The Road

Border Breakers commentary by Raúl Cairo

Five weeks after it entered the Border Breakers chart, the third single taken from Robert Miles' debut album Dreamland, One And One, surges to the number one position. It does so thanks to massive support across most of Europe. What is remarkable however, is the quick response by leading British programmers, who added the track soon after its UK release. Prestigious EHR outlets such BBC Radio 1/London and the Metro Radio Group based in Newcastle apparently harboured no reservations about the song, and are just a few of the early supporters. It is Miles' second number one in the chart, the first being Children, which topped the chart for two non-consecutive weeks early this year. Also noteworthy is the fact that this instrumental dancetrack dethrones a somewhat similar effort, B.B.E.'s Seven Days And One Week, which also enjoyed a more or less comparable airplay spread.



Scatman John

The highest entry this week is Scatman John's Everybody Jam, which enters straight into the top ten at position seven. In total, the song earned a massive 21 adds, a feat, which also thrusted it into the Chartbound section of this weeks' EHR Chart (see page 29, for review see Music & Media, November 9 1996 page 11). The song benefits a great deal from a most enthusiastic response in most of continental Europe. The reaction is especially strong in Germany, Poland and Italy, where he has been highly successful in the past. The song has the Scatman stamp all over it, but what sets it apart from its predecessors is the more prominent presence of traditional jazz

The second highest entry is Scooter's I'm Raving, which is actually a happy hardcore cover of Marc Cohn's Walking In Memphis. Perhaps not entirely surprisingly, the song is performing exceptionally well in the Benelux and Italy, where most major national networks added the track early on. The song is the first single taken from the Wicked album.

The charts on this page track the border-crossing movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their country of signing (airplay achieved in the original country is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful Non-European artists according to airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Country Of Signing" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M aims to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.
