Cost savings drive Sony/Warner Network

LONDON - The U.K. affiliates of Warner Music and Sony Music are joining forces to create a major new distribution company.

The Entertainment Network, to be equally owned by Sony and Warner, will start operations in Spring 1999. It

follows precedents set in Australia and Japan and comparable-but more modest-arrangements which exist in some other European markets.

Both companies stress that they will continue to compete in all other fields, and downplay suggestions that the new alliance could be extended elsewhere in Europe. "This is strictly a U.K. initiative and there is no discussion of anything wider," says a Warner Music International spokesperson. However, other sources say Sony is aggresively examining further "efficiency options" in the region.

The move is seen as evidence of ongoing pressure to contain costs and improve efficiency in the slow-growth U.K. music market. One senior distribu-

The biggest tournament yet in soccer's premier competition gets under way in Paris on June 10. This week, Sony Music Entertainment Europe confirmed the track listing of the offi- FRANCE 98 cial World Cup album Allez! Ola! Olé!, which

will feature no less than eight pan-European and seven local singles.

Officially endorsed by FIFA and

created in consultation with the 1998 World Cup organising committee CFO, the album will be issued in France first, on April 21. Allez! Ola! Olé! will then be released across conti-

nental Europe between April 28 and May 5. It is the only album to feature both the official anthem of the 1998 World Cup, Youssou N'Dour and Axelle Red's La Cour Des Grands/Do You Mind If I Play?, as well as the tournament's official song,

Ricky Martin's La Copa De La Vida/The Cup Of Life.


PRAGUE - Record companies in the Czech Republic are facing the prospect of having to pay substantially more for their radio advertising campaigns.

From April 1, leading Czech radio sales house Media Marketing Services (MMS) is insisting on behalf of its client stations that record companies pay full standard prices for their radio ad spots, and in particular special themed campaigns which promote particular artists on stations across a weekend.

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Uptront

There's no question that the U.K. has one of the most dynamic music scenes in the world. It is also probably one of the most insular, both in terms of its relationship with the rest of the world, and its style of operating. But there are more and more signs that the times are a-changin'.

Consider parallel imports. For years, thanks to the low value of the pound, U.K. exporters (and sometimes the major record companies) flooded the continent with cheap merchandise, affecting the sales of international repertoire released in individual countries.

That cross-border traffic didn't appear to bother U.K. business until recently, after the pound gained strength and the traffic suddenly started to flow the other way. British labels are now discovering the joys of Europe's free movement of goods. And complaining about it, of course. Give the U.K industry a few more months and it'll be begging Tony Blair to join the Euro single currency system!

Other aspects of the U.K. industry are changing, tooretail, for example. With supermarket chains like Asda and Tesco entering music retailing, it seems those who thought the U.K. industry would be immune to the "hypermarket effect" as seen in continental Europe were misguided.

Lobbying the Government is also a novelty. It was only last year, with the arrival of the Labour government, that the U.K. industry finally found the road to No.10 Downing Street. Countries such as Sweden, Denmark and the Netherlands have had government-backed music industry support schemes for years. Ten years ago in France, socialist culture minister Jack Lang even had an adviser for contemporary music, quickly dubbed by the press as "the minister of rock."

In each individual territory, U.K. acts now have to compete head-to-head with local acts, in the same way

that non-British acts have had to compete in the U.K. with local acts. For the first time in years, the British market is also starting to lend an ear to "alien" music. Acts such as Ricky Martin, Wes, Sash!, Air, BBE and Daft Punk have all enjoyed chart success in the U.K. during the past months.

Things are definitely starting to change in the United Kingdom.



SBS taking Radio 105 to

MILAN — Swedish media group SBS is taking Radio 105 to Milan's Tribunal Court to resolve deadlock over SBS's investments in the Italian CHR network.

Last July, SBS and Radio 105's holding company Finelco reached a provisional agreement for SBS to acquire a 25-30 percent stake in Radio 105 for an estimated \$3-4 million. However, a subsequent dispute over contractual arrangements lead to SBS requesting a larger controlling stake in Radio 105, or for its investment to be returned by Finelco (M&M, March 7).

Reliable sources confirm that SBS has invoked the court action to establish its claim to a majority shareholding in Radio 105, or secure a return of monies invested so far.

A visit by Peter Benson, managing director of SBS's radio division, to Milan on 26/27 February to try and resolve the impasse with Finelco president Alberto Hazan was unsuccessful.

Hazan was unavailable for comment at the time of going to press, although a recent improvement in its financial position on the back of record advertising revenue growth during the past year is seen as having

strengthened his financial position.

Meanwhile, in a separate development, SBS-which owns 11 radio stations in Scandinavia plus seven TV networks across Europe-has found new investors to replace the Disneyowned ABC/Capital Cities, which last month announced it was selling its 19 percent stake in the broadcaster as part of a strategy to concentrate on its core U.S. interests.

Reports Benson: "Disney's 19 percent stake has been taken up by several financial institutions and investment banks. The sale was over-subscribed, so the shares sold at a premium rate.

rash and Surf: new alternatives

LONDON - Listeners in two of the U.K.'s most musically active connurbations are now able to enjoy the alternative sounds of Crash and Surf.

107 Crash FM/Liverpool and Surf 107/Brighton, which both launched on March 27, are the latest stations to follow Xfm/London in bringing more alternative music programming to the U.K. radio landscape.

Crash's launch, however, was somewhat clouded by the sudden departure of Mike Gray, the station's managing director and programmer, only a few hours after he was sipping champagne to celebrate the station's launch.

"There were irreconcilable differences between the board and Mike Gray that could not be sorted out," says a Crash FM source. A replacement is expected to be announced shortly.

Crash's programming is a mix of alternative rock and dance; specialist dance output includes Boy George's syndicated dance and club mix show.

Crash FM founder and breakfast presenter Janice Long says: "We were told [by researchers] that we needed a

format that fitted a particular label or pigeon hole. But we simply went to the clubs and listened to what people were dancing to or enjoying."

In Brighton, Surf 107 has designed its output to reflect the town's increasingly high-profile dance and indie scenes. The station's daytime programming is CHR-leaning with a strong bias towards dance and alternative rock, while the evenings and weekends major on the different dance genres, including house, garage, techno, hip hop, disco, soul and swing. There are also specialist programmes featuring alternative rock, jazz and world music.

Specialist DJs appearing on the station-which is being programmed by former Southern FM/Brighton presenter Marcus Patrick-include Norman Cook, Russ Dewbury and Midfield General. Former 96.4 The Eagle/Guildford presenter Leona Graham is hosting Surf's weekday breakfast show.

Music Virgin Italy managing director Clary has just been appointed as head of EMI Music Italy, while retaining his previous position at Virgin.



Q: Your appointment at EMI Music Italy is clearly a result of your success at Virgin Music Italy-but what do you put that down to?

A: I put it down to making a big commitment to each job taken on, using good sense, having a love for the repertoire and a lot of good luck. The good sense means hiring strong financial and marketing talent in addition to creative A&R and promotion teams.

The key financial and marketing players at Virgin are [financial director] Roger Mitchell and marketing managers Marco Cestoni and Marco Alboni, who will jointly take over the day to day running of Virgin Music Italy. Image is also very important-I have never been shy about hyping our values of innovation, modernity and being open to new music.

Q: What changes do you intend making at EMI Music Italy?

A: The first thing to point out is that Virgin and EMI will remain separate and Virgin will continue to pursue its own growth plan. I want EMI Music Italy to be associated with "music and innovation" as a kind of company motto. EMI is an historic company with considerable weight, and I want to bring renewed energy to better exploit its principle assets of repertoire and catalogue.

EMI's other main asset is the staff, who [I understand] could become uncertain about major changes. At Virgin, we respect people and allow space for professional growth and natural maturation, therefore any changes will be gradual. We also have a commitment to respect the great tradition of EMI and at the same time remain open to new people with new ideas.

Q: What would you say are the best and worst aspects of the Italian music industry?

A: The good and bad points are connected. The bad has been the static nature of A&R in local repertoire, but it's like a volcano here in Italy at the moment. Behind the apparent stasis, an enormous amount of magma is building up and it's ready to explode. A big new wave of artists with innovative music are breaking throughit's exciting new product which will eventually sell more music here.

Danes tread water despite Aqua

COPENHAGEN - The stunning global success of Aqua failed to compensate for a relatively weak domestic performance by Danish artists in 1997.

International acts rather than home-grown talent were responsible for boosting the Danish music market by some 3 percent last year, according to official sales figures from labels' organisation IFPI Denmark.

Music sales in Denmark totalled Dkr1.03 billion (\$186 million) in 1997, compared with almost exactly Dkr1bn in 1996. But despite huge domestic sales for Aqua, Danish artists still accounted for around Dkr330m in 1997-the same as in 1996. Sales for international acts in 1997 totalled Dkr700m, up from Dkr670m in 1996.

Sales of CD albums increased by 5.7 percent to 16.8 million units, with

international acts accounting for the entire increase, according to IFPI. Album sales of Danish artists were flat at 5.6 million units-and would have been down by 5 percent were it for Aquarium. Aqua's not International acts sold 11.2 million albums last year, an 8.7 percent increase on 1996.

"There's definitely a problem in Denmark-[the record companies] can't boost sales of Danish music," says Bjorn Jacobsen, owner of independent retail chain GUF. "Lots of labels had problems with local repertoire and saw sales of Danish artists drop, except Universal with Aqua. Now everybody's trying to launch new Aguas.

Meanwhile, sales of classical music in Denmark almost touched the one million units mark in 1997, up from around 700,000 units the previous year.



Stellar results for SER's Universo

MADRID - Sales and membership of Spain's first mail-order music club, backed by radio giant SER, have "surpassed all expectations," in the six months since its launch in September 1997.

When the club, Universo Musical, was jointly launched last year by German media group Bertelsmann

and SER's management division Union Radio, the club's director general Pau Cubells said it was aiming for 40,000 members and sales of 300,000 CDs by

June 1998. In March, those figures were already 70,500 and 280,000 respectively, with income at Pta360 million (\$2.3m).

"We are very encouraged with the first half-year results, which have confirmed that our initial target group analysis was correct," says Cubells. "Far from competing with established [retail] outlets in major towns and cities, Universo Musical is aimed at potential music buyers living in mainly rural areas

who find access to big stores with a wide choice of music difficult."

Cubells says 64 percent of the club's members are aged under 30, and 45 percent live in towns of fewer than 10,000 inhabitants. His long-term aim is to attract 300,000 members, "but for that, we shall have to find ways to gain members in medium sized cities of between 100,000-500,000, which currently represent just 6 percent of the membership.

Cubells says he expects this year's turnover to be around Pta540m. That would represent nearly 0.7 percent of Spain's total

music market, which in 1997 was worth some Pta89.6bn.

SER owns four of the top five music networks in Spain, including leading CHR network Los 40 Principales, and also owns Spain's overall radio market leader, the news/talk network Cadena SER. Although Bertelsmann runs 10 other mail-order operations across Europe, Spain is the first country in which it has established a music club with a local radio partner.

U.K. piracy levels drop

London — Last year saw music piracy levels in the U.K. drop for the third consecutive year, according to the British Phonographic Industry (BPI).

New BPI figures value the U.K. market for illegal recordings at £18.2m (\$30m) in 1997, down some 6 percent from 1996. Total units of all types of illegal recordings as defined by the BPI-bootleg, counterfeit and pirateare estimated at 2.27m units, down five percent on the previous year.

Just under 70 percent of illegal recordings sold in the U.K. were on CD, with the remainder on cassette, according to the BPI statistics. The organisation credits its Anti Piracy Unit with keeping the business to a "managable" level in the U.K., but notes that "globally, the problem remains acute.

The Beatles, Led Zeppelin, Bob Dylan and the Rolling Stones top the BPI's list of "most bootlegged" artists in the U.K., with over 1,000 illegal titles between them. The Beatles top the list, with 280 titles.



Bootlegs (illegally taped live concerts and studio out-takes) accounted for over 60 percent of illegal sales by value in the U.K. last year, at £11.6m-10 percent down on 1996. In a statement, the BPI suggests: "The recent harmonisation of European copyright laws will hopefully reduce the amount of product illegally imported into the U.K." The lion's share of that bootleg product comes from Italy (41 percent), according to the BPI, followed by Germany (11 pecent) and Taiwan (8 percent).

The U.K. top ten, as well as several genre charts, are updated weekly as text-only listings, plus there's music news and gossip on other pages. There are also competitions and downloadable freebies which are only available on-line. It seems curious that the site doesn't take more advantage of

the Internet's audio and visual capabilities, particularly in light of The Chart Show's visual style, but what it does, it does well.

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NLR seeks common ground ON THE BEAT

BERGEN - A taste of how radio actually works: that was this year's unscheduled addition to the menu for record company representatives at Norway's annual local radio association (NLR) convention.

Some 80 attendees from the radio and record industries met at the convention in Bergen on March 20-22. During the event, Egil Houeland, head of music at regional CHR station Radio 102 Nord Rogaland and one of the Norwegian radio industry's best known personalities, invited labels present to take part in an impromptu seminar.

Among the seminar's elements were a brief explanation of key radio formats, a debate on radio airplay for Norwegian music, and discussion on how radio stations select their music.

Addressing the seminar, Houeland declared: "Record companies have become better at not trying to run radio stations. It's not my job to run a record company and it's not theirs to run a radio station."

Houeland also observed that, because of the high turnover of promotion people in the Norwegian record industry, there is a need for radio to let record company staffers know how station formats work, and to let promotion executives know how music directors make programming decisions.

"There are new radio promotion heads [at several companies] and there isn't much information being passed on from the old to the new promotions executives," noted the programmer. Houeland urged record companies to keep their own staff informed about how

radio stations work, so that labels "won't have to waste so much time trying to get airplay on records that don't fit our format. It's important to respect music as editorial content.

PolyGram head of radio promotion/international repertoire Giermund Moastuen describes Houeland's initiative as a positive one, but adds: "Too much [of the seminar] was focused around Radio 102's situation. It would have been even more interesting to learn more about other formats as well.'

Another delegate at the convention, Scandinavian Records' head of promotion Kurt Gaasø, observes: "Usually our communication [with radio] revolves around pushing our priority acts. Some record companies are good at calling around, but usually there isn't enough time, which is a pity.'

U.K. CD PENETRATION RISES TO 75%

LONDON — A new research survey published by U.K. labels' organisation the BPI shows that, for the first time, more British households (75 percent) have a CD player than a record player (71 percent). Just five years ago, only 35 percent of households owned a CD player. CD penetration is highest in the 15-24 year old demographic (91 percent), and lowest in the 65-plus age group (37 percent). Cassette hardware remains the most widespread overall, being present in 92 percent of all U.K. households.

FOUQUERAY IS FUN CHOICE

PARIS - Fun Radio president Axel Duroux has named Jérôme Fouqueray as the CHR network's new managing director. He replaces Jean Isnard, who left the station fol-

lowing the arrival of Duroux as president last November. Fouqueray, 26, was previously head of marketing and development at Contact TV, and since 1997 has been responsible for satellite TV channels at sales house France Espace.

ROYALTIES SPLIT 'GABBERTJE' ACT

HILVERSUM — Geert Timmer, Bart Vleming and Ewart van der Horst of Dutch dance act Hakkuhbar have filed a suit against a fourth member of the band, Ad de Feijter, in a royalties dispute. The law suit, lodged with Amsterdam's Economic Tribunal, claims that each of the band members was

entitled to an equal share of the royalties from Gabbertje, a single released in the summer of 1996 on indie label Roadrunner. The record was one of the first big hits for the home-grown superfast "gabber" techno genre, selling 120,000 copies and reaching No.1 in the official Dutch Mega Top 100 singles chart in January 1997. Roadrunner says de Feijter's signature is the only one on its contract with the act.

PARIS - More than 30 of the world's top club DJs are set to perform at the first ever techno event organised by French terrestrial TV channel M6.

After a dozen live "Dance Machine" events dedicated to mainstream dance music and boy bands, M6 (in association with CHR radio network Fun Radio) is hoping to attract some 17,000 ravers to "Metropole Techno," which will take place at Paris' Bercy venue on April 11.

The DJs invited include Moby (U.S.), Sven Väth (Germany), Carl Cox (U.K.), Westbam (Germany) and Manu Le Malin (France). They will perform on three different dance

floors ("Universal," "Experimental" and "House") between 22.00 and 08.00 the following morning.

"It's the first time a major





media company has got involved in techno music," says M6 entertainment deputy manager Eric Karnbauer. "Metrotechno event Paris has been waiting for."

"I have done a great job here in Paris but I don't believe in the future of Le Mouv' in Toulouse," he declares. "I am sure the station will move back to Paris in a couple of years time."

EDI, Otto swap shareholdings

BERLIN — French broadcaster Europe Developpment international (EDI) and Hamburg-based media company Frank Otto Medien (FOM) are planning to swap the shares which they hold in AC broadcasters in Hamburg and Saarland respectively.

If the state radio regulators in Hamburg and Saarland approve the deal, FOM will exchange the shares it owns in Saarland FM network Radio Salü with EDI for the latter's shares in soft AC station Magic FM 95.0/Hamburg.

EDI and FOM are partners in

several radio ventures, including Berlin dance station Kiss

FM (in which they each hold a 25 percent share), and rock-formatted Delta Radio in Kiel. Although a decision from the regulators is not expected for some weeks, the share exchange should be approved, according to a source at the Saarland radio regulator LAR.

If the deal is allowed to go through, FOM will once again become the sole owner of Magic



Danish 'tackno' brings home the bacon

elcome to the land of "tackno." Two years ago, who would have dared predict that a Danish strain of lightweight techno-mixed with a large dose of good-humoured kitsch-would become a worldwide, multi-million unit shifting chart phenomenon?

Artists such as Aqua, Los Umbrellos and Hit'n'Hide seemed to appear out of nowhere, taking even local industry insiders by surprise. Universal Music Denmark A&R manager Nicholas Anker readily admits that he had not even considered Aqua's Barbie Girl as a single until Copenhagen-based CHR station The Voice was inundated with requests for the track.

"The Voice had an exclusive on the LP for one week," recalls Anker. "Barbie Girl was only one track on the album but the response, 24 hours after the station started playing the song, was remarkable."



Aqua's fame spread to the U.S. after The Voice programme director Eik Frederiksen sent copies over to stations on his own initiative (M&M, August 23, 1997). "That was the spark which set Aqua off internationally." says Anker. To date, the band's global record sales total 9.5 million albums and 7 million singles.

Pro-active radio

Radio's role in the making of Aqua was no lucky accident.


Danish radio takes a pro-active role when it comes to new talent. "A CHR



station should be making acts as well as playing hit songs," comments Eik Frederiksen. The Voice invites local artists on a regular basis as presenters, hosts unplugged on-air sessions and covers in-store events.

Frederiksen suggests that this approach has led to a symbiotic relationship between the burgeoning Danish music scene and one of the country's largest CHR stations. "We get exclusives and the groups get prime radio exposure. It's a way of creating a balance in the normally unequal relationship between record companies and the media.'

But why do Danish acts sound different to anybody else? The roots of the current "tackno" wave can be traced back to



the success of Danish girl duo Me & My three years ago. Their 1995 debut single, Dub-I-Dub (EMI-Medley), set the blueprint for tackno with shamelessly tacky. fun-filled lyrics, a tune which sticks like superglue and a winningly daft video. Me & My sold 1.5 million copies of their self-titled debut album and the single helped shift 6 million copies of compilation albums featuring Dub-I-Dub.

Sony Music Denmark local A&R manager Poul Martin Bonde has a theory as to why Danish acts are hot. "It's the melodies," says Bonde. "We have a strong tradition of folk nursery rhymes with catchy tunes. Updated versions by local stars like Gnags and Kim Larsen sell very well in the Danish market."

EMI-Medley MD Michael Ritto points out that Scandinavian pop artists from Abba onwards have had a knack for highly melodic arrangements.

"What we do well [in Denmark] are classic sing-alongs,' says Ritto. "You can see the same element in [Danish rock group] Michael

Learns To Rock [EMI-Medley] or Scatman John [Iceberg]."

Zind

Another advantage for new Danish artists is that the local music industry is comparatively small and can dedicate large amounts of attention to individual acts. "Our philosophy is to have a small roster that we really care about," says Universal's Nicholas Anker. "[We are scheduling] a maximum of four albums per year. That way, you're only working one domestic artist in any one period which allows the team to focus on long term planning.'

Border breaking

Below the international level at which Aqua now operate, a wealth of artists are ready to break out of their home market.

At EMI-Medley, hopes are high that Zindy will be the next big thing. The former singer of R&B flavoured dance act Cut'n'Move-early precursors of the current Danish dance music scene—had a recent solo domestic hit with Round'n'Round (EMI/Medley). "Now that we've established her at home, we can talk seriously to EMI affiliates abroad," says Ritto.

Zindy's next single, Don't Wanna Say Goodbye, already on the starting blocks. Meanwhile, Infernal's Sorti De L'Enfer on EMI-Medlev dance imprint Flex has made it to U.K. clubs and is shaping up to be a major tune at Balearic holiday resorts this summer.

A few months before the Danish pop/dance craze manifested itself across Europe, Flex released a Los Umbrellos

track called No Tengo Dinero. More a club record than a straightforward pop tune, the single nevertheless shifted 300,000 units in the U.S. and another 200,000 in Australasia. Los Umbrellos' debut album, Flamenco Funk, was released by Virgin in North America on



February 2 and shipped 100,000 units. Originally issued last summer, No Tengo Dinero is now being re-serviced to European radio on the strength of its overseas success.

Also already garnering headlines are Sony Music Denmark act Daze, whose debut album Heroes clocked up sales of 200,000 units across Scandinavia. Now, a renamed version of the hit Tamagotchi, under the title Together Forever (The Cyber Pet Song) is, according to Bonde, "likely to get a worldwide release."

Maverick's Hero

Amongst the pioneers of the tackno genre, Scandinavian Records deserves special credit.

"We've built a solid base and now we're starting to see the results," says Scandinavian Records A&R

manager Lau Wulfsberg. Madonna's Maverick label is Scandinavia Records' latest international licensing partner, having picked up Hero by Miss Papaya for the world except Japan and Scandinavia.

The label's hottest hit contender right now is the Hit'n'Hide track Space Invaders. The duo have already enjoyed a Scandinavian hit with Partyman, but the Johnny Jam & Delgado produced follow-up seems destined for

bigger things. Wulfsberg points out that the buzz around Space Invaders came from the clubs. "Danish clubs are generally very commercial. In the early days our main support came from there, then about 18 months ago it crossed over to radio."

Universal Music also has big plans

for Danish singer Christina. After initial success with the single You Know Who, self-titled her debut album on Universal sold 50,000 units in Asia. Following an image make-



over, a U.S. version of the album is currently being put together, containing five new tracks.

There is another, more progressive side to Danish dance music, which finds it harder to get airplay and chart success. Typical of Denmark's dance underground is independent label April Records.

Amongst their highly eclectic output, April have some true gems including breakbeat artist Cai Bojsen-Møller and jungle act Future 3, whose debut album, We Are The Future 3, garnered plaudits from top DJs and specialised press around the globe. Their second, eagerly awaited long player, Stay With, is just out.

"Commercial radio doesn't play our material," says April promotion manager Torsten Kjaer, "but [public CHR station] P3 now has a three hour [progressive dance] show called U-Land, six evenings a week. It helps to push sales slightly.

With what looks like being a rush of quality releases from Danish labels, it's possible that the acts to emerge so far only represent the tip of the iceberg. Denmark's underground of today could well emerge as Europe's next generation of hitmakers.

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Boyzone: growing up in public

Times change. The name Boyzone always seemed a perfect one for the young Irish band who became teen market leaders in the wake of Take That's demise. Hordes of adoring young female flocked to their live shows, and with their first and second albums, Boyzone were clearly happy to be regarded as a teen band.

Now, with worldwide album sales approaching four million units, the band are currently Ireland's leading pop export. The U.K. is their strongest market, but they're also doing well in Asia and Latin America. Now, with their third album Where We Belong (Polydor) due out on May 25, the quintet is aiming at an older, more mature audience and Polydor is looking at taking Boyzone to the next stage, with global success the ultimate destination.

To date, it has been the group's cover versions which have won them their largest audience outside the teenage fanbase. The success of their version of Cat Stevens' *Father And Son* was a watershed in Boyzone's evolution from teen band into strong contenders for AC radio. Subsequent covers of the BeeGees' *Words* and Tracy Chapman's *Baby Can I Hold You* strengthened that position.

"Two of three Boyzone songs we play at present [Father... and Baby...] are covers," says Kevin Palmer, programme controller at AC station Heart FM/London. Palmer, who "wouldn't necessarily play the originals at present," picked the tracks because "they are a clever choices for covers because they're not too obvious and Boyzone do justice to these songs, which were originally



written by established adult artists. Boyzone's sound and image has certainly matured."

"At this stage I think people expect Boyzone to have a more mature outlook," says the group's Mike Graham. "Four or five years ago, we were doing mainstream pop music specifically for young kids and they've all grown up now too. If we were to maintain doing what we were doing five years ago, we wouldn't survive."

Lead vocalist Ronan Keating, who has just turned 21, is keen to stress that "we co-produced this album and the album before, and that's very important to us. If you're a boy band people see you in one light, but if they start to realise that you actually write the songs and you co-produce them, then they'll take you in a totally different light."

Among those overseeing the production on the album were Evan Rogers and Carl Sturken, who are responsible for the new single *All That I Need* which Keating describes as "a typical love song". It will be released across Europe on April 27.

The group has already made some headway in France and will concentrate on becoming better known in Europe during April and May. Asian, South American and possibly U.S. promotion will follow that.

S.O.A.P. cleaning up stateside

Danish dance/pop duo S.O.A.P. are currently showing U.S. radio audiences how to party.

Released on March 18 on Crave—the label jointly owned by Mariah Carey and Sony— This is How We Party appeared on 50 playlists

across the U.S. in its S.O.A.P. first week at radio.

The track has a 13-week run in the Danish top 10 behind it—peaking at no. 3 and selling over 10,000 singles domestically to date. According to Sony Music Denmark marketing manager local repertoire Lise Nielsen, "A number of other ter-

ritories are ready to go with the single and we are currently planning release dates with them."

The duo's debut album Not Like Other Girls was also released on March 18 in Denmark, with pre-orders topping 20,000 units, and within two weeks was certified gold (25,000 units sold. Not Like Other Girls will hit U.S. stores in late May. Sony Music's Columbia division will handle S.O.A.P. outside the U.S. and Scandinavia.

The voices behind S.O.A.P. belong to Suriyatim Heidi Sørensen and Sase Line Sørensen. Born in Malaysia to a Danish father and a Malaysian mother, the pair began their musical careers at the age of 5, learning to play various instruments at home, whilst making music with their parents.

Their career took off rather accidentally after they got talking to Remee, former vocalist with Sony Music-signed Danish dance act

Sound of Seduction. Remee took an instant shine to the Sørensen sisters and offered to compose and produce much of the music for the duo's debut album.

This Is How We Party, the first track from the album to see

commercial release, was serviced to German radio and got an overwhelmingly positive

response. "A lot of people in Germany have been asking for a promotional tour of S.O.A.P., but they will be going to the U.S. first," says Nielsen.

S.O.A.P. will, however, perform in Germany on April 14-15, and play in Finland for the following two days. At the end of that month, they will head out on a six-week tour of the U.S. Promotional activity in the U.K. market will begin after that. A second single, Ladidi Ladida is scheduled for release in Denmark on April 9.

Dance grooves

BELGIAN BASS GETS FUNKY

The rhythmic punch packed by Cheroc's Funky Bass (Accor/Belgium), dedicated to George Clinton and Bootsy Collins, makesit one of the finest floorfillers of the year so far. The track has an excruciatingly funky house beat, a sprinkling of vocal samples and a bassline which closely resembles that on Armand van Helden's remix of C.J. Bolland's Sugar Is Sweeter. Stripped-down dance at its best.

PAPERING THE LOUNGE

Confirming their reputation of being among the classiest proponents of drum'n'bass, The Amalgamation of Soundz' EP Keyvan's Paper (Filter/UK) features a big "live" sound and a heart of jazz. Concentrating on musicality rather than rhythmic trickery, the EP's four tracks display a melodic lounge-core sound. Clever without being in love with cleverness, the Amalgamation's take on nu-Jazz is about as good as it gets.

MORE JOY THAN PAIN

Moving away from their usual diet of cover versions, Scottish independent Steppin' Out comes up with a solid pop/dance tune, Joy & Pain by Addams & Gee feat. Antonia Lucas. A Eurobeat backing and Lucas' muscular vocal combine well on the strong radio edit, which concentrates on a basic but effective chorus. The label has also provided a second, slightly more acid-fuelled edit.

FRENCH INDIE'S IMPACT

The spirit of 1988 is alive on the *Impact* EP from Montpellier independent Logistic, currently one of France's most happening club labels. With four tracks by three Logistic artists, the music ranges from the Detroitstyle funky brutalism of Black Angel and Sex Wax through to the sombre, downbeat, acid-washed Harmonic. A strong label showcase from the town which has become the centre of France's southern rave scene.

BIG DUTCH BEATS

Amsterdam's Mazzo has been a prime mover among Europe's ground-breaking clubs for over a decade. In the

late 80s, it was one of the first to embrace acid house (although not as quickly as local competitor The Roxy); more recently, the club was one of the first to set up its own label, specialising in mix-CDs. Amongst the most popular releases on the Mazzo imprint are Phil Perry's superb contribution to the Mazzo

Mix-Up series and Sex Love & Motion by DJ Carlijn and Keith Fielder.

The latest brain-child of label chief Alexia Walker is Quaint, a dedicated Big Beat label. The first release,

Asphalt Darling 01, features classic tracks including Curtis' Velcro, Cabbage Boy's Bean and Carnivorous Lunar Activities by Lab Rat—all mixed by DJ EP, resident at Brussels' Cybertheatre.

"This month we start a weekly big beat night, The Sub, in Mazzo on says Walker "Sub will feature local DJs

Thursdays," says Walker. "Sub will feature local DJs like Thimbles and Rob Boskamp. We also intend to send The Sub on tour through European clubs."

Paris-based dance station Radio FG, which broadcasts sessions recorded at Mazzo, is to run a promo week featuring cuts from *Asphalt Darling 01*, Walker adds.

VACUUM SEANCE AT THE CHAEBOL

Stockholm Records/PolyGram European release date: April 6 This album's opening track, Tonnes Of Attraction has "hit" written all over it. Co-written by bass player Alexander Bard-

founder member of Sweden's disbanded champions of camp, Army Of Lovers—the track recalls hi-NRG disco at its best and has been available in some territories since March 30 as the album's second single. As already pointed out in M&M (March 28) Vacuum's previous single I Breathe was a Top 5 hit in Italy. PolyGram took that as a sign of things to come, and scheduled the release of the album in Italy and neighbouring Switzerland for April 6-before setting a date for release in Vacuum's domestic market. Vacuum's Attraction is likely to build from Italy into Holland and the G/S/A into Eastern Europe and Scandinavia before it hits the U.K.—just like this season's other big "novelty" record, Jason Nevins' It's Like That. But be warned; if you thought Aqua's Barbie Girl was the pinnacle of bad taste, don't go near Vacuum. The band's cheesy blend of '80s electropop rolls the Human League and Duran Duran into one, and tops it off with lead singer Mattias Lindblom's Brian Ferry-like phrasing.

Hiller adds: "Of course, this record is an absolute blessing for radio; we added it as soon as it got in, and currently we are playing it 15-20 times a week." From the sound of Hiller's parting words, it seems likely that Life Is A Flower seems set for a lengthy stay on Berlin's airwaves. He explains: "At first audience response was less than overwhelming—but than again it is still early days; and besides, how can an audience like records when you don't allow the listeners to get to know the tracks?"



Lighter evenings outside M&M's offices here in London are reminders of the approach of spring, and the new season brings with it the first major breaks of the year across Europe, such as Easter and bank holidays.



Those breaks should mean that listeners have more leisure time and therefore (hopefully) more opportunities to tune in to your station-and there's also the potential to pull in new listeners. So why does Jim Sampson, music coordinator at rock and speech public broadcaster, Bayern 3 in Bavaria tell me: "These holiday times scare the shit out of us"?

Sampson's fear-born from experience-is that deviating too much from regular output for only a few days can have long term effects where it hurts most—ratings. He explains: "Since we have a speech element, it is hard to fill those segments during those times. So we tended to open up the request lines. In a situation like that, we were playing on the fringe of the format."

The result, says Sampson, was that "we got a knockout punch from the ratings. It was catastrophic."

However, there's another point of view. "It's up to programmers to capitalise on this [time] and make people listen when they are available to do so," proposes John Rosborough, programme director at Belfast's full service station, Downtown Radio and hot AC broadcaster, Cool FM

Promoting programming such as "music marathons" or "all request" bank holidays prior to the holiday can pay off by pulling in weekend listeners who don't normally have time to tune in during their working week, Rosborough suggests. He notes that his stations tend to play more upbeat, "sparkier" tracks during the holiday times

But if stations deviate from normal programming by introducing such elements during holidays, there is a clear danger that new listeners—or regular listeners listening during times they normally don't-might not get a true reflection of the station's true sound.

"It's half-way," Rosborough says, "between recognising that the holiday is a different day, and people are feeling different about it, but keeping familiar elements in your programming, so that, if people do tune in on an on-going basis—as a result of tuning in on a holiday they will continue to find those elements and like them.'

It might be easier to take less complicated options when programming for a holiday. But programmers have to strike a balance between capturing the mood of the audience and what's consistent with the overall policies of the station. It also gives them an opportunity to evaluate up-and-coming presenters who cover for station regulars during a holiday.

Any presenters, by the way, who are reading this may want to ponder the number of emerging on-air talents who-according to many radio execs-have been poached by rival music programmers after hearing them doing holiday shifts!

These psychedelic rockers combine a healthy dose of eccentricity with a keen pop sensibility on this, their first single. A trans-Atlantic threesome (comprising an English singer, a Scottish guitarist and an American bassist), Transister manage to overcome any cultural differences they might be expected to have and deliver a great song in a bizarre (yet strangely effective) arrangement. The track is taken from their selftitled debut album for Trans/Virgin, which is due out in August. At Swiss French-language rock outlet Couleur 3, which broadcasts from Basel, head of music Thierry Catherine insists that he had absolutely no qualms about putting Look Who's Perfect Now straight into powerplay rotation. "We are convinced that it is an excellent tune which might very well become a major hit," declares Catherine. He continues: "We are currently playing it between four and six times a day, and



will continue to do so over the next four weeks," Catherine adds that, although these are still early days for the track at Couleur 3, he expects audience response to the song to be positive.

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
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Business is brisk for the extracurricular projects of the Fugees' Wyclef Jean.

His collaboration with all female R&B act Destiny's Child on No. No. No (Columbia) is a new entry at number 44 and the man himself enters this week at 49 with Gone Till November (Ruff-



house/Columbia). Both records currently have their strongest supporters in the Netherlands and the U.K., although it's rare for both records to appear on the same playlists.

Walter Notz, Head Of Music at German CHRoutlet Radio 7 in Ulm, expresses some surprise at his European counterparts' caution over playlisting both tracks. "For us, it isn't a problem to programme both records—we would miss too much if we could only programme one track by an artist. That's especially true of the R&B scene at the moment, where a lot of collaborations are going on. Besides, I can always tell my computer programme not to list one after the other."

There's finally some change in the top 3 of the European Radio Top 50 this week, where the Spice Girls' Stop (Virgin) takes over the number 2 position from Celine Dion's My Heart Will Go On (Columbia/Sony), although Madonna's Frozen (Maverick) stays No.1 for the sixth consecutive week. But it's below the top slots that the real action's taking place this week.

Storming the airplay charts is Life Is A Flower by Ace Of Base (Mega/Polydor). It's this week's Most Added track, the greatest chart points gainer, and also the Roadrunner in the Border Breakers section. The record is displaying its strongest growth in Scandinavia, Poland and Germany.

Covering unusual material is proving to be successful for U.K. dance act Tin Tin Out. Their album Always contains a version of the Bacharach/David album Always Something There To Remind Me. but it's pop from a different era that's provided their latest airplay hit. Their beats-added version of Here's Where The Story Ends (VC Recordings) was originally an album track for '80s indie outfit The Sundays. The track—this week's highest new entry at 38-is top at U.K. radio, as the Major Market Airplay listings show.

Below that, Robbie Williams is new at 45 with Let Me Entertain You. The rocky follow-up to his ballad Angels (both on Chrysalis)—still at number 16 this week-has picked up early airplay in the



U.K. and Germany. Still entertaining after all these years, the eternal soul diva Aretha Franklin is back on the Top 50 with A Rose Is Still A Rose (Arista) at number 47. It's proving particularly popular in Scandinavia, where it's already at number 14 in the regional chart. Following Aretha up the

chart at a respectful distance is Air's Sexy Boy (Source/Virgin), a re-entry thanks to its crossover from dance to mainstream radio.

And finally, a thank you to the only person (as far as we know!) who tried to catch the charts department out on April Fool's Day. Valeria Notari in the programming department of Italian CHRnetwork Radio Dimensione Suono/Rome faxed us their latest adds-which on closer inspection turned out to look remarkably like a list of her favourite Duran Duran and Cat Stevens records (and no, they weren't brand new dance remixes...).

Sonys show radio reality

LONDON — This year's Sony Radio Awards are being revamped to "reflect the radio industry as it really is today."

The U.K. event, now in its 16th year, will be held on May 7 at the Grosvenor House hotel in London. There are 80 nominations in 26 categories covering every facet of British radio.

This year's awards include 10 new categories covering breakfast, day-time, drivetime, late night and weekend shows. The new categories have been designed to take account of the evolution of new formats, and the growth of the commercial radio sector.

"The awards will no longer be an endurance contest," says Tim Blackmore, the programme director of independent production company Unique Broadcasting who will replace broadcasting veteran John Whitney as the awards' chairman next year. "They now reflect the current landscape of the entire radio industry," he says.

Nominees in the key music radiorelated categories for 1998 include:

The Breakfast Award—Music: Chris Evans (Virgin Radio/London); Steve Jackson's Morning Glory (Kiss 100 FM/London); Wake Up To Wogan (BBC Radio 2/London)

The Daytime Award—Music: Pete, Geoff & Noel (Key 103/Manchester); Mark Radcliffe (BBC Radio 1/London); Jo Whiley's Lunchtime Social (BBC Radio 1/London)

The Drivetime Award—Music: David Jensen's Drivetime (95.8 Capital FM/London); Dave Pearce (BBC Radio 1/London); The John Dunn Show (BBC Radio 2/London)

Cost savings drive new Network

tion executive who competes with Warner and Sony says the move makes perfect economic sense. "Everyone has to collapse [reduce] costs," he adds, estimating that the two labels will be able to make savings of up to 30 percent in some aspects of their distribution business. His guess of combined annual efficiency savings is \$1.5 million.

According to U.K. labels' body the British Phonographic Industry (BPI), statistics for 1997 show the new venture's share of the total U.K. music business by distribution would be approximately 21 percent (albums) and 19 percent (singles). The figures, supplied by Chart Information Network (CIN), show that both companies lost distribution share last year: Sony dropped to 11.4 percent (albums) and 7.9 percent (singles), Warner to 9.2 percent (albums) and 10.8 percent (singles).

Neither Sony Music Entertainment U.K. chairman/CEO Paul Burger nor Warner Music (U.K.) chairman Rob Dickins were available for comment at time of going to press; both are expected to sit on the board of The Entertainment Network. Warner Music operations director Gwen Pearce has been appointed managing director of the new venture; Jan Gach, VP of operations at Sony Music, will be deputy managing director.

The implications of the move are being keenly studied by leading U.K. music retailers. HMV Europe managing director Brian McLaughlin says the chain "will be looking at the fine detail of this move to see how it impacts on HMV."

Andy Lown, managing director of Tower Records U.K., Europe and Middle East, notes that Sony already successfully distributes Warner product in Ireland, where Tower has a high profile Dublin store. Lown says he sees the new venture as "a logical step. I don't have a problem as long as both companies maintain their service; it makes sound business sense."

Leicester-based independent retailer Richard Wootton is chairman of trade body, the British Association of record Dealers. He echoes Lown's sentiments, "If Sony and Warners think it's a good idea, and there's no drop in service, I can't see a problem. Hopefully the result of the amalgamation will be an even better service."

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The combined operation will serve around 4,000 accounts in music, video and other software lines, with at least one third of capacity devoted to third party product. It will operate from Sony's existing 250,000 square-foot premises in Aylesbury. The Aylesbury site has had excess capacity since Sony shut down its video manufacturing operation there in 1996. The bulk of the two firms' manufacturing is done in continental Europe.

Warner U.K. says it will "eventually" close its site at Alperton. The 110 distribution staff there "will be offered the chance to apply for jobs at Aylesbury." However, a spokesperson adds: "They're reviewing all their systems, so the same jobs may not exist in the future." A further 90 finance and sales employees at Alperton are likely to be relocated to a nearby location yet to be decided.

In Australia, Sony and Warner share a distribution operation called the Entertainment Distribution Companies (EDC) with EMI. In Japan, the two companies are among the partners in Japan Distribution System (JDS).

In the U.K., however, the album is unlikely to be released until June. The delay there is due to negotiations between Sony Music U.K. and London Records on the possible inclusion of the official England team song *On Top Of The World*, written by Echo & The Bunnymen's Ian McCulloch and former Smiths guitarist Johnny Marr.

Sony is optimistic that the quality of the songs written and recorded for the project will validate the unprecedented number of single releases from the album. "Allez! Ola! Olé! is not a gimmick record about football," says Sony Music Europe senior VP Richard Ogden.

"What we tried to do," he explains, "was to create singles which would enhance the artists' careers and be suitable for inclusion on their own albums as well as compiling them on one album to accompany the World Cup."

In France, World Cup fever has already spread to radio stations who are eager to sift through the flood of football-related releases this spring. Yves Bigot, scheduling director of local Paris station Sport O'FM, says: "Our station focuses on sport—particularly football—so these are the kind of tracks we are looking for."

He adds: "We need upbeat, joyful songs. But not at any price—the tracks must have a certain quality, and the lyrics cannot be vulgar." Sport O'FM is already playing La Cour Des Grands, La Copa De Vida and Wes' I Love Football.

Final track listing on the album will differ from territory to territory, but all versions of the album will feature 20 tracks, including all the pan-European singles plus Jarre's Together Now. Chumbawamba's Top

Of The World will be released as a single through EMI, and Del Amitri's Don't Come Home will be out on A&M Records.

By the time the World Cup final finishes on July 12, an estimated combined world-wide TV audience of 3.7 billion will have heard N'Dour's La Cour Des Grands and Martin's La Copa De La Vida plus various other tracks off the album. Ogden estimates Allez! Ola! Olé! is likely to sell two million units world-wide, one million of those in Europe.

"But the story won't end on July 12," believes Ogden. "We are confident the individual singles on Allez! Ola! Olé! will draw attention to the artists' other material, and we will continue to work a number of tracks in one form or another during the second half of the year."

Czech labels, radio in ads row

Record companies in the Czech Republic have traditionally bypassed national sales houses and agreed deals with individual stations for ad campaigns, usually based on a barter system where CDs plus a nominal fee are swapped for ad spots/artist spotlights.

MMS has a market-leading 36.5 percent share of the radio ad market in the Czech Republic; its clients include national AC broadcaster Radio nova Alfa and the 27-station HIT radio network. Says MMS director general Daniel Sedlacek: [The record companies] are spending money on promotion in other media, but not on radio, because they consider radio to be free. And we can't accept that. The radio station owners are saying 'we don't want this situation anymore.'"

"The radio scene here has developed to a point where it's necessary to clean up the market," Sedlacek continues. "[The record companies] received special treatment in the past. But now, there isn't enough airtime available on stations to accommodate every client. So if they want to promote their records, they will have to pay for that, just like any other client."

The record companies, however, argue that the Kc100,000 (\$2,941) price tag MMS has attached to weekend promotional campaigns for their artists is far too high. Petr Kraus, head of radio promotion at PolyGram, says: "No-one budgeted for this amount in their marketing plans—it's 5-20 times more than what we paid before. At that price, [record] companies smaller than us will prefer to pay for a TV campaign."

Another music industry executive, who wished to remain anonymous because of his company's ongoing negotiations with MMS, adds: "This price is simply laughable, it's just too much. [Record companies] are special,

we are not like other clients. We are trading in music, and that is the basis of most radio. We know that, and they know it too. The question is, who is more important than the other? The answer is clear enough—we can't exist without each other."

For the record

In Music & Media's March 21 issue, it was stated that Border Radio Holdings' Century Radio was a major shareholder in Rock 105's application for the Radio Authority's north east England regional licence. This was originally the case, but Border withdrew from the application following its success in winning the Radio Authority's north west England regional licence. Border's place in the Rock 105 consortium has been taken by the York-based broadcaster Minster Sound Radio plc.

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

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Off the record

Are hard times around the corner for guitarbased rock on U.K. radio? Speculation that media giant CLT-UFA is looking to hive off its U.K. radio interests has led to whispers that alternative music station Xfm might be put on the market. CLT has a 20 percent stake in the recently-launched, London-based station.

Employees at Norwegian public-owned broadcaster NRK have apparently been offered attractive financial packages and/or early retirement to leave the TV and radio network voluntarily. NRK is said to be aiming to shed at least 100 of its 3,500 staff. So far, 30 employees are reported to have agreed to leave the station. Over 100 have allegedly expressed interest in the terms and conditions of NRK's proposal.

The senior management of French CHR network Fun Radio flew to Los Angeles last week to attend a seminar on the future of the station's programming with U.S. radio consultants.

Last year's split between the organisers of Tribal Gathering, Europe's biggest commercial outdoor dance event, has now led to the announcement of two U.K. mega dance bashes instead of one. Both events are going under new names, since a court ruling on who can continue to use the original one is still outstanding. Vince Power's Mean Fiddler organisation kicks off the season with Creamfields at the Matterley Estate in Hampshire on May 2-3. Powers' former co-organisers Universe follow on May 22-24 with Universe '98 at Knebworth Park in Hertfordshire.



The U.K. national news and speech station Talk Radio is joining Digital One, a consortium set up by GWR and Chris Evan's Ginger Media Group, which is in the race for the first national digital radio multiplex licence in the U.K. (M&M, April

4). GWR and Ginger Media own the two other national commercial broadcasters, Classic FM and Virgin Radio, respectively.

Look for EMI France President Gilbert Ohayon to restructure its special market-Catalogue operations. exploitation, which was under the banner of the Odeon Label Group (OLG), will now be under the responsibility of the managing director, sales opera-



tions and distribution, Claude Amrane. EMI's dance label DLA-its main act is Worlds Apart—will merge with the Odeon Label Group to create a new source of current repertoire. DLA general manager Frédéric Juarez will head the merged DLA/OLG division. Consequently, OLG MD Bart Swanson is departing the company.

Geffen's London-based European marketing director Liz Morris has been promoted to the position of marketing director for Universal Music International. She will be responsible for the international marketing of Universal and Interscope's rock repertoire, in addition to her responsibilities for the Geffen, Dreamworks and Outpost labels. She reports to UMI senior VP of business affairs and GM business development Tim Bowen, pending the arrival May 1 of UMI senior VP marketing and A&R Max Hole.


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
