Jerry Masucci, president of Fania Records, and **Morris Levy**, president of Roulette Records, have announced that as of March 15, Fania is distributing all product of Tico and Alegre Records and all other Latin labels controlled by Roulette. The move brings together the two reigning giants of contemporary Latin music. Under the agreement, all activities of Tico and Alegre will emanate out of Fania headquarters in New York, with Fania responsible for all phases of operation, including production, pressing, sales, distribution and promotion.

Joe Cain, general manager of Tico and Alegre, will report directly to Fania president **Jerry Masucci**. The Tico-Alegre artist roster includes some of the biggest names in the world of Latin music. Among those coming into the Fania fold are **Tito Puente**, **Ismael Rivera**, **Joe Cuba**, **Charlie Palmieri**, **La Lupe** and others. For the past 30 years Tico-Alegre has maintained its position as one of the top Latin record companies and its vaults contain over 400 master tapes, considered the foremost Latin catalogue in the States. The addition of Tico-Alegre to Fania's powerhouse lineup of salsoul artists comes on the eve of Fania's tenth anniversary celebration and served to emphasize the incredible amount of growth the famed company has had in the short span of 10 years. The Tico-Alegre artists have joined a roster that already includes **Ray Barretto**, **Willie Colon**, **Larry Harlow**, **Johnny Pacheco**, **Roberto Roena**, **Bobby Valentin** and the **Fania All Stars**. Masucci announced that Fania will rush-release a new **Tito Puente** single containing "Babarabatiri" b/w "Ran Kan Kan," recorded several years ago and now breaking on the coast. The popularity of salsoul music outside the traditional New York market, fueled by rumors of a possible collaboration between **Puente** and **Santana**, has created renewed interest in Puente's earlier work. This new single will be in the stores by the end of the month on the Tico label.

Oswaldo I. Venzor has announced the appointment of **Memo de Anda** as promotion director for Discos Orfeon Inc. in Los Angeles . . . **Marcos Garcia**, president of Spanish World Records and Montilla and Four Points labels, announced that his production will be distributed on the west coast by Orfeon.
