tive for an El Paso distributor. In 1952 he joined the RCA-Victor distributor in El Paso, as manager of their record division. In 1959 he moved to Mexico City where he served as sales manager for the RCA Record Division in Mexico. On returning to the U. S. two years later, he was associated with a distributor in Phoenix prior to his joining Voice of Music Corp. Venzor listed some of Cap-Latino's artists who will be featured on the first releases by the label. They include: rock and roll group Los Yaki, Carlos Lico, Lucho Gatica and Robertha, all of whom record for Discos de Mexico.
