### A VALUED MARKET

Britain has always been a valued market for developing talent for English speaking countries the world over. Its actual selling market is relatively small when compared to America and Japan, but the prestige of securing a hit record here is next only to the States. If a single sells well in the UK, then usually Europe follows, depending on promotional and distribution services available for that single.

And as mentioned at the start of this article, only a small percentage of British acts can be included here. But just think, if these mentioned few can succeed internationally, and if the standard of British music and talent continues - and there's no reason to suppose it won't - a new batch of artists will replace them, that new batch will be replaced, and so on.






Working Week (Virgin)

# **BRITISH ACTS ...**

# ANOTHER TALENT BOOM

Once again British acts are taking a stranglehold on American and European charts. Not all the acts are long established names now due to the advent of a whole new sley of young stars bringing into the industry a fresh, energetic sound and a much needed injection of andrenalin. Young names that have pushed British music high in foreign charts are many and include Whami, Frankie Goes To Hollywood, Thompson Twins, Sade, U2, Paul Young, Nik Kershaw, Howard Jones, The Eurythmics and Duran Duran. And these are comfortably on their way to megastar status despite their relatively short careers so far when compared to stalwarts like Paul McCartney, Elton John, Cliff Richard and so on. There's room now for everyone - this has been proven - and each month sees yet another UK band in the recording studio, or another British act hitting home and foreign charts. It's a talent boom, no doubt about it, largely brought on by the original and inventive sound of these young stars breaking down conventional musical barriers. If that talent can be recognised and nurtured by a sympathetic record company it cannot fall to reap rewards on an international level.

However, the problems are many. First a band has to get signed to the company. Once secured, the band's product has to get to the public and the restrictions of the British radio circuit does present a situation of an act actually making it or not. With the introduction of a second commercial television station, popular music is now no longer restricted to the BBC's Top Of The Pops programme which now screens, by and large, only charted material. The position for new bands getting public exposure is better than it was five years ago, but there's still a very long way to go yet. After several years of wandering in a musical wilderness, the British industry is now fighting back in a way that'll overtake the attack of the Sixties. It is not content to allow itself to be dominated, or influenced by, American music for example. Out of interest now, during 1983 British acts accounted for thirty-five per cent of the American charts, whereas US acts on the British listing totalled a mere eighteen per cent. Times are changing and overseas companies are looking to Britain once again for guidance.

**OVERSEAS ACCLAIM** 

Now with the recently established names fike those listed above opening the doors to overseas territories, a flurry of even newer acts are finding it comparatively easier to leave home base, and it's with a handful of these we'll stay, for they are either embarking on international careers or earning a name for themselves in the British Isles, with overseas acclaim yet to come.

Of course to mention every up and coming UK act would fill this magazine many times over, and that probably wouldn't include circuit working units only known to local areas of the British Isles at this time. Like the acts about to be mentioned these publicly unknown groups



will, hopefully, have their moment of glory. The industry turnabout is extensive, and although home competition is crippling, some do make the big time, but the number who give up is probably more than those who continue the struggle to the top. Before hoping to actually record, finding a suitable manager should be a new band's priority - and that takes a lot of doing.

### NO ILLUSIONS

However, certain artists have managed to achieve this. From the same management as Imagination comes Haywoode who is not only a singer, but dancer (she's appeared in Bubbling Brown Sugar) and actress (having played in Superman 2, The Muppet Movie and Ragtime). "My father was a founder member of The Fantastics" she told me "and my background is show business, so I've got no illusions". Her debut single A Time Like This charted here during 1983, but the very popular twenty-four year old has yet to repeat that big success. Her album is due but the ideal situation would be, she says, to release it on a big single. Meanwhile Haywoode is the female vocalist on The Limit's runaway hit Say Yeah.

### ON THE BRINK OF SUCCESS

As Boy George, Aztec Camera and Bananarama scored UK success, another lady (from Birmingham) experimented with music and was fortunate enough to find a manager who cared. Jaki Graham, one of six children. is not a stranger to the studios having been a session singer for a variety of acts like UB40, Alexis Komer and David Grant. Before this Jaki was a member of Medium Wave, and during one of their gigs she was spotted by manager Brian Freshwater. "He kept me under wraps until it was my time" she explained. "I was kept busy working with David Grant while Brian kept a look out for the right song for me". He found one and she recorded her first single What's The Name Of Your Game which tickled the UK charts. This was hotly followed by Heaven Knows and Once More With Feeling with her debut album due any time. Meanwhile, like all artists on the brink of success, Jaki is continuing the hard, boring slog of nationwide promotion. This promotion work does pay dividends because two young girls, known as Strawberry Switchblade (with their unique, eye-catching theatrical clothes) have proved it and roared into the top 10 with the Since Yesterday single.

British dj's don't always confine themselves to turntables. A fair percentage become involved in other areas of the industry, like *Steve Waish* who opened his own record label Total Control. His first single was **Paul Hardcastle**'s You're The One For Me which raced up the UK charts. Paul, formerly a member of First Light and Direct Drive, tried it alone because he was frustrated with staid musical ideas and wanted to experiment on his own.

Taking this chance worked, for he has now enjoyed three consecutive British hits, with one, Rain Forest crossing the Atlantic to tear

up the US listings. Meanwhile his old group Direct Drive, with lead vocals by Helen Rogers, look as if they'll enjoy their first crossover success in years with their Anything single. "Paul is still a great friend of ours" commented Helen. "He actually programmed the synthesisers on the single, then lent us his studio while he went outside and fiddled around with his cart!"



### **CROSSOVER APPEAL**

Another club and radio dj, Robbie Vincent, manages the funk group Second Image who have tasted minor club chart success, but that crossover appeal hasn't happened. It will happen as it did for Level 42, but the staying power presents problems all of its own. With British acts now producing high quality and immensely saleable dance music, American artists are slowly finding themselves up against strong opposition. American studios and producers will always have the edge because somehow British artists and producers cannot reproduce the 'feel' for the music, yet the Dutch band, The Limit (who have been accepted in England before their home country) is currently standing alongside James Ingram, Thelma Houston And The Ternptations at the top of the club chart.

Paul Hardcastle ... three consecutive British hits

Paul Hardcastle is possibly one of the most inventive UK acts when it comes to getting the 'feel' and atmosphere of sound, although he'li probably be the first to credit American music as his influence. What the UK loses out to America on the dancefloor, is made up for in popular sound. It has taken a long time to get black music treated in the same way as white on promotion levels. The situation is by no means equal but headway is being made slowly but surely as more black product, American and British, makes the charts. And it's interesting to note that on the current pop album chart home names of Alison Moyet, Bronski Beat and Ultravox are forcing Tina Turner and Lionel Richie to fight for placings. The competition is getting stronger all the time. With the increasing growth of independent labels the all important chart stakes are even more competitive. Naturally indies do not have huge amounts of money to sink into lavish marketing and promotion campaigns. Nevertheless a lot do make their mark against the major record companies and secure a small proportion of the market share which ordinarily the big brothers would have swallowed up. To assist the indies a specially compiled chart has been introduced and, by and large, this contains acts that rarely cross

over into the big sales league, like - Enemy Within, Subhumans, Sid Presley Experience, Red Lorry Yellow Lorry. However, some get away - Black Lace, The Toy Dolls and The Smiths immediately come to mind. Now they have to substain their popularity which is always a problem.

### CRACK OF THE WHIP

London isn't now the only British area to produce talent as all the big cities are getting a fair crack of the whip. For example, Sheffield has produced two very new bands: Floy Joy (names after The Supremes' hit) and Shout. Both have secured record deals but the real slog has only just begun for them. Floy Joy is a four piece unit who are on the verge of releasing their first album Into The Hot. Like most UK bands, Floy Joy is self-contained; writing and playing their own material. "The way we write" said member Mike Ward, "doesn't compare with other bands. I think when somebody like ABC sets a precedent, and you get one hundred bands copying it that style over content thing - it just won't hold water. We don't use any logic or formula, that's why our album is quite varied" Shout, a six piece band, on the other hand,





The Big Sound Authority (MCA)
Eight-piece London band The Big Sound
Authority made their debut on Paul Weller's Respond label. Their sound is a blend of funk, blues and soul with a full-power brass section.
Their first single for MCA, This House, was

produced by Robin Millar (Sade, Everything But The Girl and Working Week) and indeed they produce a 'big sound', combined with oceans of feel in the voices of Tony Burke and Julie Hadwen. Altogether this makes Big Sound Authority an exciting new release.





King (CBS) Formed from the ashes of the WEA signing Reluctant Stereotypes, Coventry band King built up a slow but very loyal following and had at the end of 1984 three singles released without any significant chart succes though Around Christmas they supported Culture Club on their UK tour. At Christmas eve their single Love and Pride was re-released which currently is already at no. 2. Other chart successes are expected in Germany, Belgium and Holland. The demand for King is enormous, their UK tour is sold out and another one is booked in April. We expect that their funky popmusic will make a 'royal' impact around Europe. A new single entitled Won't You Hold My Hand Now will be released March 11th

have just issued their first single Suspicion. They formed eighteen months ago, and literally walked the streets of London begging a company to record them. Passion Records took up the challenge eventually, and gave them to NIgel Wright, Shakatak's producer, to work with. If the single is successful, Shout will join the album stakes in the same way as Floy Joy. But even when that first single is issued, and hopefully comparatively successful, the pressure heightens to produce a follow-up that will also sell. One hit wonders are two a penny and careers aren't sustained.

Animal Nightlife, for example, a quintet featuring the vocals of Andy Polaris enjoyed a hit with their first single Mr. Solitaire. They had previously built up a strong following through their live work, and that supported the single. However, they've yet to prove their ability to survive on vinyl.

The UK Players, a one time hugely popular band, who have been dogged with singles-that-nearly-made-it have temporarily abandoned their own careers to earn a living as session singers for the pop trio Bananarama. Before too long, no-one will

remember the group's past glory. And two young very talented artists who made great headway a couple of years ago - David Grant and Junior - are back in the studios to, dare! say it, revive their flagging careers. Grant was one half of *Linx*, and had an extremely profitable solo career immediately after the demise of the duo. Junior, on the other hand, was always a solo artist but of late has been unable to repeat her earlier successes. To keep his name in the public eye he joined Council Collective (with Paul Weller and Jimmy Ruffin) to record Soul Deep.

### A STUMBLING BLOCK

Comprising Ken Joseph, Leroy Williams and Jeff Guishard, Hi Tension is another working band and they enjoyed a chart song called Rat Race last year. This trio built up a massive following via concentrated work at nightclub

A very hot and much discussed topic in the press at the moment is the project, The Power Station. Duran Duran's bassplayer John Taylor and guitarist Andy Taylor lined up in New York City with Robert Palmer and Chic drummer Tony Thompson. The four have recorded sight tracks with Robert Palmer on lead vocals. The entire project has been produced at New York's Power Station Studio's by Chic's Bernard Edwards.

Their debut single entitled Some Like It Hot has just been released and first reactions are overwhelming. The initial idea for this creative diversification involving John and Andy Taylor was originally spawned three years ago when

John first met Robert Palmer in Birmingham. Shortly after, another meeting occured between John, Andy and Chic drummer Tony Thompson during Duran Duran's first US tour supporting Blondie in 1982. The circle was finally complete in 1984 when John and Andy met Bemard Edwards during the Duran Duran 1984 US tour.

SOME of you may remember the name of Belouis Some, who had a minor hit last year with the song Target Practice on EMI or may have seen him last year on a Nik Kershaw tour. Early March will see the release of his new single Imagination on which famous names like Carlos Alomar, Tony Thompson and Bernard Edwards are featured.

level and support work. One of this country's top units, Tension relied on the independent Streetwave Records to give them the chance they needed so badly, as Ken explained "The big difference is that we were not treated by Streetwave simply as product but we were

treated like people". And this is a policy that maybe some of the major companies should adhere to.

Recording isn't obviously only confined to singers, for comedian extraodinaire Lenny Henry has, despite, being in show business for

The twenty-six year old has now secured his own television series which is in its second run, and a touring schedule that is fixed for months at a time. Certainly Lenny's hurnour is an acquired taste, and this could be a stumbling block overseas.

Go West (Chrysalis)

One of the major bands that Chrysalis recently signed, is the new band Go West. Their debut single We Close Our Eyes is a lively dance track, very well received by the mediapeople and already in the English charts. Go West are Peter Cox (vocals, guitars and keyboards) and Richard Drummie (keyboards, vocals and hass).

On hearing a rough demo of We Close Our Eyes master producer Arif Mardin described their sound as 'Modern Motown' and the highly selective award winning video directing tearn of Godley and Creme produced the video for their single. This is, in fact, the first time ever that Godley and Creme have been involved with a new bands' first single promo and it was only their third video production of 1984. Their debut album is to be released early Summer.

Other new names for Chrysalis in 1985 include The Colourfield (Thinking Of You), Billy Bragg (see our news section) and the Dublin band Les Enfants with their powerful single Slipaway.
